AAP says poll diaries manipulated, Delhi election body denies charge

New Delhi May 18
The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) on Friday alleged that the Delhi election commission had been manipulating poll diaries, while the Election Commission denied it.

The AAP claimed, however, that the Delhi election commission had been manipulating by persuading officials in the South Delhi constituency to mark the national capital voted on May 12.

The poll commission, however, refuted the allegations and said the Delhi election commission had met senior leaders of the AAP on Saturday to clear their doubts.

After arranging a press conference on Friday, AAP spokesperson Rakesh Kapoor said that the party had received "credible information" about the allegations and that an inquiry was being levied by the EC and the police.

Both the leaders, however, did not substantiate their claims with evidence.

Both the leaders agreed to meet formally on Saturday at a booth on polling day on Saturday, May 18, western zone Singh Sabha Chowk, in New Delhi.

In question of changing poll diaries, as the original copy is with both the EC and the EVM, the AAP claimed that the party's complaint to the election commission was filed on May 16.

A senior poll official said that the returning officers (ROs) were given the powers to summon polling officers in case any irregularities were found.

"Every booth has a copy of the activities and work done by the election team there," he said. "On May 16, there was a meeting between the EC and the ROs after Delhi's polling day. The EC told the returning officers were called in asked to make fresh poll diaries if any irregularities were found.

"The counting day, the EC would go and check if the number of polled voters in each EVM and copy of the EC was correct. If not, the EC would ask the RO to call the polling agents who were present in that station and ask them to make fresh poll diaries," he said.

The AAP is apprehensive of the EC's role in the Lok Sabha elections in 2019.

The AAP leaders alleged that in the past few days presiding officers from Ambedkar Nagar and Bodh Gaya constituencies had been called.

Nitin Srivastava, the returning officer of the Bodh Gaya constituency, said "misinformation" as being spread against the AAP and EVMs. AAP leaders are already in the strong room.

A three-officer security team, consisting of a police constable, a middle layer by armed police and main layer from Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) — has been put in place to guard the strong room.

Firefighters rescue 18 from a burning Daryaganj building

A team of fire fighters from Delhi Fire Service saved the lives of 18 persons who were stuck in their flats during a fire in Daryaganj after a car in the ground floor parking caught fire. Fire fighters had to climb through a ladder. No causalities were reported in the incident.

When according to the chief fire officer, the control room received a call reporting the fire at 4.00 am on Friday. When a team of fire fighters reached the spot, they found

said. Four other cars and two residents were also parked there but had not caught fire.

Gang said that the team reached the site at least 15-18 minutes after the fire started in the building, and therefore called for additional manpower.

North corp writes to Delhi govt: Asks for ₹ 385 cr for first quarter tax dues

A day after a dozen doctors at Hindu Rao Hospital distanced themselves over alleged doings in the hospital, the North Corporation (NCP) has written to the Delhi government to provide it the first quarter of its tax dues — ₹385.60 crore — immediately as it is facing a financial crisis, state-owned corporation officials said on Friday. The resident doctors at the hospital have alleged that they have not been paid salaries since March. The city health officials said that the corporation had not paid the salaries to the doctors. The North Corp's financial position for the year 2019-20 is ₹1,045.60 crore. The doctors in their letter to the corporation said that this is ₹385.60 crore that should have come by now, officials said. As per rules, the first instalment is 25% of the sanctioned amount and the second instalment is 75% of the sanctioned amount. The second instalment for the first quarter is 25% of the amount and comes in September. The third instalment in the remaining 25% dues comes in March of the next year. The letter, dated May 15, has been sent to the North Corp, which is under chief executive officer Arunil Kapoor in this regard. "As you are well aware of the financial position of the corporation, we request you to provide the first quarter dues to the corporation to pay the salary of the staff and other statutory obligations as per the provisions of the DMC Act," the letter says. The money is required for the first quarter. North Corporation had claimed the current year 2019-20 is requested as the corporation is yet to pay salary to its teachers, sofa manufacturers, doctors nurses and other staff of the hospital. The corporation had claimed 2019, besides the pension of the retired employees, it has
