Monsoon to be normal in Aug-Sept, says IMD

New Delhi, August 2

INDIA METEOROLOGICAL DEPARTMENT (IMD) on Monday predicted that the monsoon would be 'normal' during August-September. However, a possible emergence of La Nina in the Pacific Ocean from October may prolong the monsoon season and bring in more rains during the harvesting period, potentially damaging some kharif crops, analysts warned.



over most parts of peninsular India, home to plantation crops like rubber and coffee, and soybean, cotton and pulses growing central region during August-September.

Pan-India precipitation was 1% below the benchmark (LPA) during June-July, even though there was a 7% deficit in July, the wettest of the four-month season that is crucial for summer crop sowing. The precipitation was 10% above LPA in June. Normally, 65% of the sowing takes place in July while the remaining 35% of 107-million-hectare normal kharif acreage gets covered in June and August-September.

As most of the global models forecast the emergence of the La Nina condition from October-November (currently ENSO neutral), there could be more rains in India during that period, which might adversely im-

pact crops ready for harvesting.

Last year, the monsoon retreated from the country on October 28, the second-most delayed exit since 1975, and as a result, soybean crops got damaged by heavy rains in Madhya Pradesh during September-October. In 2010, the southwest monsoon withdrawal got completed on October 29. The normal monsoon withdrawal date is October 15. Coincidentally, both 2010 and 2020 had La Nina.

Since 2016-17, the country's foodgrains output (comprising rice, pulses and coarse cereals) during kharif season has been hitting new records every year. During the 2020-21 kharif season, the production was 148.4 million tonne, 3.2% higher than a year ago.

El Niño, which is associated with warmer-than-average sea surface temperatures in the central and eastern tropical Pacific Ocean, normally brings lower monsoon rainfall. It develops when the surface temperatures of the Pacific rise above normal. La Nina is opposite of El Niño and occurs when sea surface temperatures in the Pacific Ocean drops below average.

SC seeks states' reply on use of scrapped Section of IT Act

THE SUPREME COURT on Monday sought response from all States, Union Territories and high courts over the continued filing of FIRs under the scrapped Section 66A of the Information Technology Act.

Section 66A was declared unconstitutional by the Supreme Court in a judgment in 2015.

A bench led by Justice RF Nariman issued sought a response from all States and Union Terri-

tories and Registrar General of all High Courts within four weeks in the matter. The bench noted that since the police is a state subject, it will be better than all the state governments and UTs are made party. "Police is a state subject. We will issue notice and pass comprehensive orders. This cannot continue. Judiciary we can take care separately but police are also there," Justice Nariman said.

States and their agencies share an "equal responsibility" to ensure that people are not

booked by the police under Section 66A of the Information Technology Act for expressing themselves freely on social media, the Centre submitted in an affidavit to the Supreme Court.

Senior counsel Sanjay Parikh, appearing for People's Union for Civil Liberties, an NGO, said that there are two aspects in this matter, one is police and the other is judiciary where such cases are still being tried.

The Centre in its reply to the Supreme Court had stated that States and their agencies share

an "equal responsibility" to ensure that people are not booked by the police under Section 66A for expressing themselves freely on social media. "Prevention, detection, investigation and prosecution of crimes and capacity-building of the police are primarily the responsibility of the States," the Centre submitted in the affidavit, adding that the law enforcement agencies share equal responsibility to comply with the apex court judgment. They take action against cybercrime offenders as per the law.

SC seeks response from Morepen Labs in 2003 case

THE SUPREME COURT on Monday admitted the Securities and Exchange Board of India's (Sebi) appeal against the Securities Appellate Tribunal's (SAT) order that set aside regulator Sebi's order barring Delhi-based pharmaceutical company Morepen Laboratories from the securities markets for one year for making misleading disclosures about the issuance of global depository receipts (GDRs) way back in 2003.

A Bench led by Justice Indira Banerjee issued notice to Morepen Labs and posted the matter for further hearing on

September 9.

Stating that SAT had failed to consider its explanation for the purported delay, senior counsel CU Singh, appearing for Sebi, argued that that the apex court had in 2015 upheld its jurisdiction to debar the entities for violation of its Sebi (Prohibition of Fraudulent and Unfair Trade Practices) relating to securities market) Regulations, 1995 (PFUTP) in respect of GDRs whose underlying shares are held with depositories based in India.

Counsel Somasekhar Sundaresan, appearing for Morepen Labs, however, opposed Sebi appeal, saying that the GDR issue took place in 2003 and the show

cause notice was issued in 2017, after so much delay.

Sebi told the SC that it had in 2009 investigated 59 GDR issues made by 51 Indian companies including Morepen Labs during 2002 to 2014. For this, the market regulator had even approached foreign regulators in procuring information as transactions were carried outside India. "The entire process of collection of information was complex, tedious and time-consuming. Consequently, the investigation in the GDR issue made by Morepen got completed around March 2017," it stated in its appeal filed through counsel Pratap Venugopal.

Mitra writes to FM against privatisation of insurance companies

WEST BENGAL FINANCE Minister Amit Mitra wrote to Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman, urging her not to go ahead with the privatisation of public insurance companies.

He said the move to privatise has brought a great sense of insecurity and distress among the people of the country.

"May I express my shock and alarm at the policy decision of the Government of India venturing to privatise public sector insurance companies which are the pillars of the economy," Mitra said in the letter.

The government plans to privatise public general insurer United India Insurance Company

in the first instance as well as sell-off Life Insurance Corporation (LIC), considered to be the fulcrum of financial security for most of the Indians, he said.

Privatisation of LIC, which has a massive quantum of investments in the economy running into ₹36.76 lakh crore, will open up a 'Pandora's Box' and throw into insecurity 30 crore policyholders, he said.

The privatisation of United India Insurance will cause major disruption and destabilise the future of almost two crore retail insurers, Mitra added. The privatisation will initiate hydra-headed financial problems while undermining the confidence of the common retail insurers of the poorer sections of the society, he said.



NHAI's total borrowing rises to ₹3.06 lakh crore in March

THE TOTAL BORROWINGS of the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) increased to ₹3,06,704 crore in March this year from ₹74,742 crore in March 2017, the government said on Monday.

Replying to a question in the Rajya Sabha, road transport and highways minister Nitin Gadkari said since 2017, NHAI has availed external borrowing to the tune of ₹3,000 crore. The minister informed that the amount of interest paid by the NHAI in 2020-21 was ₹18,840 crore.

As of date, there are 140 arbitration cases pending before various arbitral tribunals, wherein an amount of ₹91,875.70 crore of the contractors/concessionaires claims and ₹44,600 crore of NHAI's counterclaims are involved for adjudication, he said in a written reply.

Further, there are 240 cases pending before the courts wherein ₹21,601 crore is involved. Responding to another question, Gadkari said the Centre has not notified green tax on older vehicles. मुंबई : केंद्र सरकारकडून अद्यापही पुरेसा लसपुर्ववटा उपलब्ध होत नसून २० लाख नागरिक दुसऱ्या मात्रेच्या प्रतीक्षेत असल्याचा दावा राज्य सरकारने सोमवारी उच्च न्यायालयात केला.



पहाटेपासून रांगा लावूनही नागरिकांना लस मिळत नसल्याचा आणि कोविन अपहारे केल्या जाणाऱ्या लस नोंदणीत त्रुटी असल्याचा आरोप करणाऱ्या याचिकेवर सोमवारी सुनावणी झाली. त्या वेळी आतापर्यंत ११.२३ कोटी नागरिकांचे लसीकरण झाले असून त्यातील ३.३५ कोटी नागरिकांनी लशीची पहिली, तर दीड कोटी नागरिकांनी दोन्ही मात्रा घेतल्याची माहिती राज्य सरकारतर्फे न्यायालयाला देण्यात आली. त्यावर लशीचा अद्यापही तुटवडा असल्याबाबत मुख्य न्यायमूर्ती

नवी मुंबई : ऐरोली सेक्टर १० येथील सागर दर्शन सोसायटीमध्ये राहणाऱ्या दोन बहिणींनी गळफास घेऊन आत्महत्या केल्याची घटना सोमवारी संध्याकाळी समोर आली आहे. आत्महत्येचे कारण अद्याप स्पष्ट झालेले नाही. ऐरोली सेक्टर १० येथील सागर दर्शन सोसायटीमधील बिल्डिंग नं १५ मध्ये वास्तव्यास असणाऱ्या लक्ष्मी पंथारी (३३) व स्नेहा पंथारी (३१) या दोघींनी आत्महत्या केली आहे. या दोघीही शिकवणी घेऊन उदरनिर्वाह करीत होत्या. दोन दिवस दरवाजा बंद आढळल्याने आणि दुर्गांधी सुटल्याने आसपासच्या रहिवाशांनी दरवाजा ठोठावला. परंतु प्रतिसाद मिळाला न मिळाल्याने पोलिसांशी संपर्क साधण्यात आला. दरवाजा तोडल्यावर आतमध्ये दोघींचे गळफास घेतलेल्या अवस्थेत मृतदेह आढळून आले, अशी माहिती खाळे पोलिस ठाण्याचे वरिष्ठ पोलीस निरीक्षक योगेश गावडे यांनी दिली.
