Court awards life imprisonment to two colleagues in Finance Manager murder case

Mumbai May 28 (UNI): A sessions court in Mumbai on Tuesday awarded life imprisonment to two colleagues for the murder of Kirti Vyas, a Finance Manager at BBLunt salon in Andheri, who was reported missing by her family six years ago.

Sessions Judge M G Deshpande had earlier found Siddhesh Shantaram Tamhankar and a woman colleague guilty of murder, kidnapping for murder, wrongful restraint, and destruction of evidence, among other sections of the Indian Penal Code (IPC). Tamhankar and the woman colleague sought

leniency stating that they had no criminal antecedents and had their families dependent on them. Kirti Vyas's woman colleague pleaded for leniency and said there was no evidence against her. They also submitted that the entire case was based on circumstantial evidence.

While opposing it, Special Public Prosecutor A M Chimalkar said the crime was committed with the 'coolest of minds' and that Vyas was a budding chartered accountant who was the financial pillar of her family. Vyas, aged 28 at the time, was reported missing on March 16, 2018, after she

left her South Mumbai residence for work. Nearly two months later, the police alleged that two of her colleagues were responsible for her death.

Although Vyas's body was never found, the prosecution argued that the circumstances indicated her colleagues killed her in a moving car after picking her up from her residence on the morning of March 16, 2018, over workplace-related issues. Both accused denied any involvement, never stating that they neither picked her up nor caused her disappearance.

Rahul Gandhi condoles death of MLA P N Patil

Kolhapur, May 28 (UNI): Congress leader and MP Rahul Gandhi on Tuesday condoled death of MLA Pandurang Nirvuti alias P N Patil, who passed away last week. In his condolence message sent to Rahul Patil, elder son of late MLA Patil, he said, "I am deeply saddened by sudden demise of MLA P N Patil. The Congress family has lost a leader like him who dedicated his life to public service."

Patil's commitment to Congress ideology shaped his politics, he noted and remembered how he organised the 'Sadbhavana Daud' to celebrate ideals of peace and tolerance in society for more than 30 years.

He will be remembered for his immeasurable contribution to the party especially in strengthening the Congress party in Kolhapur. Rahul Gandhi said and added that his thoughts and prayers were with late Patil's family members during these difficult times.

Candidature of Shivajirao Nalavde for Council's biennial poll: NCP (AP)

Mumbai, May 28 (UNI): Maharashtra NCP (AP) president. Sunil Tatkare, announced on Tuesday that Shivajirao Nalavde will be party candidate from Mumbai Teacher's constituency for biennial election to Maharashtra Legislative Council due to be held on June 26.

The name of Nalavde, who is Mumbai working president, was announced in the parliamentary board meeting held here in the presence of NCP national president and Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar, national working president Prashant Patel, state president Sunil Tatkare, Mumbai Divisional president Sameer Bhubhal.

Nalavde is former chairman and current director of Mumbai Bank. His contribution to the cooperative movement is also valuable.

Congress MLA meets Sassoon Hospital dean in Pune car accident case

Pune, May 28 (UNI): Congress MLA Ravindra Dhangekar on Tuesday met dean of Sassoon Hospital in connection with recent Pune car accident case.

The meeting happened after allegation of blood samples of accused involved in car accident being switched surfaced.

During the meeting, he advised hospital authorities not to succumb to pressure from anyone and bring facts before society. Later, talking to

reporters, Dhangekar said, "I have met the dean of Sassoon Hospital today and asked him not to succumb under pressure of anyone, bring facts before society, since it is a matter concerning citizens of the country."

The Congress MLA also asked dean to complete investigation and submit a report as soon as possible.

He said that police have seized money from person allegedly involved in changing of blood samples

of minor accused who killed two innocent pedestrians while driving his car under influence of alcohol.

While raising issue of appointment of two doctors who were arrested by police yesterday (on Monday) on charge of alleged manipulation of blood samples, he alleged that one of doctors Ajay Tare got the post because he was close to a minister.

Tare indulged in wrongful activities by changing blood samples of

accused while being on an official leave, he claimed and demanded for an in-depth probe into the matter.

Dhangekar said that an employee of Sassoon Hospital working in blood samples department is reportedly not reachable and police are searching for him since that day, he said.

Meanwhile, NCP (SP) MP Supriya Sule has demanded for a review of the working of Sassoon Hospital and issue a white paper.

'Let CBI investigate Pune car accident case'

Mumbai, May 28 (UNI): Maharashtra Pradesh Congress Committee (MPCC) president, Nana Patole, on Tuesday strongly demanded that in Pune, the minor son of a rich person crushed two people under his car, before incident he had consumed alcohol and was accompanied by the son of an MLA.

The name of the MLA should be declared, he demanded. In this incident, Deputy Chief and Home Minister Devendra Fadnis used his own law degree to save accused, he claimed.

On Dr Taware of Sassoon Hospital who changed accused's blood samples, he alleged that a minister and an MLA had recommended that Dr Taware should be made

superintendent. Hence, people should know the names of that MLA and minister, he demanded and recalled that previously, all facilities were provided to drug mafia Lalit Patil in Sassoon hospital, from where he finally escaped.

After the car accident case, 36 illegal pubs in Pune were demolished, he said while expressing serious concern about spread of illegal drug racket in Pune.

BJP has committed sin of running youth by bringing large quantities of drugs from Gujarat to Maharashtra, he alleged and claimed that interference of ruling party has increased and criminals are roaming freely in the city.

The Chief Minister should make his stand clear in this case, he demanded and said as the role of Home minister Fadnis is also doubtful, he should resign from the post. Even in Nagpur, Home minister's city, two girls were crushed to death under a car by two youths, but they got bail within 10 hours, he noted.

In Jalgaon too, a similar case was reported, and an attempt was made to save the accused, Patole charged.

LoP criticises Maha Govt over issue of seeds
