We did not review the interim financial information / financial results of forty one subsidiaries included in the consolidated unaudited financial results, whose interim financial information / financial results, before consolidated adjustments, reflect total assets of Rs. 513,784.35 lakh as at September 30, 2019 and total revenues of Rs 58,723.17 lakh and Rs 117,021.41 lakh for the guarter and six months ended September 30, 2019 respectively, total net (loss) after tax of Rs 886.91 lakh and Rs. 2,045.89 lakh for the guarter and six months ended September 30, 2019 respectively and total comprehensive loss of Rs 1,518.33 lakh and Rs 2,366.85 lakh for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2019 and net cash inflow of Rs. 8,736.77 lakh for the six months ended September 30, 2019, as considered in the Statement. These interim financial information / financial results have been reviewed by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management and our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries is based solely on the reports of the other auditors and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above.

Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of these matters.

7. The consolidated unaudited financial results includes the interim financial information/ financial results of two subsidiaries which have not been reviewed by their auditors, whose interim financial information/ financial results reflect total assets of Rs. 4.15 lakh as at September 30, 2019, total revenue of Rs Nil and Rs Nil for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2019 respectively, total profit after tax of Rs Nil and Rs Nil for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2019 respectively and Total comprehensive income of Rs Nil and Rs Nil for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2019 respectively and net cash inflows (net) of Rs. Nil for the six months ended September 30, 2019, as considered in the Statement. According to the information and explanations given to us by the Management, these interim financial information / financial results are not material to the Group.

Our Conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of our reliance on the interim financial information / financial results certified by the Management.

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Notes to Standalone and Consolidated Unaudited Financial Results for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2019:

- 1. The Audit Committee has reviewed the above results and the Board of Directors has approved the above results and its release at their respective meetings held on November 14, 2019. The Statutory Auditors of the Company have carried out a limited review of these results.
- 2. Based on the information reviewed by the Chief Operating Decision Maker (CODM), the Company has single operating segment, being integrated post-production services.
- 3. Pursuant to the shareholders' approval, a business transfer agreement (the "BTA") has been executed subsequent to the period end, between Prime Focus Limited (the "Company") and DNEG Creative Services Limited, a subsidiary of the Company ("DNEG"), for sale of the Company's VFX business on a slump sale basis, for a consideration of Rs. 27,000 lakhs, subject to closing conditions as specified in the BTA.
- 4. Some of Indian subsidiaries of the Group have elected to exercise the option permitted under section 115BAA of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as introduced by the Taxation Laws (Amendment) Ordinance, 2019. Consequently, remeasurement of deferred tax assets and liability position of such companies' basis the rate prescribed under the aforesaid section, has resulted in recognition of net reversal of deferred tax expense of Rs. 2,235 lakhs for the six months ended September 30, 2019.
- 5. The Group has adopted Ind AS 116 on "Leases" with the date of initial application being April 1, 2019. Ind AS 116 replaces Ind AS 17 on "Leases" and related interpretation and guidance. The Group has applied Ind AS 116 using modified retrospective approach, under which the cumulative effect of initial application is recognised in retained earnings as at April 1, 2019. As a result, the comparative information has not been restated.

On transition to Ind AS 116, the Group recognised right-to-use assets amounting to Rs 57,230.82 lakhs [Rs 2,881.54 lakhs], lease liability amounting to Rs 61,169.81 lakhs [Rs 2,992.74 lakhs] and Rs 2,831.64 lakhs (debit) [Rs 111.20 lakhs (debit)] in retained earnings as at April 1, 2019. The Company has discounted lease payments using the applicable incremental borrowing rate as at April 1, 2019 for measuring the lease liability.

During the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2019, the Company has recognised interest expense on lease liabilities amounting to Rs 907.91 lakhs [Rs 86.04 lakhs] and Rs 1,812.09 lakhs [Rs 171.92 lakhs] respectively and depreciation on right-of-use assets amounting to Rs 1,590.51 lakhs [Rs 156.57 lakhs] and Rs 3,228.35 lakhs [Rs 299.83 lakhs] respectively. Consequently, rental expenses are lower by Rs 2,133.42 lakhs [Rs 175.67 lakhs] and Rs 4,368.56 lakhs [Rs 350.87 lakhs] respectively.

* figures in brackets are pertaining to standalone financial results of the Company.

6. The standalone and consolidated statement of cash flows for the six months ended September 30, 2018 as reported in these financial results have been approved by the Company's Board of Directors, but have not been subjected to review by the auditors.
