CBI books its 4 personnel for taking bribe from bank fraud accused

The CBI has booked its four personnel, including two deputy superintendents of police, for allegedly receiving bribe to compromise on investigation against companies accused of bank fraud, and

started a search operation on Thursday morning at its training academy in Ghaziabad and 13 other locations, officials said. The agency did not give out much details about the case in which its own personnel are under scanner for allegedly taking huge amounts of bribe

from the accused companies in bank fraud cases being probed by them, they said. The CBI officials booked by the agency are Deputy Superintendents of Police R K Rishi and R K Sangwan, Inspector Kapil Dhankand and Steno Samir Kumar Singh, they said.

Tejas far better than China-Pak JF-17 fighter jets, says IAF Chief

Asserting that the made in India light combat aircraft Tejas is far better and advanced than the Chinese-Pakistani JF-17 fighter jets, Air Force chief RKS Bhadauria on Thursday said the latest Indian jet would be better equipped to carry out Balakot-type airstrikes.



Indian joint venture JF-17 fighter," Bhadauria said when asked to compare the Indian fighter with the JF-17.

To a query on whether the Tejas would be able to carry out Balakot-type airstrikes, the Air Chief said: "In terms of strike capability, it will have the capability of a standoff weapon which will be even beyond the capability we used that time." Noting the approval of the largest indigenous defence procurement deal to buy 83 LCA Te-

jas, Air Chief Bhadauria said that the deal is a huge step for IAF capability building, adding that the current strength of the two squadron plan of LCA will now increase to six. "Order of 83 aircraft is huge. When this kind of order takes shape in the next 8-9 years, the entire ecosystem will get set up. For military aviation, it will be a big step. It will make a big base for fighter aircraft production, maintenance and support," IAF Chief told ANI. "It is a huge step for IAF capability building. It is also a big boost to our indigenous industry. It is also a big recognition of our designers. It is a huge step for Indian Air Force and for the country," he added.

BSP labour unions oppose SAIL disinvestment plan

Labour Unions of Bhilai Steel Plant (BSP) have opposed the union government's decision of disinvesting 10% stake in Steel Authority of India (SAIL) through sale route. The Secretary, Department of Investment and Public Asset Management also made a tweet in this regard. It has heightened the temperature of Labour Unions active in Bhilai Steel Plant.

Bhilai Steel Plant is the largest steel producing plant of India capacity of producing 3.15 million tons of steel every year. Bhilai Steel Plant Employees Union leader DVS Reddy said, CITU and all the labour unions are against

the government's plan of disinvestment, will register strong protest if such a thing happens. Reddy further said, very soon all the representatives of labour unions of BSP will meet and form a strategy to stall any such move. Meanwhile, on the issue of disinvestment in BSP and SAIL, the Centre of Indian Trade Unions (CITU) also issued an official press statement and said, "CITU denounces the destructive as well as desperate move of the Govt to further divest 10 per cent shares of public sector Steel Authority of India Ltd (SAIL). This is nothing but putting the valuable national assets on auction to the detriment of national interests and for the benefits of private corporate".

who visited the spot in the evening said that a petition should be made at Calcutta High Court to ascertain the actual cause of fire. "Fire Brigade station from the place of mishap is a few kilometers away. Even then the fire tenders have arrived late. It seems that it was a pre-planned action. A petition should be filed in the High Court to find the exact reason of fire and delay of fire tenders," mentioned Sinha.
