# Communication, media & tech boost Cognizant's Q1

NASDAQ-LISTED COG-**NIZANT** Technology Solutions stronger-thanreported expected earnings for the first quarter (January-March) of 2024, outperforming market predictions primarily due to significant growth in the communications, media, and technology (CMT) sectors, along with healthcare. However, this may not translate to linear growth going forward as the company's management is still cautious

about the market conditions. Simply put, barring the performance of the CMT and health verticals, Cognizant also continues to face the macro-economic headwinds leading to weak discretionary spending by clients.

IT companies have been struggling to bring in growth in their CMT verticals since the global interest rates have gone up, said an analyst who tracks the IT industry at a domestic broking firm. "Clients have been putting off deals or delaying them in CMT simply because they don't want to pay more interest on their loans, but some large deal wins and acquisitions helped Cognizant offset weak discretionary spending and

pushed its topline above its guidance," he said.

During the quarter, Cognizant reported flat revenues on a sequential basis at \$4.76 billion, but the year-on-year revenues declined by 1.2% in constant currency terms. However, the topline was above the higher end of its guidance range, contrary to estimates of a decline of 2.7-1.2%. Meanwhile, the company's net profit decreased by over 6% to \$546 million yearon-year. The company follows the calendar year cycle.

Despite these figures, Cognizant's annual revenue guidance remains unchanged with a broad range of -2% to +2%, reflecting ongoing market uncertainties. Ravi Kumar S,CEO, said the company usually guides within 200 basis points but the weak market sentiment has pushed the company to provide a 400 bps guidance range. This is important as Cognizant's performance reflects the overall market sentiment for Indian IT service companies such as TCS, Infosys, and Wipro who get majority of their businesses

Indian companies, too, have given muted guidance for FY25 even as they have won record deals. Infosys said it achieved a record high deal value with contracts worth \$17.6 billion in FY24, but still slashed its revenue growth

from the US and Europe.

expectation for FY25 between a mere 1-3% from 4-7%.

In terms of business verticals, Cognizant's performance was mixed. The CMT vertical showed remarkable growth, with sequential and y-o-y increases of 2.7% and 5.2%, respectively. The healthcare sector also grew by 1.4% sequentially. Meanwhile, the financial services and products sectors continued to face challenges. Notably, the financial services sector declined by 0.7% sequentially and 6.2% y-o-y.

However, "Cognizant seems more optimistic about the BFS sector, which is significant, as it comprises 60% of the financial services portfolio. The optimism stems from strategic changes, including a leadership refresh and expansion in service offerings," Kotak Institutional Equities said in a note.

The company reported a reduction in its global workforce, losing 3,300 employees sequentially and 7,100 yearover-year, with the total headcount standing at 344,400 by the end of March. This mirrors cautious hiring practices across the industry. Attrition, however, fell by 10 percentage points to 13.1% on a trailing twelve-

month basis.

# IndiGo to dole out bonus for employees

**BUDGET CARRIER INDIGO** on Thursday announced a special bonus for its staff. The decision comes ahead of the airline's fourth quarter and full-year results, likely to be announced late next month, and less than a week after the airline placed an order for 30 wide-body A350 aircraft.

In a communication to the staff, the airline said it would give a one-time special bonus equivalent to "1.5 months' basic salary", according to two sources. The bonus amount will be disbursed along with the employees' May salary as an ex gratia.

IndiGo, which has a domestic market share of more than 60%, offers an annual bonus depending on the actual operational and financial results of the company. The airline has remained profitable for five straight quarters, and in the three months ended December 2023, its profit after tax more than doubled to ₹2,998.1 crore.

In FY23, its salaries, wages and bonuses amounted to ₹4,190.29 crore. It had 33,045 employees at the end of March 2023, as per its annual report.

## **APSEZ posts 76% profit rise**

**ADANI PORTS AND Special** Economic Zone (APSEZ), the country's largest private port operator, has posted a 76.2% rise in net profit at ₹2,014.77 crore. This was, however, below Street estimates of ₹2,266 crore.

The Adani group company had posted a net profit of ₹1,158 crore for the same period a year ago. The firm's revenues rose 19% to ₹6,897 crore from ₹5,797 crore, while Ebitda rose 23.6% to ₹4,044 crore, and Ebitda margins rose to

58.6% from 56.4%, APSEZ said. A consensus estimate of Bloomberg analysts was expecting the firm to post a consolidated net profit of ₹2,266 crore, on revenue of ₹6,884 crore and Ebitda of ₹4,121 crore.

Following the acquisition of Gopalpur and Karaikal ports, APSEZ's total number oports in India has risen to 15, while its marine services business won contracts in Sri Lanka, Mexico and Oman. Its total number of logistics park is at 12. —FE BUREAU
