Communication to Shareholders - Communication on Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) on dividends and Updation of Email Address and Contact Details

Date: August 26, 2023

Dear Shareholder,

We hope that you and your family are doing well and are safe and healthy.

We are pleased to inform you that the Board of Directors at their Meeting held on May 30, 2023 has recommended a Final Dividend of Rs. 2.25/- per equity share of the face value of Rs. 5 each i.e. 45% for the Financial Year ended March 31, 2023 and the said Final Dividend will be payable to the shareholders holding shares as on September 11, 2023 (Record date fixed for dividend payment) post approval of the shareholders at the ensuing Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Company to be held on Monday, September 18, 2023.

As you may be aware, the Finance Act, 2020 has abolished the Dividend Distribution Tax (DDT) and has introduced the system of dividend taxation in the hands of the shareholders with effect from 01 April 2020. Accordingly, the Company would be required to deduct Tax at Source ('TDS') in respect of approved payment of dividend to its shareholders (resident as well as non-resident).

The TDS rate may vary depending on the residential status and the documents submitted to the Company in accordance with the provisions of the Act. The TDS for various categories of shareholders along with required documents are provided in Table 1 and 2 below:

Please Note that:

- Recording of the valid Permanent Account Number (PAN) for the registered Folio/DP ID-Client ID is mandatory. In absence of valid PAN, tax will be deducted at a higher rate of 20% as per Section 206AA of the Act.
- Shareholders holding shares under multiple accounts under different status / category and single PAN, may note that, higher of the tax as applicable to the status in which shares held under a PAN will be considered on their entire holding in different accounts.

The Shareholders holding shares under multiple accounts under different status / category and single PAN, may note that, higher of the tax as applicable to the status in which shares held under a PAN will be considered on their entire holding in different accounts.

Kindly note that the documents as mentioned in the Table 1 and 2 above are required to be submitted to the Company / Registrar at email ID landmarkdivtax@linkintime.co.in with Subject “Tax Exemption related documents” on or before September 11, 2023 in order to enable the Company to determine and deduct appropriate TDS / withholding tax rate.

Documents received by Post, Courier or from registered Email ID will only be accepted. In case of joint shareholders, the shareholder named first in the Register of Members is required to furnish the requisite documents for claiming any applicable beneficial tax rate.

No claim shall lie against the Company for such taxes deducted.

The Company will arrange to email a soft copy of the TDS certificate at the shareholders registered Email ID in due course, post payment of the said Final Dividend. Shareholders will also be able to see the credit of TDS in Form 26AS, which can be downloaded from their e-filing account at <https://incometaxindiaefiling.gov.in>.

Updation of Email Address and Contact Number.

Members holding shares in physical form may register their email address and mobile number with Company’s Registrar and Share Transfer Agent, Link Intime India Private Limited by submitting Form ISR – 1 along with Folio no., Name of Shareholder, Scanned copy of the Share Certificate (front and back), PAN (Self attested scanned copy of PAN card), Aadhar (Self attested scanned copy of Aadhar Card) for registering their email address.

The Shareholders holding shares in Demat form are requested to register their email addresses with their respective Depository Participant.
