Harrowing stories were being narrated about the plight of stranded people. A group of nurses, who included pregnant women, said they were not getting proper food or medication and were facing the threat of infection due to high occurrence of the disease around their places of stay. Private vehicle owners

were demanding up to three lakh rupees to make a trip from places like Delhi, which the stranded people said they could not afford to pay. They have made distress call to all possible contacts, but without any success.

With complaints pouring in from different cities, the Kerala authorities resumed the issuance of passes after they had briefly decided to stop the process as there was heavy build-up of traffic on the check points.

# Large number of bats killed in Rajasthan over fear of contracting coronavirus

Forest officials combat rumours, warn of legal action under Wildlife Protection Act

Rajasthan Forest Department has categorically stated that killing or injuring bats would be punished as per the provisions of the Wildlife Protection Act. This comes after incident of killing large number of bats in Rajgarh of Churu district. The incident was sparked off due to fear of the Coronavirus which is claimed to have been spread from bats.

This incident took place in the LIC office of Rajgarh where people saw several bats in the parking area when they returned to work when relaxations were announced in lockdown 3. The local administration advised them to wait for a day or two to let them fly away. But in the evening residents



from surrounding areas lit a fire and the smoke caused the bats to fall down, they then attacked them grievously. Some were reportedly killed. The forest department took charge of the bats and released them in the forest areas.

The Chief Wildlife Warden Rajathan, Arindam Tomar, then issued a strict advisory that harming bats is a punishable offence. It stated that there is no research to prove that Corona

has been caused by bats while it is a proven fact that bats play a positive role in nature by facilitating pollination and seed dispersal. It went on to say that action will be taken against those killing or trying to disperse bats from their habitat.

Confirming the same to The Free Press Journal, GV Reddy head of forest forces (HOFF) said, "An incident was reported from Churu as people linked bats to Corona and there is

a possibility of recurrence at other places as people are unaware of facts. Similar incidents were reported from Karnataka also. All animals including humans are carriers of various virus and we are called vectors. Killing bats enhances a possibility of some other outbreak."

"Bats fall under the category of Schedule 4 animals and there are several species that are quite rare. Harming them is a punishable offence Wildlife Protection Act of 1972. We have issued an advisory that causing any type of harm to them would attract penal provisions," added Reddy.

It needs to be mentioned that there are around 128 species of bats found in India and out of these as many as 25 are found in Rajasthan.

# Migrants in Rajkot allege police charged Rs 725 as train fare to UP

Migrant workers returning from Rajkot to Ballia on a special train on Saturday claimed that Gujarat Police charged them Rs 725 fare. Authorities here, however, said they had no information about it.

The train carrying 1,170 migrant workers from parts of UP reached Ballia in the morning, following



which they were screened and provided food packets. District Magistrate Hari

Pratap Shahi said.

"The migrants were then sent to their states. As many as 420 are from Ballia, while rest of them are from Prayagraj, Fatehpur, Maharajganj, Hardoi, Kushingar, Etawah and other districts," he said.

Some passengers claimed that they had to pay Rs 725 train fare to Gujarat Police, the district magistrate said, adding that he had no information on this.

## Cops rescue kidnapped child within 24 hours in Mathura

Police on Saturday rescued the three-year-old child who was kidnapped from near his house in Uttar Pradesh's Mathura district, an official said.

The child was missing since Friday morning after he went to play outside his house in Parasuram Colony in

In the early hours on Saturday, police found the child at a temple in Tabaka village which is around 10-km away from Raya, said SSP Gaurav Grover.

The six teams formed to investigate the case were in the area since Friday afternoon, he said.

The child's father, who is a 'lekhpal' (revenue official), said due to sincere efforts of police and checkposts at various places the kidnappers had to release his son.

# 225 migrant workers from Bihar reach Telangana to work in rice mills

The special train carrying 225 migrant workers of Bihar have reached Lingampally railway station in Telangana. These people came as they wanted to work in rice mills in Telangana.

"The special train which brought 225 migrant workers from Bihar reached at around 12:55 pm. These workers were willing to work in the rice mills in Telangana. After they reached here they were screened and PPE kits were later given to them," said VC Sajjanar, Cyberabad Police

Commissioner. He further said, "These

migrant workers have been sent to different locations like Peddapalli district, Jagtial district and Miryalguda district, where they will work in rice mills." Upon their arrival at Lingampally railway station, Civil Supplies Minister Gangula Kamlakar along with other officials visited the railway station to welcome the migrant labourers.

This is for the first time since the lockdown was imposed that the migrant workers willingly left their native state to work in some other state.

Speaking on the recent death of 16 migrant workers in Aurangabad, Kamlakar said, "We are saddened after hearing about the migrant labourers meeting with accidents on their way back to their homes. We request them not to walk from their residences in Telangana to their destinations because the state government is making arrangements for their safe travel to their native states. However, they can also work here at various places as few sectors have been allowed to be functional during the lockdown."

# 2 flights with 356 passengers from Dubai land in Chennai

Two evacuation flights of Air India Express to Chennai from Dubai landed at Chennai International Airport with 356 passengers and three infants on the wee hours of Saturday.

According to an official of Air India Express, the first flight IX 612 landed safely with 179 passengers and three infants at about 1.10 a.m. The second flight (IX 540) with 177 passengers landed at about 2 a.m.

According to an official of Tamil Nadu Health Department, samples for Coronavirus testing were taken from the passengers and they were sent for quarantine.

The flights are being operated as a part of the government's campaign 'Vande Bharat Mission' to bring back Indians who were stranded in foreign countries due to Covid-19 lockdown.

# Restaurants, eateries open for home delivery in Ludhiana

Restaurants and eateries in Punjab's Ludhiana opened on Saturday for home delivery with the district administration giving the green signal for it.

These relaxations will not be given in hot spot areas and containment zones. "Restaurants, eateries, ice

cream shops, sweet shops and juice shops in the district are allowed to open from 7 am to 7 pm, only for delivery," home Pradeep Kumar Agrawal, DM, Ludhiana.



No special permission will be required for the home delivery of food, yet delivery persons should follow the guidelines issued by the Punjab government, as per the order.


