Intoxicating syrup: Three held for plotting to sell stock



Ahmedabad : Six months after seizing a huge stock of intoxicating ayurvedic syrup worth Rs 20 lakh, the Vanthali police in Junagadh district lodged an offence and arrested three persons on Thursday. On July 19 last year, the Vanthali police had got a tip-off about the stock hidden in the godown of arrested accused Asif Amreliya (52). The police had then seized 19,300 bottles of Ashvasav, 4,525 bottles of Kal Meghasav and 19,375 bottles of Kansava — all having labels of 'Sri Ayurveda Healthcare, Vadodara'. 'We will make a film which has only Deepika Padukone like Sooryavanshi, Singham and Simmba: Rohit Shetty reveals major details about Singham Again After forensic tests confirmed that the syrup contained alcohol, the Vanthali police lodged the offence and arrested Amreliya, Sujer Nagori (19), and Abbas Rauma (44). Two other accused — Feroz Chauhan, who is said to be the kingpin, and Amreliya's son-in-law Abdul Kadir Multani (33) — are on the run. The forensic examination also revealed that the accused had forged the labels of the Vadodara company which is now closed. Police investigation revealed that

Chauhan had contacted Multani informing him that he had a huge stock of this syrup and it needed to be stored somewhere. Multani in turn contacted Amreliya who offered to hide it in his godown. 'Multani then contacted Nagori and others who hatched a criminal conspiracy to sell these bottles,' said a police officer. Chauhan had sent the entire stock to Amreliya's godown in a tempo through

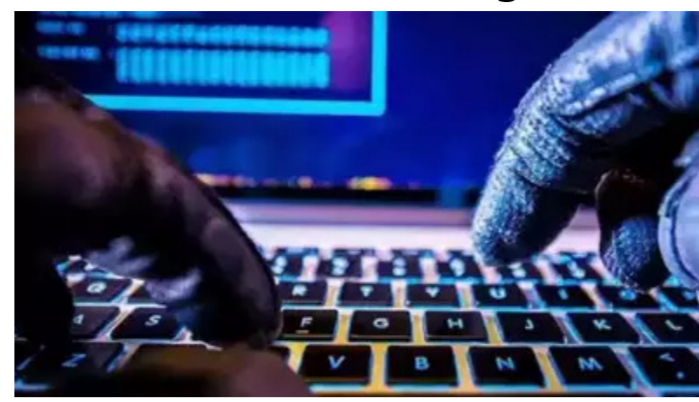
Rauma. They got the labels of the Vadodara company made and pasted them on the bottles. 'The syrup contained ethyl alcohol and isopropyl alcohol that is used in making hand sanitizers. The accused were aware that consuming it in large quantities can result in death,' the officer said. While Amreliya was tasked with hiding the stock in his godown, Nagori was told to unload the vehicle sent by Chauhan and sell the bottles. However, before they could sell the bottles, police seized the stock. All were booked under relevant sections of IPC for cheating, forgery, criminal conspiracy and adulteration and under Prohibition Act. Multani in turn contacted Amreliya who offered to hide it in his godown. 'Multani then contacted Nagori and others who hatched a criminal conspiracy to sell these bottles,' said a police officer.

Class 10 girl molested by Instagram friend

Ahmedabad : A 16-year-old girl was allegedly molested by her Instagram friend near Raiya telephone exchange in Rajkot. The accused also threatened her with dire consequences if she did not engage in a relationship with him. Police arrested the 20-year-old accused Vishal Gohil following a complaint lodged by the girl's mother. Police said the girl, who studies in class 10, and the accused had started chatting on Instagram only a few days ago. At around 4 pm on Wednesday, she told her mother that she was going to buy buttermilk at a shop near their house. However, she did not return home for a long time and her phone was also switched off. The family started searching for

her but she returned home around 8 pm. Seeing the injury marks, her mother inquired and she narrated her ordeal. According to the complaint, Gohil had called her near the Raiya telephone exchange and forced her to accompany him on his bike. He took her to an isolated lane, where he allegedly molested her. When she resisted, he brandished a knife and threatened to kill her mother if she did not agree to keep relations with him, the FIR stated. The accused also threatened her with dire consequences if she did not engage in a relationship with him. Police arrested the 20-year-old accused Vishal Gohil following a complaint lodged by the girl's mother.

Junagadh woman loses Rs 1 lakh in online hotel booking fraud



Ahmedabad : A woman from Keshod town in Junagadh lost Rs 1.11 lakh in OTP fraud to a cyber crook, impersonating as an employee of a hotel in temple town Dwarka, who offered her a huge discount on room booking and siphoned off the money from her bank account. The woman Risita Bamrotiya told the Cyber Crime police station in her complaint that her husband gave her the mobile number of a person from Lemon Tree Hotel in Dwarka and told her to book two rooms for a total of Rs 7,000. Her husband told her that the hotel was offering good discount on online room bookings. Bamrotiya spoke to the man and made by payment using Gpay. The crook then told her that she could get a partial refund of the payment on following a procedure on her mobile phone. He sent her three OTPs

and siphoned off Rs 1.11 lakh from her Union Bank of India account. Police said this was a typical case of cyber fraud where numbers of hotels and other commercial institutes are cloned on the internet. When she made the payment, her phone in all probability got cloned and the fraudster got access to it. When people make calls for inquiries, they call go to the cyber crooks who are mostly based out of West Bengal and other cyber crime hubs. The woman Risita Bamrotiya told the Cyber Crime police station in her complaint that her husband gave her the mobile number of a person from Lemon Tree Hotel in Dwarka and told her to book two rooms for a total of Rs 7,000. Four arrested for looting trader of 7L



Rajkot: Four people who had looted a Rajasthan trader of Rs 7 lakh in Bhuj on January 9 were nabbed by the Rajkot special operations group (SOG) from the city on Tuesday. Police arrested Ramzan Shah Sheikh (30), Aman Shah Sheikh (36), Ali Shah Sheikh (28) and Ishbasha Sheikh (40), and recovered Rs 2.35 lakh of the looted amount and the car used in the crime. J D Zala, inspector, Rajkot SOG said that Ramzan, Ali Shah and Aman Shah have several offences of cheating, house break-in and others registered against them in Bhuj. A complaint was lodged by the trader Kaushal Kishore Gaalav with the Bhuj B-division police on January 13. Two months ago, Gaalav came across a Facebook marketplace post by one Avinash Patel selling gold at prices much lower than the market rates. Investigation revealed there was no person by the name of Avinash Patel and it was Aman Shah who used this name to fleece people. When asked how he got gold for a lesser price, Shah told him that he deals in ships and gets cheaper gold from Dubai. He offered to sell gold for 25% less than the market price.

Meena came to Bhuj by train. However, Aman, who was speaking as Avinash Patel, told them to contact a person named Jogesh Patel who was actually Ramzan Shah. He told Gaalav that he would have to pay Rs 4.5 lakh for one tola (10 gm) gold. When Gaalav agreed, Aman and Ramzan picked them up and drove to a farmhouse in Bhuj. However, on reaching there, they brandished a knife and looted the cash. Thereafter, they pushed them out of the car and threatened to murder them if they approached the police. The duo and the other ac-

cused fled in a total of three cars. They first fled to Sasan and then to Junagadh. Later, they came to Rajkot and started living in the Geban Shah Pir Dargah area.

2 cybercrooks from WB held

Rajkot: The Jamnagar cyber crime police arrested two residents of Kolkata in West Bengal for allegedly defrauding a city-based trader of Rs 50 lakh by luring him into investing in gold, diamond and plastic. The arrested duo include Vivek Kanoria (38) and Bhagatsinh Verma (41). They had cheated trader Dhaval Shah of Rs 50 lakh lakh between March 15, 2002 and

May 19, 2022. P P Jha, inspector, at the cyber crime police station, said the duo used to initiate a conversation on WhatsApp with people and lure them with 25% returns on commodities investment. They asked people to download a mobile investment application and open a bank account. 'Initially, they used to deposit small amounts of profit in their accounts.'

Woman with learning disability raped

Rajkot: A 30-year-old woman with a learning disability was allegedly raped by her neighbour in the industrial Shapar-Veraval area of the city. The woman's sister lodged a complaint with the police against the accused Raju Vasuniya, who is a native of Madhya Pradesh. Sources said that on Jan 18, the accused noticed that the woman was alone in her hut. He entered inside and raped her, said police. Vasuniya, who was doing casual labour work, is on the run after the crime.

30 teachers go on Goa tour sans nod

Surat: Nearly 1,000 teachers of a school in Limbayat are cooling their heels at home as 30 teachers showed the audacity to go on a week-long vacation to Goa without seeking permission from the authorities.

The district education officer (DEO) has slapped a notice on Mount Mary Mission Higher Secondary School and will penalize it. The school declared a vacation for students of class 1 to class 9 from January 9 to January 14 to students as no teachers were available. After the incident, the furious parents approached the authorities and the complaint reached the DEO office. The school runs classes from nursery to standard 12 in the Mahaprabhunar area. DEO Dr. Bhagirathsinh Parmar told "After the issue came to light, we served a notice to the trustees and administrators of the school. However, they could not give satisfactory replies to why the teachers left without permission. They couldn't explain why vacation was declared when the academic term is going on."

Family grabs flat given to stay in good faith by senior citizen

Ahmedabad : Giving his three-BHK furnished flat to an acquaintance in good faith has turned into a nightmare for a 75-year-old former factory worker in the city. Jayprakash apariya lodged a complaint against Jayesh Savlani, his life Meenakshi and son Jay, under the Gujarat Land grabbing Act, after they refused to vacate the house he had given them in 2014. apariya said Savlani had approached him in 2014 for permission to live in his vacant flat saying that he had purchased a flat but was not on the possession. Sapariya allowed him to stay and did not even take any rent from him. In fact, he used to send Savlani money to pay the maintenance and electricity bills. In 2018, Sapariya went to the US where his two sons live, but got stranded due to the global Covid-induced lockdown. On returning in 2022, he asked Savlani to vacate as he and his wife wanted to shift from Jamnagar to Rajkot. Savlani sought more time saying that his residential project was stalled and the builder had returned his money. He then kept dilly-dallying on some or the other pretext. Sapariya allowed him to stay and did not even take any rent from him. In fact, he used to send Savlani money to pay the maintenance and

Diamond worker attacks teen, dies after self-immolation



Surat: In a shocking incident, a 22-year-old diamond worker has attacked a 19-year-old girl with sharp weapon and died by suicide after self-immolation in Sarthana police station area in Surat. Ankit Bhambhana went to the girl's home in the afternoon of Friday and attacked the girl and her sister. He also tried to embrace the girl after self-immolation. However, she survived and is out of danger. Assistant commissioner of police PK Patel told TOI, "Both Bhambhana and the victim had an affair for six months as they lived in Om Township of Pasodara. As the families knew about the affair, they stopped talking. Two days ago, the girl got engaged to some other boy as she stopped talking with Bhambhana."

This has not gone well with Bhambhana and he reached her home with sharp weapon and petrol-like liquid. He attacked the girl with sharp weapon and bit her sister on the hand. During the altercation, he sprayed the inflammable liquid on himself and died by suicide. He also tried to kill the girl by embracing her as she got burns on her face, hands and chest. After the incident, Bhambhana died on the spot before he was saved by the fire officials. Police has filed a complaint of attempt to murder, trespassing and also registered an accidental death case. Sarthana police inspector VL Patel said, "The victim lived with her parents, brother and sister in the township. When the incident took place, she was with her sister at home. After the burns and injuries, she was shifted to hospital for further treatment. She is out of danger." Ankit Bhambhana went to the girl's home in the afternoon of Friday and attacked the girl and her sister. He also tried to embrace the girl after self-immolation. However, she survived and is out of danger. Assistant commissioner of police PK Patel told TOI, "Both Bhambhana and the victim had an affair for six months as they lived in Om Township of Pasodara."
