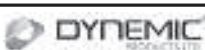

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana is a government scheme launched in compliance with 'Housing for All (HFA)' mission. The Gujarat government has ensured that no one should stay homeless in the State. Along with housing, provision is even made for water connection, toilet facilities and 24*7 power supply.

Whether one is living in a city or village, what is more of concern is that one should have a home for shelter. Housing is one of the basic needs of each human being. Along with water and food, it is the shelter of utmost need. Shelter is the dream of many, a place that one can call home. The Prime Minister envisioned Housing for All by 2022 when the Nation completes 75 years of its Independence. In order to achieve this objective, the Central Government has launched a comprehensive Mission "Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) - "Housing for All Mission". A Gujarat Government is focusing sincerely to meet this need and provide housing to poor and needy people in the State.

Due to inclusive development, people from many regions of industry, trade, business and foreign countries have come and settled in Gujarat. Integrated Gujarat model is providing livelihood to a huge number of people. However, not each one of them can fulfill hopes of having their own home. For low-income households in today's era of inflation, building your own home is like a dream. In order to fulfill their dreams, a common person is working hard, to meet both ends and save most of his life earnings during the time of ever-increasing land prices and paying for loans.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has brought a huge change in the housing sector, in a way that poor can get their own house. PM has written to a beneficiary of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) under which



subsidized housing is provided to the urban poor, saying houses are not just brick and mortar structures but instill confidence about a better tomorrow. He made sure about 'pucca' houses for poor and said that the houses have also become "symbol of women empowerment". Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana to provide Housing for All has been launched under his inspiration. He brought the RERA Act, which took care of homebuyer's interest. Reforms in Home loans eased by the Banking sector, has made it easier for the Lower and Middle class. It creates a quality lifestyle, shelter and security that we have a house of our own. State Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel is ensuring that Housing is provided for poor and needy people of Gujarat state. **They are pushing this plan with determination to make every person live in a good home.**

Gujarat ranks first

Under the Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP) component, Yearly monetary assistance of Rs 3 lacs from Government (Rs 1.50 lacs from Central Government and State 1.50 lacs) is provided to homeless families with an annual income of Rs 3 lacs for housing. Under this component, construction of more than 1 lacs housing units has been completed

Slum dwellers on government lands in urban areas are provided free of cost housing under In-Situ Slum Redevelopment (ISSR). The housing is Comfortable and provided at a nominal cost. Over 15,000 housing units have been completed under this component.

Families owning land or raw house in urban areas, with annual income upto Rs 3.00 lacs can avail Rs 3.50 lacs for housing construction Under Beneficiary Led Construction (BLC). Under this plan, 53,000 housing units have been completed under this plan. Under Credit Link Subsidy (CLSS) (central sector component) interest subsidy of up to Rs 2.67 lacs is provided on loans taken for first housing upto 60 sq. m in urban areas. More than 4.45 lacs beneficiaries have benefits with Rs 10,200 crores interest assistance. Gujarat ranks first under this component.



Under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana, Gujarat is a leading State in the country; it sets an example for other States to follow.

Gujarat is the leading state in the country in urban planning with a total of 8.61 lacs houses sanctioned against the target of 7.64 lacs houses. Out of which construction of 6.24 lacs houses has been completed

Salutes for Shelter

In accordance with the Prime minister's vision of "Housing for All", the Gujarat government has been efficiently implementing PRADHAN MANTRI AWASYOJANA to provide a home to every homeless person in the state.

Under the plan, Eligible Households in Rural Areas or people with raw houses are provided financial assistance for the construction of new houses. Construction work of 3,50,998 houses has been completed so far under the scheme (Rural). Each beneficiary will get financial assistance of Rs 12000 for the construction of the toilet per dwelling under Swachh Bharat Mission. It was also decided to provide Rs 5000 per beneficiary for housing and construction of toilets under PMAY (Rural), as many as 9000 beneficiaries have availed it.

Ranavav Taluka of Porbandar district secured second place for the same award in 2019-20.

The Gujarat government under the leadership of Bhupendra Patel has been working hard to ensure that the poor get a home to live in. Method of allotment of houses is transparent and done with the draw system. The subsidy received by these is deposited in their account through DBT (Direct Benefit Transfer) To sum up, it is a matter of appreciation and salutation to the Gujarat government making every effort to provide shelter to poor and needy people of the State.

- Slum rehabilitation of Slum Dwellers with participation of private developers using land as a resource.
- Promotion of Affordable Housing through Credit Linked Subsidy.
- Affordable Housing in Partnership with Public & Private sectors.
- Subsidy for Beneficiary-Led individual house construction /enhancement.
- The Ministry of Rural development, Government of India awarded first place to Dang of Gujarat in 2018. The same award secured second place by Ranavav Taluka of Porbandar district.
- 15,000 housing units have been completed under-Situ Slum Redevelopment (ISSR). The slums are provided on-site affordable housing.
- Lacs of houses have been constructed under Affordable housing in Partnership (AHP)
- Under Beneficiary Led Construction (BLC), 53000 housing units have been completed.
- Encourages women to be homeowners or co-applicant.
- Compulsory ground floor accommodation for senior citizens and differently-abled.
