AAP says poll diaries manipulated, Delhi election body denies charge

Delhi The Assam Aom Party (AAP) on Friday alleged that the state election commission had got polling diaries manipulated by planting officers in the South Delhi parliamentary seat after the general election voted on May 12.

The poll commission, however, refuted the allegations and said the Delhi chief election officer would meet some leaders of the AAP on Saturday to clear their doubts.

Addressing a press conference on Friday, AAP spokesperson Anurabh Khanna said the party had received 'credible information' about alleged poll code violation. The same allegation was levelled by AAP South Delhi candidate Rishabh Chaudhary who said that polling officers were being summoned by the EC and are being asked to 're-verify' and 're-sign' EVM related documents. Both the leaders, however, did not substantiate their charges with any concrete evidence.

Polling diaries are used to maintain a record of the poll data. On Saturday, AAP leaders Sangjee Singh and Rishabh Chaudhary met the party's complaint to the chief election commissioner and the Delhi CEO.

A senior poll official said that the return officer (RO) are well within their powers to summon polling officers in case any discrepancy is noticed on the audit of books. There is no question of changing the poll diaries, as the original copy and both sets of the poll diaries, one with the polling agents, will copy in the strong room with EVMs, the official said.

Every booth has a presiding officer who controls the activities and work done by the election team there. We have credible information that on May 12, three days after Delhi's polling day, about 200-250 presiding officers were called and asked to make fresh polling diaries, which they signed again, until Monday.

The AAP leader alleged that in the past two days presiding officers from Anurabh Khanna and Rishabh Chaudhary constituencies had been called.

Sudha Srivastava, the returning officer of South Delhi constituency said 'manipulation' is being proved by politicians. The AAP on Friday said that the AAP is starting a deficit and hence were sending bogus allegations.

The BJP said that the ruling party in Delhi has a habit of blaming the election commission and the voting process, as it had done by blaming the EVMs responsible for the manipulated election in 2012.

Delhi BJP media in-charge Praveen Kanti said 'by leveling charges against the election commission, they have proved that manipulation of the part of state politics. The AAP is apprehensive of its defeat in the Lok Sabha elections.'

Firefighters rescue 18 from a burning Daryaganj building



A fire at Daryaganj building. A team of fire fighters from Delhi Fire Service saved the lives of 18 persons who were rescued to their fire-resistant building in Daryaganj after a fire in the ground floor parking caught fire, blocking the only way out during the early hours of Friday.

New Delhi May 18 A team of fire fighters from Delhi Fire Service saved the lives of 18 persons who were rescued to their fire-resistant building in Daryaganj after a fire in the ground floor parking caught fire, blocking the only way out during the early hours of Friday.

While residents on the first and second floors were made to jump on the mattresses, others stuck on the floors above had to be held with a rope and were brought down through a ladder. No casualties were reported in the incident.

According to the chief fire officer, Ajit Garg, the entire room received a call reporting the fire at 1:45am.

Four other cars and two two-wheelers were also parked there but they were not affected by the fire.

Garg said that the team realised that at least 15-18 people are trapped in the building and therefore called for additional manpower. Many fire-fighting and assistant fire-fighting officers from the Connaught Place fire station who was also rushed to the spot to manage the rescue operation, and since the fire was in the front of the building, we got a ladder on the roof and our men got onto the first floor.

They were pushed into the houses and took out all the mattresses which we rolled over on the ground floor. As the fire was got to spread to the first floor, the occupants were asked to come down to the first floor and were made to jump over the mattresses. However, we had only rescued seven people from the first floor and the fire had reached the first floor through a short, said Khanna, because of the rescue operation.

The remaining portion of the building was then taken to the fourth and fifth floor. While some of them were made to sit on the building, others were held from the side along with two children had managed to get onto the terrace of an adjacent building to save themselves.

The plea, said around 3,000 doctors, including residential doctors working for the civic authorities, have gone on strike due to the non-payment of salaries for two months.
