of the seventh phase of general elections in June 1, when nine seats in state capital Kolkata, South 24 Parganas and North 24 Parganas are scheduled to go to the polls. This is a crucial phase for both the Bharatiya Janata Party, which performed impressively in other parts of the state but drew a blank here in 2019, and the TMC, which is looking to defend its fortress in West Bengal.

With just four days to go, Modi slammed the TMC for apparently attacking the judiciary over the high court verdict. "I was taken aback. Questions are now being raised on the intention of the judges and the judiciary. I want to ask the TMC whether they would now unleash its goons on the judges. The entire nation is watching how the TMC is throttling the judiciary," Modi said at Barasat in North 24 Parganas.

Without naming Banerjee, Modi said the court was guilty of "treachery" of the TMC. The party snatched the rights of OBC youth to support its appeasement politics and vote jihad. The TMC has betrayed the OBCs of West Bengal," he said.

The Prime Minister also said "he didn't allow any scan to take place at the Centre". "Ten years ago, I gave you a guarantee. I had khaunga, na khaunga danga. I was not a single scan to take place at the Centre in these 10 years. Now Modi is going another guarantee to the government and to West Bengal in particular. Jisne khaya hai, use bahar nikalunga aur jiska khaya hai usko main lautayunga," he said in Barasat.

Last week, the Calcutta high court scrapped OBC certificates awarded to 77 communities since 2010, an overwhelming majority of them Muslim, in West Bengal, observing that such reservations were "illegal".

"Religion in itself appears to have been the sole criterion for declaring these communities as OBCs," the court said, adding that it is "of the view that the selection of 77 classes of Muslims as backward is an affront to the Muslim community as a whole".

The state government has said that it will move the Supreme Court against the verdict. "It is quite evident that TMC doesn't like those who expose its treachery and lies... an attempt to see how the government is questioning the judiciary. Don't they have any faith in the judiciary and our Constitution?" Modi asked.

Hours later, Banerjee hit back. "A few days back 15 million OBC certificates were scrapped. I don't care if you are a lawyer too. I can't say anything against judges but I can speak against the judgement," Banerjee said on Tuesday evening in Behala.

"He will be able to call himself Prime Minister for another week or so. After that he will have to use the word former. Today he said he monitored the cyclone from Delhi. It is a blatant lie. Does it suit him? The lies are not the PM's constitutional right," Banerjee said.

She was referring to the Modi's statements in Barasat, where the Prime Minister said: "We all faced the cyclone with the blessings of Goddess Kali. The Union government was constantly monitoring the cyclone. It was also in constant touch, NDRF and other teams did a good job. The Centre is providing all help to the state".

In the evening, Modi held his first-ever road show in Kolkata. The vibrant cavalcade started from the Shyambazar crossing. He paid tribute to Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose at a state-of-the-art ambazee before starting his roadshow.

The roadshow terminated at the ancestral residence of Swami Vivekananda in Park Street in North Kolkata, with people thronging the route. Banerjee, meanwhile, walked

Lavanya Kumari, 60, from Rajapukhuri Village in Kamrup district, was killed after a tree fell on her house, according to District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA) said. In Guwahati city, a 19-year-old student, Mintu Talukdar, was killed when a tree fell on his house in Nabajyoti Nagar.

Earlier in the day, in Barapur, Modi asked the people to vote for the BJP. "Ask 100 people as to which government is coming to power, 70 would tell you that the Modi government is coming. If it is certain that the Modi government is coming so why waste votes? Your votes should be given to the Modi government and to West Bengal in particular. Jisne khaya hai, use bahar nikalunga aur jiska khaya hai usko main lautayunga," he said in Barasat.

"He said in a khaunga, na khaunga danga I will neither accept bribes nor allow others to take it from them. But he is giving the majority of the vote to the Modi government. He said he will bring back black money. But all corrupt leaders are being absorbed in the BJP which acts like a washing machine," she said.

"In light of the Red Alert for Nagaon, Hojai, West Karbi Anglong, Karbi Anglong, Golaghat, Dima Hasao, Cachar, Habra and other districts, all educational institutions in these districts will remain closed on May 29, 2024," he said in S. Several educational institutions including Assam University, Silchar and Guwahati's Cotton University, cancelled examination and classes scheduled for May 29. According to the Meteorological Department (IMD), 60 to 90mm rainfall was recorded in various parts of Assam and the state has received 450.2mm of rain in last seven days.

Dima Hasao was one of the worst-affected districts according to DDMA reports. Landslides in several areas in the district disrupted road connectivity between the three districts of Barak Valley and the rest of the state. Flight operations at Guwahati Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport (GBIA) were also impacted by the weather. Several flights were cancelled on Tuesday, especially the Airway, Assam and Silchar-bound flights, according to the authorities.

Flooding was also reported in Guwahati, Silchar and other parts of Assam. More than 50% of the Silchar town is under water and many schools, offices and households were inundated, according to DDMA, Cachar officials said. In Meghalaya, one person was killed when a wall caved in on their house on Tuesday morning at Sirtuga village in East Jaintia hills. In Assam, more than 17 people were injured in a landslide in Mawlynnoh Bypass in East Khasi Hills district, according to a bulletin by the state disaster management authority, which also said 17 villages in the state have been affected by cyclonic storm. Several looting areas of the state capital of Shillong witnessed flooding on Tuesday.

A 73-year-old man was crushed by a wall that caved in at Putsuro under Phek district in Nagaland and damage to public infrastructure, houses, agricultural fields and road blockages due to mudslides were reported on Tuesday across several districts. Officials of Nagaland State Disaster Management Authority (NSDMA) said damage reports were still being compiled at the time of filing this report.

The effects of heavy rainfall and strong winds were reported from other northeastern states, including Manipur and Tripura. IMD has forecast heavy to very heavy rainfall till June 2 in several parts of the state. Heavy rainfall has also been forecast for Mizoram for next three days.

"The number could go up. There was a abandoned stone quarry and not functional for the last three decades. Houses near the quarry collapsed," Mizoram Director General of Police Anil Shukla told PTI, adding that torrential rain was affecting the operations. President Droupadi Murmu consoled the deaths in Mizoram. "Saddened to learn about the loss of lives in stone quarry collapse near Aizawl in Mizoram. My condolences to the bereaved families. I pray for the success of rescue and relief operations and the safety of people who are injured," Murmu wrote on X.

The Statutory Auditors have conducted audit of Financial Statements. 2. The above Financial Results of the Company have been prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards (Ind-AS) as prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and with Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015, as amended from time to time. 3. Figures for the quarter ended 31st March, 2024 and 31st March, 2023 represent the derived figures between audited figures in respect of full financial year and the unaudited published year to date figures upto 31st December being the date of the end of the third quarter of the relevant Financial Year which were subjected to limited review by the statutory auditors of the Company. 4. Railway Board vide Commercial Circular No. CO60 of 2019 has increased the catering tariff for post and pre-paid trains. However, the effect of enhancement of License Fee for the periods from 18th November 2019 to 22nd March, 2020 (for post paid trains) and 27th November 2021 to 31st December, 2022 (for post and pre-paid trains) on account of increase in catering tariff stated above has not been ascertained & recognized pending sale assessment in its entirety. After the resumption of regular train services from 27th Nov 2021 onwards, the Company has conducted and completed the sales assessment, for all the trains (post-paid trains as well as prepaid trains). Further, the Company has raised certain demand notices for increased License fee, but some of the licensees have challenged the Company's decision of increased License fee in respective Hon'ble High Courts of Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata and Guwahati. Further, some of the licensees have requested for arbitration. As the matter is sub-judice and the outcome is dependent on outcome of certain event in future, the impact of increase in License fee for post and pre-paid trains has not been recognized in the financial statements for the year ended on 31st March, 2024 and for previous years up to 31st March, 2023. 5. Upto the financial year 2022-23, as per the Railway Board, the Company has provided Railway share on the profits of the Railiner segment @ 15% for plants run departmentally as well as PPP plants. Later, Railway board has advised that for Railiner plants run departmentally by the Company, the profits between IR and Company shall be shared in the ratio of 15:85 and for plants operated under PPP model/run by DCO, profits between IR and Company shall be shared in the ratio of 40:60. Accordingly, the provision for the differential amount of profit sharing @25% (40%-15%) upto 31st March, 2023 have been made for ₹ 1451.24 Lakhs during financial year 2023-24 and shown as an exceptional item in the financial results for the year ended 31st March, 2024, even though the Company has made representation to the Railway Board for sharing of profit at uniform ratio of 15:85 for all Railiner plants from 1st April, 2023. Responses from the Railway Board is awaited. During the year, provisions of Railway shares for departmentally run and PPP plants has been made @15% and 40% respectively. The company has recognized Railway Share amounting to ₹ 320.33 Lakhs being 15% of profit of departmentally run Railiner plants and ₹ 452.25 Lakhs being 40% of the profits of plants run on PPP model during the year ended 31st March, 2024 after charging Railway Share amounting ₹ 1451.24 Lakhs. 6. As per the terms and conditions of the tender, in respect of 4 PPP Railiner plants, the Developer cum Operator (DCOs) are to be reimbursed the GST on sales (net of Input Tax Credit) availed by them. In the absence of information of ITC availed by DCOs, the ITC receivable amounting to ₹ 364.83 Lakhs has been accounted for during year ended on 31st March, 2024 for two plants and in the previous year 2022-23, the impact of ₹ 442.46 Lakhs was accounted for the two plants only. These DCOs have represented against the claim of the Company for Input Tax Credit. This matter is being examined by the Management to decide on the future course of action. 7. The National Anti-Profitsharing Authority (NAAP) issued notice dated 25th February, 2022 for profiling amount of ₹5041.44 Lakhs under section 171 of the CGST Act, 2017 for not passing the benefit of tax reduction to consumers. The show cause notice was taken by the Company and matter was argued in August, 2022 but final order from Authority was awaited. However, as per the notification No. 23/2022-Central Tax issued on 23rd November, 2022 effective from 1st February, 2023 by the Government of India, Competition Commission of India (CCI) has been empowered to adjudicate the matter. The proceeding under the notice issued by NAAP regarding stands concluded and no proceedings, if any, will be commenced after by the Competition Commission of India (CCI) and as on date no communication has been received from CCI in this matter. 8. Certain Licensees who are contractors of IRCTC for providing catering services in trains availed arbitration clause seeking compensation on account of difference in rates of regular meal and combo meal as provided in terms of CC 63 of 2013 read with CC 67 of 2013 circular issued by Indian Railways and further claimed price of welcome drink provided in terms of CC 32 of 2014, for the period from 2014 till date. The arbitrator awarded a sum of ₹ 7471.65 Lakhs (approx.) in 13 petitions for the aforesaid services for the period from January 2015 to March 2020. On the basis of appraisal of the factual position, it is matter of record that the claimant never claimed said amount while submitting invoices for the aforesaid services rendered to the passengers. These all contracts are SBO contracts as were assigned to IRCTC post Catering Policy 2017. It is also a matter of record that the services were provided to the passengers of the Indian Railways and the amount so paid is required to be reimbursed to the IRCTC by the Indian Railways. In these circumstances, there will be no any liability of IRCTC as a consequence of the award and there is no need to make provision pursuant to the above awards. As the Company intends to dispute the awards and also has a right of recovery from Railways, in case the Company is held liable to pay ultimately. The Company has filed objection against Arbitral award and the Hon'ble High Court, Delhi vide Order dated 06.10.2023 directed the Corporation to deposit the awarded amount so as to stay the execution of the Arbitral award. In compliance of the aforesaid order, the Corporation deposited a bank Guarantee to the tune of ₹ 8471.65 Lakhs so as to stay the execution of the said award. It is to mention that the Hon'ble High Court, Delhi has reserved the judgment in the said matter. 9. (A) For the current financial year 2023-24, net expense on account of Exceptional Items amounting to ₹ 5853.03 Lakhs includes: (i) ₹ 5126.20 Lakhs being provision made towards revised fixed, variable and Custody charges for the two Tejas express trains w.e.f. 13th August, 2021 to 31st March, 2023 in line with the letter received from Ministry of Railways even though the Company has made representation to the Railway Board for waiver of the amount, (ii) ₹ 1451.24 Lakhs being provision made towards the differential amount of profit sharing @25% (40%-15%) upto 31st March, 2023 on profits of Railiner plants operated on PPP model and (iii) ₹ 724.41 Lakhs being excess provisions written back for previous years relating to various expenses. - The above results have been reviewed by Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors in its meeting held on 28th May, 2024. The Statutory Auditors have conducted audit of Financial Statements.
- The above Financial Results of the Company have been prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards (Ind-AS) as prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015, as amended from time to time.
- Figures for the quarter ended 31st March, 2024 and 31st March, 2023 represents the derived figures between audited figures in respect of the full relevant Financial Year and the unaudited published year to date figures upto 31st December being the date of the end of the third quarter of the relevant Financial Year which were subjected to limited review by the statutory auditors of the Company.
- Railway Board vide Commercial Circular no. CO60 of 2019 has increased the catering tariff for post and pre-paid trains. However, the effect of enhancement of License Fee for the periods from 18th November, 2019 to 22nd March, 2020 (for post paid trains) and 27th November, 2021 to 31st December, 2023 (for post and pre-paid trains) on account of increase in catering tariff stated above has not been ascertained & recognized pending sale assessment in its entirety. After the resumption of regular train services from 27th Nov 2021 onwards, the Company has conducted and completed the sales assessment, for all the trains (post-paid trains as well as prepaid trains). Further, the Company has raised certain demand notices for increased License fee, but some of the licensees have challenged Company's decision of increased License fees in respective Hon'ble High Courts of Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata and Guwahati. Further, some of the licensees have requested for arbitration. As the matter is sub-judice and the occurrence is dependent on outcome of certain event in future, the impact of increase in License fees for pre-paid and post-paid trains has not been recognized in the financial statements for the year ended on 31st March, 2024 and for previous years up to 31st March, 2023.
- Upto the financial year 2022-23, as per the Railway Board letter, the Company has provided Railway share on the profits of the Railnee segment @ 15% for plants run departmentally as well as PPP plants. Later, Railway board has advised that for Railnee plants run departmentally by the Company, the profits between IR and Company shall be shared in the ratio of 15:85 and for plants operated under PPP model/vn by DCO, profits between IR and Company shall be shared in the ratio of 40:60. Accordingly, the provision for the differential amount of profit sharing @25% (40%-15%) up to 31st March, 2023 have been made for ₹ 1451.24 Lakhs during financial year 2023-24 and shown as an exceptional item in the financial results for the year ended 31st March, 2024, even though the Company has made representation to the Railway Board for sharing of profit at uniform ratio of 15:85 for all Railnee plants till FY 2022-23. Response from Railway Board is still awaited. During the year, provisions of Railway share for departmentally run and PPP plants has been made @15% and 40% respectively. The Company has recognized Railway Share amounting to ₹ 320.33 Lakhs being 15% of profit of departmentally run Railnee plants and ₹ 452.25 Lakhs being 40% of the profits of plants on PPP model during the year ended 31st March, 2024 after charging Railway Share amounting ₹ 1451.24 lakhs.
- As per the terms and conditions of the tender, in respect of 4 PPP Railnee plants, the Developer cum Operator (DCOs) are to be reimbursed the GST on sales (net of Input Tax Credit) availed by them. In the absence of information of ITC availed by DCOs, the ITC receivable amounting to ₹ 364.83 lakhs has been accounted for during year ended on 31st March, 2024 only for two plants and in the previous year 2022-23, the impact of ₹ 442.46 Lakhs was accounted for the two plants only. These DCOs have represented against the claim of the Company for Input Tax Credit. This matter is being examined by the Management to decide on the future course of action.
- The National Anti-Profit Earning Authority (NAA) issued notice dated 25th February, 2022 for profiteering amount of ₹5041.44 Lakhs under section 171 of the CGST Act, 2017 for not passing the benefit of tax reduction to consumers. The show cause notice has been contested by the Company and matter was argued in August, 2022 but final order from Authority was awaited. However, as per the notification No. 23/2022-Central tax issued on 23rd November, 2022 effective from 1st December, 2022) by the Government of India, Competition Commission of India (CCI) has been empowered to adjudicate the matter. The proceedings under the notice issued by NAA in the reference stands concluded and no proceedings, if any, will be commenced ahead by the Competition Commission of India (CCI) and as on date no communication has been received from CCI in this matter.
- Certain Licensees who are contractors of IRCTC for providing catering services in trains invoked arbitration clause seeking compensation on account of difference in rates of regular meal and combo meal as provided in terms of CC 63 of 2013 read with CC 87 of 2013 circular issued by Indian Railways and further claimed price of welcome drink provided in terms of CC 32 of 2014, for the period from 2014 till date. The arbitrator awarded a sum of ₹ 7471.65 Lakhs (approx.) in 13 petitions for the aforesaid services for the period from January 2015 to March 2020. On the basis of appraisal of the factual position, it is a matter of record that the claimant never claimed said amount while submitting invoices for the aforesaid services rendered to the passengers. These all contracts are SSO contracts and were assigned to IRCTC post Catering Policy 2017. It is also a matter of record that the services were provided to the passengers of the Indian Railways and the amount so paid is required to be reimbursed to the IRCTC by the Indian Railways. In these circumstances, there will not be any liability of IRCTC as a consequence of the award and there is no need to make provision pursuant to the above awards. As the Company intends to dispute the awards and also has a right of recovery from Railways, in case the Company is held liable to pay ultimately. The Company has filed objection against Arbitral award and the Hon'ble High Court, Delhi vide Order dated 09.10.2023 directed the Corporation to deposit the awarded amount so as to stay the execution of the Arbitral Award. In compliance of the aforesaid order, the Corporation deposited a bank Guarantee to the tune of ₹ 8471.65 Lakhs so as to stay the execution of the said award. It is to mention that the Hon'ble High Court, Delhi has reserved the judgment in the said matter.
- (a) For the current Financial Year 2023-24, net expense on account of Exceptional Items amounting to ₹ 5853.03 Lakhs includes: (i) ₹ 5126.20 Lakhs being provision made towards revised fixed, variable and Custody charges for the two Tejas express trains w.e.f. 13th August, 2021 to 31st March, 2023 in line with the letter received from Ministry of Railways even though the Company has made representation to the Railway Board for waiver of this amount, (ii) ₹ 1451.24 Lakhs being provision made towards the differential amount of profit sharing @25% (40%-15%) up to 31st March, 2023 on profits of Railnee plants operated on PPP model and (iii) ₹ 724.41 Lakhs being excess provisions written back for previous years relating to various expenses.
- (b) For the previous Financial Year 2022-23, net income on account of Exceptional Items amounting to ₹ 2720.00 Lakhs includes: (i) ₹ 1198.59 Lakhs being excess provisions written back for previous years relating to Performance Related Pay (PRP), (ii) ₹ 1085.74 lakhs being excess provisions written back for previous years relating to Maintenance & Development charges for Internet Ticketing and (iii) ₹ 435.67 Lakhs being excess provisions written back for previous years relating to various other expenses.
- The Board of Directors of the Company has proposed the final dividend of ₹ 4.00 per share (face value of ₹ 2/- per share) subject to approval of the shareholders at the ensuing Annual General Meeting. This is in addition to the interim dividend of ₹ 2.50 per share (face value of ₹ 2/- per share) declared in the month of November, 2023, thereby making total dividend for financial year 2023-24 to ₹ 6.50 per share on the face value of ₹ 2/- per share.
- The figures for the previous year periods have been regrouped/reclassified/retained, wherever considered necessary.
- The subsidiary Company incorporated on 10th February, 2024 and hence, the consolidated figure for quarter and year ended 31st March, 2024 is given in the above results. Since, the subsidiary company does not exist till the period ended 31st December, 2023 and hence, the figures for quarter ended 31st December, 2023 and quarter and year ended 31st March, 2023 are for parent company only for comparative purpose.
