Deb: Missionary CM who wants to make Tripura visionary State

Krishak Kalyan Samarjit scheme; procurement of 9,600 metric tonnes of paddy, enabling farmers receive Rs. 12 crore for their produce and providing PM Fasal Bima Yojana cover; setting up of Krishak Bandhu Kendras in each block and under PM Kisan Samman Nidhi Rs.12 crore, provided to more than 60,000 farmers; augmenting farmers' income through animal husbandry (10,000 cows given to 5,000 families), duck rearing, fish and poultry farming; and implementing the seventh pay commission as well as transparency in recruitment for the benefit of Government employees. Pegasus flying high in Parliament

Pegasus spyware is surveillance software created by Israeli cyber intelligence firm NSO Group. The spyware is able to read the victim's SMS and emails, listen to calls, take screen shots, record keystrokes and access contacts and browser history. The allegation that is rocking the Indian parliament is that the government or a security agency under it may have been using Pegasus. The Guardian reported that "the selection of Indian numbers largely commenced around the time of Modi's 2017 trip to Israel, the first visit to the country by an Indian Prime Minister and a marker of the burgeoning relationship between two states, including billions of dollars in deals between Delhi and Israeli defence Industries." The deal has a high relevance because Pegasus is classified as a cyber weapon and any export must be approved by the Israeli Defence Ministry. It is believed that the government has purchased Pegasus. Many times the government was questioned about the purchase. It was categorically denied by the then IT minister Ravi Shankar Prasad. In one of his replies he said "if more than 45 countries are using Pegasus, why only India being targeted?" Obviously the answer is in the question itself. If the Indian government is using this system to spy on people," it is a betrayal of the constitutional compact with citizens" (Hindustan Times 21/7/21). According to media reports, the phone numbers of 40 journalists, two ministers, three opposition members, political wizard Prashant Kishor, former election commissioner, a Supreme Court Judge and a few business magnets were on a list of potential targets for surveillance at different times in the last four years. On July 18, 2021, The Wire as a part of an international collaborative investigation titled "Pegasus Project" revealed that the Israeli spyware firm NSO targeted "over 300 verified Indian mobile telephone numbers, including those used by ministers, opposition leaders, journalists, the legal community, businessmen, government officials, scientists, rights activists and others" through their spyware, Pegasus. (internetfreedom.in). The spy spree took place at different times during the last four years. Evidently the government is in a fix. No wonder Congress had a jibe at BJP calling it Bharatiya Jasoos Party- Jasoos means spy in Hindi. The revelation reveals that there is an urgent need for surveillance reform to protect the citizens against the use of such invasive technologies which hamper their fundamental right to privacy. BJP has to come clear on this. The best option is a judicial enquiry to get to the truth and punish those who are responsible for this spying mess.
