1. The financial results of the company have been prepared in accordance with Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) notified under the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 as amended by the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) (Amendment) Rules 2016.
2. The above Financial results recommended by the Audit Committee are considered and approved by the Board of Directors at their meeting held on 19th January, 2022.
3. The Standalone Financial results are reviewed by the Statutory Auditors of the Company as per Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and financials of M/s.Ngon Coffee Company Limited, material overseas Subsidiary of the Company were reviewed by NSVR & Associates LLP.
4. Estimation uncertainty relating to the global health pandemic on COVID-19
The management has considered the possible effects, if any, that may result from the pandemic relating to COVID - 19 on the carrying amounts of trade receivables & inventories. In assessing the recoverability of receivables, the Company has considered internal and external information upto the date of approval of these financial results including credit reports and economic forecasts etc.,. The Company has performed sensitivity analysis on the assumptions used and based on current indicators of future economic conditions, the Company expects to recover the carrying amount of these assets. The impact of the global health pandemic may be different from that estimated as at the date of approval of these financial results and the Company will continue to closely monitor any material changes and future economic conditions.
5. The entire operations of the Company relates to only one segment viz., Coffee and Coffee related products. Hence segmental reporting as per Ind AS 108 is not made.
6. The Board of Directors declared an interim dividend of Rs. 3.00 per equity share of Rs. 2/- each for the financial year 2021-22.
7. Previous Year/ Period figures have been regrouped and re-cast, wherever necessary, inline with the current period presentation.
8. The results for the Quarter ended 31st December, 2021 are also available on Bombay Stock Exchange website, the National Stock Exchange website and on the Company's website.

1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Consolidated Unaudited Financial Results of **CCL Product (India) Limited** ("the Parent") and its subsidiaries (the Parent and its subsidiaries together referred to as "the Group"), for the quarter ended 31st December, 2021 and for the Period from 1st April, 2021 to 31st December, 2021 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Parent pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015, as amended.
2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Parent's Management and approved by the Parent's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

4. The Statement includes the results of the following entities:

- (iv) Continental Coffee Private Limited., India

5. Based on our review conducted and procedures performed as stated in paragraph 3 above and based on the consideration of the review reports of the branch auditors and other auditors referred to in paragraph 6 below, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standard and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.

6. We did not review the financial results of 1 (one) subsidiary included in the consolidated unaudited financial results, whose financial results total revenues of Rs. 12,798.34 Lakhs for the quarter ending 31st December, 2021 and Rs. 32,209.41 Lakhs for the nine months ending 31st December, 2021, total net profit/(loss) after tax of Rs. 3,651.08 Lakhs for the quarter ending 31st December, 2021 and Rs. 8,739.42 Lakhs for nine months ending 31st December, 2021, total comprehensive income/loss of Rs. 3,651.08 Lakhs for the quarter ending 31st December, 2021 and Rs. 8,739.42 Lakhs for nine months ending 31st December, 2021, as considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results. These financial results have been reviewed by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management and our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries, associates and joint ventures, is based solely on the reports of the other auditors and the procedures performed by us stated in paragraph 3 above.

Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of the matters.




