21 years on, all acquitted in Naroda Gam riots case

Those released include former BJP minister in Gujarat govt Maya Kodnani

More than two decades after 11 Muslim community members were killed in the post-Godhra riots in Ahmedabad's Naroda Gam, a special court here on Thursday acquitted all the 67 accused in the case, including former Gujarat minister Maya Kodnani and ex-Bajrang Dal leader Babu Bajrang.

The Ahmedabad-based court of S K Baxi, special judge for Special Investigation Team (SIT) cases, acquitted all the accused in one of the worst massacres witnessed during the state-wide riots triggered by the Sabarmati train carnage on February 27, 2002. The Naroda Gam case was probed by a Supreme Court-appointed SIT.

A detailed court order was awaited. Soon after the brief verdict was announced, some of the accused raised slogans of 'Jai Shri Ram' and 'Bharat Mata Ki Jai' outside the court. Those acquitted include former

There were a total of 86 accused in the case, of which 18 died during the pendency of the trial, while one was discharged

by the court earlier under section 169 of the CrPC (Code of Criminal Procedure) due to insufficient evidence against him.

The CrPC section 169 relates to release of accused when evidence is deficient. Reacting to her acquittal, Kodnani, said, "The truth has truly won today."

CJI on same-sex marriage: 'Are binary spouses essential?'

The Supreme Court Thursday said it may be redefining the "evolving notion of marriage" as the next step after decriminalising consensual homosexual relationship which implicitly recognised that same-sex people could live in a stable marriage-like relationship.

A five-judge Constitution bench headed by Chief Justice D Y Chandrachud, which is hearing a batch of petitions seeking legal sanction for same-sex marriage, did not agree to the contention that unlike heterosexuals same-sex couples cannot take proper care of their children.

The CJI referred to instances of alcohol abuse by heterosexuals in families and the adverse impact it has on

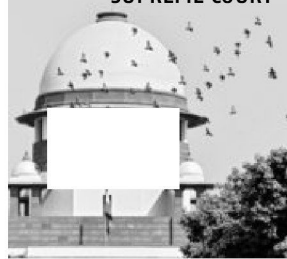
children. He said he did not agree to the submission even at the risk of getting trotted.

During the day-long hearing in the matter for the third day on the trot, the bench pondered over whether the relationship between a man and a woman is so fundamental to the Special Marriage Act that substituting them with term "spouses" will amount to redoing the legislation.

"Once we have crossed that bridge then the next question is as to whether our statute can therefore recognise not just marriage like relationships but the relationship of marriage," the bench said, adding, "This requires us to redefine perhaps the evolving notion of marriage." The CJI said to put in really bluntly, is the relationship between a man and a woman so fundamental to the

Special Marriage Act that for the court to comprehend that it will also include a relationship between a same-sex cou-

ple would be completely "redoing the tapestry of the legislation". "If yes, then obviously we cannot," Justice Chandrachud said. The bench said the law provides a framework for the concept of marriage and it is broad enough to take care of later developments such as same-sex relationships.

"Is existence of two spouses who belong to a binary gender necessary requirement for relationship of marriage or has our law sufficiently progressed to contemplate that the existence of binary gender may not be necessary for your definition of marriage?" the court wondered. Senior advocate K V Viswanathan, appearing for one of the petitioners, said recognition should be given to same-sex marriage and procreation is not a valid ground to deny such couples the right to marry.

No relief for Rahul Gandhi as Surat court rejects plea

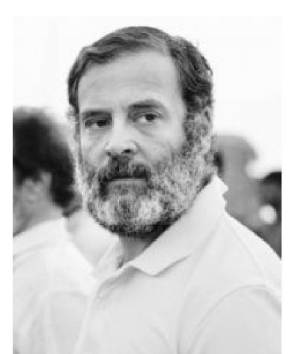
Cong leader to approach HC; victory of people, judiciary: BJP

A sessions court in Surat on Thursday rejected Rahul Gandhi's plea for a stay on his conviction in a criminal defamation case over his Modi surname remark, holding that the Congress leader should have been "more careful with his words" since he was a Member of Parliament and the then president of the country's second largest political party.

The Congress leader was on March 23 convicted to serve a two-year jail term for his derogatory remarks at a public meeting about those with the surname Modi.

Denying the disqualified MP relief that could have paved the way for his reinstatement in the Lok Sabha, additional sessions judge R P Mogera



observed that a "high standard of morality" is expected from a person like Gandhi, adding that the trial court had imposed a sentence which was permissible in law.

It observed that the Congress leader's removal or disqualification as MP under section 8(3) of Representation of the People Act, 1951 "cannot

be termed as irreversible or irreparable loss or damage." Gandhi, who will continue to remain out on bail, stood disqualified from contesting Lok Sabha and Assembly elections for a period of eight years unless a higher court stays his conviction.

Congress spokesperson A M Singhvi said the "erroneous decision" of the sessions court would be challenged in the high court. "We are confident that superior courts with the constitutional power of judicial review will set right the legal errors found in this judgment," he said. The BJP hailed the court order as a "victory" of the judiciary and the people. BJP national spokesperson Sambit Patra said the court's decision is "a blow" to the arrogance of the Gandhi family, "especially Rahul Gandhi."

Amartya Sen asked to vacate 13 decimals of Visva-Bharati land by May 6



Visva-Bharati University in an eviction order has asked Nobel laureate Amartya Sen to vacate the 13 decimals of land which he has been allegedly occupying in an unauthorised manner by May 6 or within 15 days of the publication of the last order on April 19.

Contending as per government advisories and CAG reports the institution was in urgent need of getting control of encroachments, the notice said, "Sen and all concerned persons are liable to be evicted from the said premises, if need be, by use of such force as may be necessary."

Lawyers can't go on strike or abstain from work, says SC

The Supreme Court on Thursday said lawyers cannot go on strike or abstain from work and directed all high courts to constitute grievance redressal committee at the state level headed by the chief justice, where advocates could make representations for redressal of "genuine problems".

A Bench headed by Justices MR Shah and Ahsanuddin Amanullah said that a separate grievance redressal committees be made at district court level to provide a forum, where lawyers could seek redressal of their genuine grievances related to procedural changes.

Assam, Arunachal ink pact to end decade-old border issue

The Assam and the Arunachal Pradesh governments on Thursday signed an agreement in presence of Union Home Minister Amit Shah here to resolve their decades old border disputes. Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma and his Arunachal Pradesh counterpart Pema Khandu signed the deal.

Assam and Arunachal Pradesh share an 804.1-km-long border. The two states have been in discussions to resolve the border dispute with Sarma and Khandu signing the Namsai Declaration on July 15 last year wherein they had pledged to find a solution

soon. Officials said the two states decided to resolve the dispute in 123 villages. Shah termed the border agreement as a "historic" event and said

it ended decades long disputes. Sarma said the deal is a "big and successful" moment. Khandu described the deal as "historic".
