Confident of doing well against India: Hong Kong

Dubai, Aug 31:

There is always curiosity about new teams whenever they take on the giants of world cricket. Hong Kong, though not relatively new to international cricket, especially in Asia Cup as they have made their appearances in two Asia Cup tournaments, in 2004, 2008 and 2018 (all 50-over format), and played a game each against India in the two editions 10 years apart.

They were defeated by 256 runs in 2008 in Karachi, Pakistan, courtesy centuries by the two Chennai Super Kings super stars Mahendra Singh Dhoni and Suresh Raina. It was a better show 10 years later when Hong Kong made a brave attempt to chase down the 286-run target only to go down by 26 runs.

Hong Kong, who have a mix of players from Pakistan, India, England and also those born in Hong Kong but of Indian and Pakistani origin, will look to gain confidence from that performance in Dubai four years ago when they take on India in the first T20I meeting ever between the two teams at the Dubai International Stadium on Wednesday evening.

Hong Kong captain Nizakat Khan, who

has played in 51 out of his team's 52 T20 Internationals, sounded confident when he said at the pre-match briefing: "For the opportunities, any team can beat any other team on a given day. Our job is to play good cricket. We have shown that in Oman as well."

Hong Kong defeated Singapore, UAE and Kuwait in the qualifying tournament that ended on August 24 to top the table.

Khan added: "In 2018, we did really well, though we lost to India by 26 runs. If we are in that position, we will make sure that the mistakes we did in that game are not repeated. We are well prepared to take on India and Pakistan in this tournament. We played

in the T20 World Cup qualifier in Zimbabwe. The goal here is to do well in all the departments and am sure we will put up a good show."

Khan and his team coach Trent Johnston, the former Ireland captain, said that he team will get better by playing against bigger nations regularly.

"Winning and losing are part of the game. As long as we play our best cricket, that is most important. It's a massive opportunity for everyone to play India and Pakistan. I am sure we will play more Test-playing nations. We have a very young squad and this is a learning process for us. We get less opportunities. We need to make sure that we show that we are good enough to play big

teams."

Johnston said, "Hong Kong deserves to be at the big stage. The exposure we will get by playing India and Pakistan will be immense. Playing any format against any top opposition is promotion for Hong Kong cricket. We have been constantly playing since June 1. We played our best cricket in Oman and the results reflect that. We know we have a couple of levels to go up to play these teams. The aim is to play positive cricket. It is a great opportunity to show the world cricket how good Hong Kong cricket is."

Among the players to watch out for in the Hong Kong team is their captain Khan, who is 22 runs short of becoming the first player from his country to reach 1,000 T20I runs. Top-order batsman Babar Hayat scored their country's first T20I century while right-arm medium-pacer Aizaz Khan is their highest wicket-taker with 58 wickets.

From among the Indian team, captain Rohit Sharma played in both the previous matches against Hong Kong while Bhuvneshwar Kumar, Yuzvendra Chahal and Dinesh Karthik have played in the 2018 match in Dubai.

FIFA names officials for U-17 Women's World Cup

The FIFA Referees Committee officially announced the lists of the match officials who have been appointed to officiate at the forthcoming FIFA U-17 Women's World Cup India 2022. A total of 14 women referees, 28 women assistant referees, three support referees and 16 video match officials

will take charge of the matches.
