1. Audited Financial Results for the year ended 31st March 2021

The Board of Directors at their Meeting held today, the 15th May, 2021, have approved the Audited Standalone and Consolidated Results for the financial year ended 31st March, 2021.

Pursuant to Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulation 2015, we hereby enclose the following:

- (i) Statement showing the Audited Financial Results (Standalone and Consolidated) for the year ended 31st March, 2021 along with Auditors Report.
- (ii) Disclosure by CFO with regards to issue of Audit Report with unmodified opinion given by the Statutory Auditors Standalone and Consolidated.

2. Final Dividend

The Board has recommended a Final Dividend of Rs. 2 per equity share of Re.1/- each for the financial year 2020-21 for the approval of the Shareholders of the Company at the ensuing Annual General Meeting. The dividend, if approved by the members at the ensuing Annual General Meeting, will be





disbursed to the eligible shareholders within twenty days from the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting.

The Board had declared an interim dividend of Rs1.5 per share in Nov 2020, which together makes a total dividend of Rs 3.50 (350%) per equity share of Rs1 each for the financial year 2020-21.

3. Annual General Meeting

The date of the 27th Annual General Meeting of the Members of the Company will be intimated in due course

4. Re-appointment of Statutory Auditors for a further period of five years

The Board of Directors have approved and recommended the re-appointment of M/s B S R & Associates LLP, Chartered Accountants (ICAI Registration No. 116231W/ W-100024) as Statutory Auditors of the Company for a further period of five years.

5. Allotment under ESOS 2016 and ESOS 2017 Schemes

The Board of Directors of the Company has allotted 18,549 equity shares of the face value of Re.1 each to employees of the Company and the subsidiaries at its meeting held today upon exercise of stock options under Employees Stock Option Scheme 2016 and Employees Stock Option Scheme 2017 (Tranche II)

6. Grant of Stock Options under the Scheme ESOS 2017

As per SEBI (Share Based Employee Benefits) Regulations, 2014 and Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, the Nomination and Remuneration Committee of the Board of Directors at its meeting held on 14th May, 2021 approved a grant of 1,00,000 stock options to the eligible employees of the Company and its subsidiaries under "Employee Stock Option Scheme - ESOS 2017" at an exercise price of Rs. 63.70 per option.

7. Proposal to form an entity in GIFT City

The Board of Directors have approved the proposal to form an entity in GIFT City to acquire an AMC license as an AIF Manager under International Financial Services Centres Authority subject to all





applicable Regulations and Approvals.

Opinion

Basis for Opinion

We are independent of the Group, its associate and its joint ventures in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements under the provisions of the Act, and the Rules thereunder, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements and the Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence obtained by us along with the consideration of audit reports of the other auditors referred to in sub paragraph (a) of the "Other Matters" paragraph below, is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion on the consolidated annual financial results.

The Holding Company's Management and the Board of Directors are responsible for the preparation and presentation of these consolidated annual financial results that give a true and fair view of the consolidated net profit/ loss and other comprehensive income and other financial information of the Group including its associate and joint ventures in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standards prescribed under Section 133 of the Act and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations. The respective Management and Board of Directors of the companies included in the Group and of its associate and joint ventures are responsible for maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of each company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and the design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the consolidated annual financial results that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, which have been used for the purpose of preparation of the consolidated annual financial results by the Management and the Directors of the Holding Company, as aforesaid.

In preparing the consolidated annual financial results, the Management and the respective Board of Directors of the companies included in the Group and of its associate and joint ventures are responsible for assessing the ability of each company to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the respective Board of Directors either intends to liquidate the company or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

The respective Board of Directors of the companies included in the Group and of its associate and joint ventures is responsible for overseeing the financial reporting process of each company.

Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with SAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these consolidated annual financial results.

As part of an audit in accordance with SAs, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the consolidated annual financial results, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances. We also performed procedures in accordance with the circular No CIR/CFD/CMD1/44/2019 issued by the SEBI under Regulation 33(8) of the Listing Regulations, as amended, to the extent applicable.

Other Matters

- (a) The consolidated annual financial results include the audited financial results of four subsidiaries whose financial results reflect total assets (before consolidation adjustments) of Rs. 22,342.92 lakhs as at 31 March 2021, total revenue (before consolidation adjustments) of Rs. 2,550.28 lakhs and total net profit after tax (before consolidation adjustments) of Rs.884.06 lakhs and net cash outflows of Rs. 20.36 lakhs for the year ended on that date, as considered in the consolidated annual financial results, which have been audited by their respective independent auditors. The independent auditors' reports on financial results of these entities have been furnished to us by the management and our opinion on the consolidated annual financial results, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these entities, is based solely on the report of such auditors and the procedures performed by us are as stated in paragraph above.
- (b) The consolidated annual financial results include the unaudited financial information of one subsidiary, whose financial information reflect total assets (before consolidation adjustments) of Rs. 306.00 lakhs as at 31 March 2021, total revenue (before consolidation adjustments) of Rs. 283.20 lakhs and total net profit after tax (before consolidation adjustments) of Rs. 48.45 lakhs, and net cash outflow of Rs. 0.95 lakhs for the year ended on that date, as considered in the consolidated annual financial results. The consolidated annual financial results also include the Group's share of net profit after tax (before consolidation adjustments) of Rs. 332.34 lakhs for the year ended 31 March 2021, as considered in the consolidated annual financial results, in respect of an associate and a joint venture. These unaudited financial information have been furnished to us by the Board of Directors and our opinion on the consolidated annual financial results, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of this subsidiary, associate and joint ventures is based solely on such annual financial information. In our opinion and according to the information and explanations given to us by the Board of Directors, these financial information are not material to the Group.

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Notes to the consolidated financial results:

- 1 Consolidated financial results cover the operations of Geojit Financial Services Limited ("the Company"), its subsidiaries in Geojit Investment Services Limited, Geojit Technologies Private Limited, Geojit Credits Private Limited, Qurum Business Group Geojit Securities LLC, Geojit Techloan Private Limited, its joint venture in Barjeel Geojit Financial Services LLC (formerly known as Barjeel Geojit Securities LLC), Aloula Geojit Capital Company, and its associate in BBK Geojit Financial Brokerage Company. With effect from 1 July 2019, the consolidation of Aloula Geojit Capital Company has been discontinued on account of loss of significant influence.
- The audited consolidated financial results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and recommended for adoption to the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors of the Company have considered and approved the same at its meeting held on 15 May 2021.
- 3 The statutory auditors have carried out an audit of the consolidated financial results as required under Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015 ("Listing Regulations") and have issued an unmodified opinion thereon.
- 4 The above financial results have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles of Ind AS prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant Rules issued there under and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and SEBI circular dated 5 July 2016.
- Figures for the quarter ended 31 March 2021 and 31 March 2020 are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of full financial year and the published year to date unaudited figures upto the third quarter of the respective financial years.
- 6 Exceptional item for the year ended 31 March 2020 represents impairment loss on investment in a joint venture, M/s. Aloula Geojit Capital Company, Saudi Arabia.
- 7 The Taxation Laws (Amendment) Ordinance, 2019, provide domestic companies a non-reversible option to pay corporate tax at concessional rate effective from 1 April 2019, subject to certain conditions. The Company has adopted the reduced rates from the quarter ended 31 March 2020.
- 8 The Group has reported segment information as per Indian Accounting Standard (Ind AS) 108 on 'Operating segments'. As per Ind AS ·108, segments are identified based on management's evaluation of financial information for allocating resources and assessing performance. Accordingly, the Group has identified two reportable segments, viz., financial services and software services:

- 9 Covid-19 outbreak was declared as a global pandemic by World Health Organisation. Stock broking service, which constitutes the major business of the Group, had been declared as an essential service and accordingly, the Group has been in operation consistently with minimal permitted staff. Accordingly, as of 31 March 2021, based on the facts and circumstances existing as of that date the Group does not anticipate any material uncertainties which affects its liquidity position and also ability to continue as a going concern. However, the impact assessment of Covid-19 is a continuing process given the uncertainties associated with its nature and duration.
- 10 The Nomination & Remuneration Committee at its meeting held on 2 November 2020 approved granting 17,530 options to the employees of the Company at the exercise price of Rs.39.45 per share in ESOP 2016 approved by shareholders on 4 August 2016.
- 11 The Board of Directors at its meeting held on 3 November 2020 had declared an interim dividend of ₹ 1.50 per equity share of face value ₹1 each.
- 12 The Board of Directors at its meeting held on 15 May 2021 has recommended a final dividend of ₹2/- per share of face value ₹1/- each for the financial year ended 31 March 2021. The payment is subject to the approval of the shareholders in the ensuing Annual General Meeting of the Company.
- 13 Standalone financial results are available for perusal at the website of the Company and Stock Exchanges.

Notes to the standalone financial results:

Place: Kochi

- 1 The Company's operating segments are established in the manner consistent with the components of the Company that are evaluated regularly by the Chief Operating Decision Maker as defined in Ind AS 108 'Operating Segments'. The Company is engaged primarily in the business of broking and financial services and there are no separate reportable segments as per Ind
- The audited financial results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and recommended for adoption to the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors of the Company have considered and approved the same at its meeting held on 15 May 2021.
- 3 The Statutory Auditors have carried out an audit of the standalone financial results as required under Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("Listing Regulations") and have issued an unmodified opinion thereon.
- 4 The above financial results have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles of Ind AS prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant Rules issued there under and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and SEBI circular dated 5 July 2016.
- 5 Figures for the quarter ended 31 March 2021 and 31 March 2020 are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of full financial year and the published year to date unaudited figures upto the third quarter of the respective financial years.
- 6 Exceptional item for the year ended 31 March 2020 represents impairment loss on investment in a joint venture, M/s. Aloula Geojit Capital Company, Saudi Arabia.
- 7 The Taxation Laws (Amendment) Ordinance, 2019, provide domestic companies a non-reversible option to pay corporate tax at concessional rate effective from 1 April 2019, subject to certain conditions. The Company has adopted the reduced rates from the quarter ended 31 March 2020.
- 8 Covid-19 outbreak was declared as a global pandemic by World Health Organisation. Stock broking service, which constitutes the major business of the Company, had been declared as an essential service and accordingly, the Company has been in operation consistently with minimal permitted staff. Accordingly, as of 31 March 2021, based on the facts and circumstances existing as of that date, the Company does not anticipate any material uncertainties which affects its liquidity position and also ability to continue as a going concern. However, the impact assessment of Covid-19 is a continuing process given the uncertainties associated with its nature and duration.
- 9 The Nomination & Remuneration Committee at its meeting held on 2 November 2020 approved granting 17,530 options to the employees of the Company at the exercise price of Rs.39.45 per share in ESOP 2016 approved by shareholders on 4 August 2016.
- 10 The Board of Directors at its meeting held on 3 November 2020 had declared an interim dividend of ₹ 1.50 per equity share of face value ₹1 each.
- 1 The Board of Directors at its meeting held on 15 May 2021 has recommended a final dividend of ₹ 2/- per share of face value ₹ 1/- each for the financial year ended 31 March 2021. The payment is subject to the approval of the shareholders in the ensuing Annual General Meeting of the Company.
