Stiff compliance, flash sale ban in draft norms for e-com firms

Govt proposes appointing chief compliance officer, nodal contact person mandatory for companies

The Centre is planning fresh guidelines for e-commerce companies, including appointment of a chief compliance officer, giving preference to the sale of locally produced goods, mandatory registration of e-tailers with Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), in an attempt to tighten the regulatory regime and make these companies more accountable.

A slew of amendments have been proposed under the Consumer Protection (E-Commerce) Rules, 2020 to protect the interests of consumers and encourage free and fair competition in the market, the consumer affairs ministry said on Monday. It has sought comments from relevant stakeholders by July 6. According to the proposed rules, e-commerce companies will not be allowed to organise a flash sale that allows sale of goods or services at significantly reduced prices and high discounts. Separately, the consumer affairs ministry clarified that conventional e-commerce flash sales are not banned but specific flash sales or back to back sales which limit customer choice, increase prices and prevent a level playing field are not allowed.

The proposed rules have been released at a time when DPIIT is also trying to roll out a comprehensive e-commerce policy aimed at addressing the regulatory challenges sector. A senior government official told *Business Standard* that the e-commerce policy will be implemented by making changes in the Foreign Direct Investment rules, consumer protection rules as well as Information Technology Act.

The guidelines also state that e-tailers will now have to send a notification and suggest "alternatives" before products are purchased by consumers to give a fair opportunity to goods manufactured in India. They will not only have to rank goods, but also have to come up with a framework such that the ranking does not discriminate against domestic goods and sellers.

Business Standard was the first to report that the Centre might tighten the "country of origin" norms for e-commerce players in a bid to push the sale



of locally produced goods on their platforms that could be done through amendments to the Consumer Protection Rules.

E-tailers cannot mislead consumers by manipulating search results on their platforms. They will have to ensure that marketplaces do not use any information collected through its platform for unfair advantage of its associated enterprises. Besides, no marketplace e-commerce entity shall sell goods or services to any person who is registered as a seller on its platform.

Etailers engaged in cross-selling of goods or services will have to disclose to their users, by providing the name of the entity providing data for cross-selling, as well as the data used for cross-selling on the platform. Cross-selling is a marketing practice of selling complementary products to customers, thereby getting them to purchase more. Selling products to a consumer by "deliberate misrepresentation" of information about the goods is also not allowed.

Similar to the newly notified Information Technology (Intermediary Guidelines and Digital Media Ethics Code) Rules, 2021, under the IT Act, the Consumer Protection Rules are proposing a grievance officer, a chief compliance officer and a 24x7 nodal officer to be appointed by e-commerce firms. Compliance of these requirements has already caused a storm between the government and social media firms operating in the country.

"By requiring e-commerce entities to register with the DPIIT and appoint a chief compliance officer, nodal officer and grievance officer who are citizens of (and resident in) India, the proposed rules seek to hold e-commerce entities in the country accountable. At first glance, it will be interesting to see how practically these changes are implemented," Archana Tewary, partner, J Sagar Associates.

In addition, a clause on logistics has been added: "No logistics service provider of a marketplace e-commerce entity shall provide differentiated treatment between sellers of the same category. Provided that each logistics service provider of a marketplace e-commerce entity shall provide a disclaimer including terms and conditions governing its relationship with sellers on the marketplace e-commerce entity platform, a description of any differentiated treatment which it gives or might give between sellers of the same category," the new rules propose.

Amazon India, for example, has its own logistics arm, and the provision seems to be aimed at ensuring such logistics providers are not given preference over others. "LocalCircles has done extensive work with the Department of Consumer Affairs since 2017 to bring out consumer-centric e-commerce rules and is happy to see many of those recommendations around best before dates, seller information access to consumer, etc., being included," said Sachin

Taparia, founder & chairman, community social media platform LocalCircles. "Looking at the proposed rules, however, from the lens of a small business (MSME and start-ups in the e-commerce sector) many of whom are on LocalCircles, a good bit of work still needs to be done to ensure these rules work for them, and not take away their competitive differentiators or make doing business difficult," he added.

"Every e-commerce entity shall, as soon as possible, but not later than 72 hours of the receipt of an order, provide information under its control or provide assistance to the government agency which is lawfully authorised for investigative or protective or cyber security activities," the rules said.

"Since the notification of rules in 2020, the government has received several representations from aggrieved consumers, traders and associations complaining against widespread cheating and unfair trade practices being observed in the e-commerce ecosystem....The rapid growth of e-commerce platforms has also brought into the purview the unfair trade practices of the marketplace e-commerce entities engaging in manipulating search result to promote certain sellers, preferential treatment to some sellers, indirectly operating the sellers on their platform, impinging the free choice of consumers, selling goods close to expiration etc," the ministry said.

Flipkart tells court it offers lower fee if sellers cut prices

Walmart's Flipkart sees nothing wrong in offering to cut charges for sellers on its platform if they lower product prices, its lawyer told a court on Monday, drawing protest from a retailer group challenging the practice.

Flipkart and Amazon are in a court battle against the Competition Commission of India's (CCI) bid to restart an investigation into their business practices, after a judge in early June dismissed the companies' pleas.

Both Flipkart and Amazon have for years battled accusations from brick-and-mortar Indian retailers that they bypass the foreign investment law by favouring some sellers and influencing prices of products, which are prohibited. The companies say they comply with all laws.

Arguing against the resumption of the antitrust investigation, Flipkart's counsel Harish Salve told a two-judge Bench in the

southern state of Karnataka that he sees nothing wrong in telling the sellers of Flipkart marketplace that they will be charged a lower fee, if they reduce their prices.

Referring in particular to the Hindu festival of Diwali when websites organise sales, he added: "I tell my sellers at a time like Diwali if you reduce your prices, I will give you a reduction in rent. What's wrong?"

The comments drew immediate criticism from the Confederation of All India Traders, which is party to the ongoing litigation opposing the e-commerce giants, saying the practices were prohibited under India's foreign direct investment (FDI) rules.

The comments "clearly corroborate the view and complaints made by CAIT time and again. FDI policy specifically provides that marketplace should not influence prices", said Praveen Khandelwal, secretary general of CAIT, which represents 80 million retail stores in the country.

India's foreign investment



law for e-commerce says "entities providing (a) marketplace will not directly or indirectly influence the sale price of goods or services".

A Reuters investigation in February based on internal Amazon documents showed the US firm has for years given preferential treatment to a small group of sellers, doling out discounted fees and lowering the platform fees for some to enable them to offer more competitive prices.

Amazon has said it "does not give preferential treatment to any seller". REUTERS

Facebook, WhatsApp urge HC to stay CCI notice in privacy matter

Facebook and WhatsApp on Monday urged the Delhi High Court (HC) to stay the Competition Commission of India (CCI) notice asking them to furnish certain information in relation to a probe ordered by it into the instant messaging app's new privacy policy.

A vacation bench of Justices Anup Jairam Bhambhani and Jasmeeet Singh said it will pass an order on the application.

During the hearing, the Bench said since it was sitting on a vacation Bench, it did not want to delve into the merits of the matter even as the main petitions are pending before a bench headed by the Chief Justice.

"We will pass an order. The matter will be listed on July 9 (the date already fixed for the main petitions)," the Bench said.

The case relates to the appeals of Facebook and WhatsApp against a single judge order dismissing their pleas against the probe CCI ordered into the instant messaging app's new privacy policy.

The high court had earlier issued notices on the appeals and asked the Centre to respond to it.

In their fresh applications filed in the pending appeals, Facebook and WhatsApp sought stay on the CCI's June 4 notice asking them to furnish certain information for the purpose of inquiry conducted by it.

No video call, UP Police summon Twitter MD

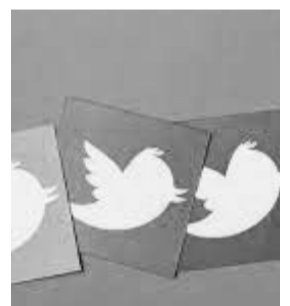

Twitter India Managing Director Manish Maheshwari has been summoned by Uttar Pradesh police for questioning on Thursday over tweets on the assault of an elderly Muslim man in Ghaziabad. This comes hours after Maheshwari had made himself available over a video call.

"You couldn't remove certain tweets even after you were asked to by authorities. You understand Indian laws and are bound to follow them," the notice said, according to the report.

As the issue spiralled into a major controversy, Twitter on Monday "withheld" 50 tweets related to the video. According to information on the Lumen database, Twitter received a legal request from the Centre on June 17, seeking action on 50 tweets.

These tweets have been withheld and the content could not be independently verified. Upon clicking on the blocked URLs listed on Lumen database, a message



saying the tweet has been "withheld in India in response to a legal demand" is displayed. According to sources, these tweets contained content related to the said video clip.

"As explained in our Country Withheld Policy, it may be necessary to withhold access to certain content in response to a valid legal demand or when the content has been found to violate local law(s)," a Twitter spokesperson said.

The spokesperson noted that the withholdings are limited to the specific jurisdiction/country where the content is determined to be

illegal. "The legal requests that we receive are detailed in the biannual Twitter Transparency Report, and requests to withhold content are published on Lumen," the spokesperson added.

Requests received by Twitter for withholding content are published on Lumen database — an independent research project studying cease and desist letters concerning online content.

The Ghaziabad Police have booked Twitter and six persons for circulating a video that claimed to have the elderly Muslim man saying he was allegedly thrashed and asked to chant "Jai Shri Ram". Police said this was done to create communal unrest. The Ghaziabad Police said the assault was a personal dispute but was being painted as a communal issue on Twitter. Some media platforms and journalists were also named in the complaint.

Maheshwari had been summoned last week for questioning by UP Police.

Maruti to hike prices in Q2, third increase this CY

The country's largest carmaker Maruti Suzuki India (MSI) on Monday said it will increase prices of its entire product portfolio in the second quarter of the current fiscal due to rise in prices of various essential commodities, including steel. This will be the third hike in 2021.

The auto major, which has already taken a price increase in April this financial year, noted that the price of steel and various precious metals has gone up considerably prompt-

ing the company to pass on some of the impact to the customers. "The prices of steel and precious metals like Rhodium and Palladium have gone up substantially. In April we passed on a part of the increased input costs to consumers thinking that the prices of these essential commodities will come down eventually. But that has not happened and as a last resort we are doing it to safeguard the company's financial health," MSI Executive Director (Sales and Marketing) Shashank Srivastava told PTI.



He noted that the price of steel has gone up from ₹38 per kg to ₹68 per kg while that of Rhodium has gone up from ₹19,000 per gram to about ₹66,000 per gram thus impacting the production cost.
