Mega makeover for Maximum City

As Mumbai gets ready for its biggest transformation yet, there are opportunities galore for real estate developers. But the biggest of all is the chance to improve the quality of life of its residents

MUMBAI, 28 July

Mumbai, India's financial capital, is set for a mega transformation with a massive patch of land opening up for redevelopment; a new metro railway ready to start services by the year-end; and the country's oldest railway station, the Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus, going for modernisation with private sector participation.

Work on Mumbai's second airport will start from next month, while construction of the sea link connecting central Mumbai to Navi Mumbai has already moved into a fast lane despite Covid-induced lockdowns. Also, a coastal road project, connecting Nariman Point to Worli, is under way and will help decongest the city to quite an extent.

Of all these mega infrastructure projects, the one that has a huge potential to change the city's skyline is the Eastern Waterfront project — to be built on the Mumbai Port Trust (MbPT) land.

As part of the project, slums in the dock areas are likely to be shifted and accommodated in affordable housing colonies in the city. The project has also opened the opportunity to build a "Central Park" in Mumbai, a la New York. Designing the project is Ahmedabad-based HCP Design, the firm that gave the blueprint for the Sabarmati Waterfront in Ahmedabad and New Delhi's Central Vista project.

The MbPT land, which is nearly 1,800 acres, currently covers the entire eastern seafont of Mumbai island city. Experts say this is an opportunity for Maharashtra and the central government to address the social

and infrastructural challenges that Mumbai faces. The land can be redeveloped to include affordable housing, hospitals, schools, colleges, recreation and sports infrastructure, intrastate bus terminus, water transportation and infrastructure for cruise liners, besides cultural centres.

"This can potentially bring a positive change in the lifestyle and wellness of the people, apart from promoting tourism, with emphasis on the safety of the environment and wildlife. We will explore opportunities that fit our real estate strategy," said Sanjay Dutt, managing director and chief executive officer, Tata Realty and Infrastructure, which is evaluating opportunities to develop residential and commercial buildings in the project.

The cost to set up infrastructure per block is ₹6,500 crore. Land surveys are on and the number of blocks is being worked out. The total project cost will depend on the final techno-legal studies.

Earlier, the redevelopment of the commercial district at Lower Parel, Dadar and Elphinstone towards the western side

of central Mumbai was carried out on land where defunct textile mills stood. The swanky Bandra Kurla Complex, today the address of some of the country's biggest financial companies, was built on marshy land in the 1990s. After it came up, a large number of companies shifted from South Mumbai's Nariman Point and Ballard Estate to this new complex.

Similarly, the areas towards the eastern side of central Mumbai like Sewri to Byculla, when opened for development by MbPT, are bound to change the landscape of the city. The simultaneously planned infrastructure projects are also expected to trigger robust growth of this region.

This large-scale redevelopment has lessons to learn from the past. "During the redevelopment in the last 30 years, the poor were left out and slums mushroomed all over the city. Billionaires lived in billion-dollar homes with slums around," said an urban planner who did not wish to be named. "If this project is handled well, it can transform the city for the poor, too. But the greed of a few powerful people can still tilt the scales against them."

According to the plan, MbPT is developing approximately 253 hectares, half of which will be for public activities. The plan includes mixed land use development of a hi-tech city, government offices, recreational spaces, theme parks, and so on. The focus is on increasing tourism along the city's waterfront. New hotels and restaurants are also expected to come

up in the area.

According to real estate consultant JLL, new roads, rail and metro networks along with ferry services will improve East-West connectivity, which will trigger an increase in real estate prices in the area as well as in Navi Mumbai, on the other side of the bay.

The port area was earlier restricted to industrial, commercial and port activities. With this redevelopment, residential buildings will come up; these are expected to house approximately 100,000 people. "It is early to comment on the implementation timelines. However, MbPT hopes to fast-track the process and is currently short-listing consultants for empanelment for monetisation of assets," said A Shankar, head of Strategic Consulting and Valuation Advisory, JLL.

Real estate companies say that if planned properly, the eastern corridor can rejuvenate Mumbai.

"Most cities around the world have built public gardens, social infrastructure and, of course, residential and commercial complexes in a planned way," said Vikas Oberoi, chairman and managing director of Oberoi Realty. "If the MbPT project becomes a reality, it will provide excellent opportunities for real estate companies to build public parks, malls, hotels, schools, hospitals, residential and commercial complexes. It can be an integrated township that can offer everything one needs or aspires for."

One potential hurdle, however, could be the friction between the Bharatiya Janata Party-led central government (MbPT) and the state government (a coalition of Shiv Sena, Congress and the Nationalist Congress Party, or NCP). "One can only pray that all the governments focus on the long-term future of Mumbai and insist on increased public amenities like large parks and jogging tracks," said an urban planner, adding, "In the past, greed has not been good for the city."

Bankruptcy: What it means for Vijay Mallya & lenders

The Insolvency and Companies Court of London High Court on Monday declared fugitive businessman Vijay Mallya (pictured) a bankrupt person according to UK laws.

Legal experts explain what this could mean for 65-year old Mallya's personal liberties, his legal battle against extradition to India to face trial, and for the consortium of Indian lenders at whose behest the bankruptcy proceedings were initiated in the UK courts.

What are the consequences for Mallya and the lenders?

According to British law, a bankrupt trustee takes charge of a bankrupt person's financial and physical assets, including his credit and debit cards, bank accounts, etc. The court-appointed trustee would then reconcile all assets and liabilities of the bankrupt person to pay off the lenders. In that period there is restriction on personal spending by the bankrupt person. Such a person would also need court's permission to engage in business activities, or be part of a board of directors in a company. Under the British law, financial details of a bankrupt person are



publicly available in the individual Insolvency Register. "The obvious consequence is the likelihood of freezing of bank accounts and attachment of assets. Mallya would be required to hand over his assets. A further assessment of such assets against documented liabilities appears to be the natural and immediate consequence," said Faisal Sherwani, partner at law firm, L&L Partners.

However, the legal battle to declare Mallya bankrupt is far from over. Experts point out that Mallya has the option to take recourse to appeal against the order in a higher court. The order allows the consortium of Indian banks, led by the State Bank of India, to pursue a worldwide freezing order on Mallya's assets to seek the repayment of debts owed by Kingfisher Airlines, said Sushmita Gandhi, partner, IndusLaw.

The consortium of banks has already recovered around ₹7,000 crore, through sale of shares in different UB group companies. Mallya had taken loans worth ₹6,500 crore from various banks to fund his beleaguered Kingfisher Airlines.

Will the order have any impact on Mallya's efforts to resist the extradition exercise?

Per se the latest bankruptcy order is not related to the extradition case, which is being decided by the UK Home Office. Lawyers said it would not have a direct bearing on the issue of extradition, but could be cited as a relevant fact in any deliberative process towards such an end.

What are the key differences in the application of bankruptcy laws in the UK and in India?

According to lawyers, the bankruptcy order is a natural consequence of Mallya's failure to honour admitted debts. "Once you remove the bells and whistles, at its core the thesis and logic are the same, while statutes obviously differ," said Sherwani.

However, there are some key differences in the manner of operation of the trustee, who is not required to take permissions from the creditors under the bankruptcy laws in the UK. This is a departure from India's Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code where creditors play a key role in the decision-making.

Unlike under the IBC in India, where only financial creditors are conferred with voting powers, in the UK law, all creditors can participate in the voting process, Gandhi pointed out.

What is the next course of action for lenders?

For lenders, this could mean another round of court battles for seizing Mallya's foreign assets. But first lenders have to identify Mallya's assets in the UK and other countries. "While assets in the UK can be sold and realised, for other jurisdictions, it could be a long-drawn process as different jurisdictions have different requirements," said Gandhi.

Legal teams are also likely to examine whether other creditors and employees could make a claim on Mallya's estate, depending on their contractual relationship.

Diplomatic helmsman

Basavaraj Bommai, home minister in the BS Yediyurappa (BSY) government and the son of former CM and socialist leader S R Bommai, took oath as chief minister of Karnataka on Wednesday.

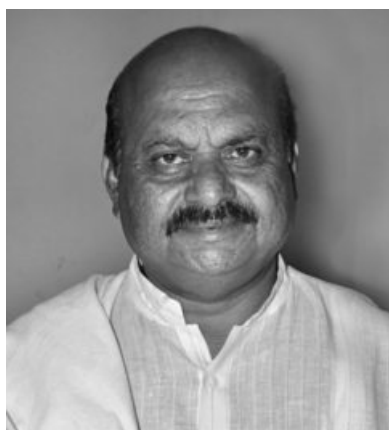
There is no reason, supporters said, that any of the policies of the BSY government would be reversed as a result of the appointment. This means that the allocation of 3,667 acres in Ballari to JSW Steel will likely remain on hold.

In May, the BSY cabinet withdrew its approval for the lease-cum-sale land deal with the company following a political tussle in which many in the BJP opposed the government's decision to sell the land. The move to hold back on cabinet confirmation on the sale was seen as Yediyurappa taking one step back to ease the ongoing power tussle in the BJP and the pressure on him.

Interestingly, the sale is a 15-year-old saga and when the Congress-Janata Dal Secular government was in power (2019), as BJP MLA, Basavaraj Bommai had opposed it vehemently. In April, the BSY cabinet okayed the deal. But in May, it reversed the confirmation, with Bommai as law minister announcing that the government would not go ahead with it. What happens now to the deal is a matter of speculation and a complex legal process. The BSY government, in going ahead with the deal, had merely obeyed a high court order, BSY's supporters said. But a fresh PIL was filed and the matter will likely go through another round of judicial scrutiny. One of BSY's prime critics, MLC A H Vishwanath had charged the former chief minister's family with having accepted bribes to "facilitate" cabinet approval.

There are many other policy decisions that Bommai will now have to take.

The new CM, supporters say, has a masterly understanding of Karnataka's river water disputes. Rather than Yediyurappa's uncompromising bluntness, Bommai will likely employ a degree of diplomacy with neighbouring states including Tamil Nadu to try to keep disputes at bay. For the

moment, it is floods that Karnataka has to contend with — but the Cauvery water-sharing dispute will eventually resurface. In 2020, Karnataka announced a five-year industrial policy that required only affidavit-based commitments by industry to set up new units. It was designed to align with recent reforms such as amendments to the Land Reforms Act, 1961, the Labour Act, and Karnataka Industries (Facilitation) (Amendment) Act, 2002. However, the implementation was held up because of Covid-19. The policy is expected to proceed apace now. "Bommai has an intricate understanding of water resources, especially hydel projects. Expect a lot of development in this field," said a supporter.

Yediyurappa had a stature in the state, given his work in the party and the organisation. But in the course of his various tenures, he also made many adversaries. Bommai, by contrast, knows the opposition well and has many friends cutting across parties — he is, after all, only a 2008 BJP entrant.

In appointing Bommai, the central BJP has shown rare sensitivity in honouring its

promise to the outgoing veteran — that no matter whom they appointed CM, it would not be a person from among the group that ran a campaign against the 75-plus leader. While organising secretary B L Santhosh's rivalry with Yediyurappa prevented him from being a replacement, others who were overtly critical of Yediyurappa were also not considered.

Bommai is a Lingayat who has been a Yediyurappa supporter consistently. Although the former CM said he would name no one as his successor, he may have indicated that Bommai would have his support. He does not consider Bommai a caste rival. In fact, supporters point to the optics — Bommai and Yediyurappa drove in the same car to the hotel where the legislature party elected Bommai as successor to Yediyurappa. "While chief ministerial aspirants like Arvind Bellad, Mureghesh Nirani and Jagadish Shettar travelled to Delhi to lobby for themselves, only smart Ganesh (Bommai) stayed back, visited Yediyurappa and became CM," said a supporter. The reference is to the mythological story where Ganesh defeated his brother Kartikeya in a competition to circle the world three times to prove himself. Kartikeya went round the world; Ganesh merely went round his parents, Shiva and Parvati, indicating they were his world.

Bommai belongs to Shiggaon and his constituency has a strong Muslim presence. It is unlikely that he will take headline positions on minority management.

On cabinet formation, Bommai has a difficult job. He will have the task of accommodating defectors from the Congress and the JDS who enabled the formation of the BJP government. He will also have to contend with the tirade of disgruntled leaders. His first challenge will be forming a council of ministers that will please everyone. The expectation is that the new council of ministers will be a judicious mix of those who supported and opposed Yediyurappa.

Elections to the assembly are due in the summer of 2023. Bommai will be working towards those.
