# President of India confers National Geoscience Awards- 2022

The President of India Smt. Droupadi Murmu has conferred the prestigious National Geoscience Awards-2022 (NGA) of the Ministry of Mines in a glittering function organized at Rashtrapati Bhawan Cultural Centre here today. Minister of Coal, Mines & Parliamentary Affairs Shri Pralhad Joshi and Minister of State for Coal, Mines & Railways Shri Roosaheb Patil Danve and senior functionaries of the Ministry of Mines, Geological Survey of India graced the occasion. Twenty-two Geoscientists including working professionals and academicians from across the country received the awards grouped under three categories namely one National Geoscience Award for Lifetime Achievement, one National Young Geoscientist Award and eight National Geoscience Awards in various fields of geosciences. The National Geoscience Award for Lifetime Achievement was conferred upon Dr. Om Narain Bhargava, well known for his pioneering work in the Himalayas spanning over the last four decades. The National Young Geoscientist Award was presented to Dr. Aniya Kumar Samal, Assistant Professor of Banaras Hindu University who has made significant contribution in understanding the variation of sub-continental lithospheric mantle (SCLM) below different Archean cratons of the Indian shield. Instituted in 1966, the National Geoscience Awards (NGA) is a symbol of recognition and appreciation

for exceptional individuals and organizations that have demonstrated excellence, dedication and innovation in the realm of Geosciences. The awards are presented in the field of Mineral Discovery and Exploration, Basic Geosciences, Applied Geosciences and Mining, Mineral Beneficiation and Sustainable Mineral Development. Speaking on the occasion, the President said that the field of Geoscience is very wide. It also includes the study of natural disasters like landslides, earthquakes, floods and tsunamis. These subjects are called Public Good Geosciences because they are useful in the welfare of the people. The President said that mining is the primary sector of our economy. Mineral development has a vital contribution in the economic development of the country. During the last few years, many progressive changes have been brought in the mining sector by the government. These changes are enhancing the capacity and productivity of the mining sector. The President said only that path of science and technology which goes towards the welfare of humanity. That's why the geoscientist community has to keep moving forward in the direction of human centric mining. She appreciated the Indian geoscientists strengthening India's economy by contributing in the efficient use of minerals.

# SINGLE USE PLASTIC ITEMS PROHIBITED WITH EFFECT FROM 1ST JULY 2022

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has notified the Plastic Waste Management Amendment Rules, 2021, on 12th August 2021, prohibiting manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of the following identified single use plastic items, which have low utility and high littering potential with effect from 1st July, 2022: (i) ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, plastic flags, candy sticks, ice-cream sticks, polystyrene [Thermocol] for decoration; (ii) plates, cups, glasses, cutlery such as forks, spoons, knives, straw, trays, wrapping or packing films and sweet boxes, invitation cards, and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 micron, stirrers. The notification also prohibits manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of plastic carry bags having thickness less than twenty microns with effect from the 31st December, 2022. The single use plastic items prohibited with effect from 1st July 2022 have been identified based on recommendation of an Expert Committee constituted by Department of Chemical and Petrochemicals, Government of India on single use plastics. Plastic packaging is covered under Guidelines for Extended Producer Responsibility on Plastic Packaging. Further, the

sachets using plastic material for storing, packing or selling gutkha, tobacco and pan masala and wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards, and cigarette packets, are banned under Plastic Waste Management Rules. The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India lays down science based standards for articles of food and to regulate their manufacture, storage, distribution, sale and import, to ensure availability of safe and wholesome food for human consumption and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) has notified the Food Safety and Standards (Packaging) Regulations, 2018, which prescribes general and specific requirements for different food packaging materials including plastics. These regulations also specify that paper, glass, metals and plastic materials, if used for packaging food stuffs, shall be manufactured in accordance to Good Manufacturing Practices and various national/international standards. Further, packaging material of plastic origin, is required to pass the prescribed overall migration limits and specific migration limits. Following regulatory measures have been taken by FSSAI to enable Food and Beverage industry to reduce their plastic foot print: (i) issued guidelines for use of bamboo as food contact material; (ii) allowed serving drinking water in paper-sealed reusable glass bottles for captive use within the hotel premises subject to certain conditions; (iii) removed the restriction on use of returnable bottles for packaging of artificially sweetened beverages; (iv) permitted the use of liquid nitrogen during in PET bottles during the packaging of drinking water; (v) permitted the use of other food grade packaging materials for packaging of drinking water other than plastics that are used currently; (vi) promoted biodegradable packaging as part of Eat Right India initiative and encouraged Food Business to

## High Seismic Risk Zone in Himalayan Region

Various organisations of Government of India are involved in seismic zonation mapping and regular monitoring for identification of high seismic risk zone in the areas across the Country in order to mitigate their effect. The National Centre for Seismology under the Ministry of Earth Sciences monitors the earthquake activity in and around the Country on 24x7 basis with special emphasis to the Himalayan regions having high seismic potential. Wadia Institute of Himalayan Geology under the Department of Science and Technology has about 70 broadband seismograph stations operational in the Northwest and Northeast Himalaya for monitoring earthquake activities, evaluation of seismic hazards, and earthquake precursory studies. Since, an earthquake can trigger landslides, landslide susceptibility and vulnerability maps by incorporating tectonic activity based on machine learning algorithms have also been prepared. The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has carried out landslide susceptibility zonation mapping along with Northwest and Northeast Himalaya. ISRO has also established a network of 30 Global Navigation Satellite System based Continuously Operating Reference Stations across Himalayan belt to monitor the process of crustal deformation. In addition to above, the Geological Survey of India (GSI) has carried out research and development studies with field validation across the landslide prone areas of the Country. GSI has also installed permanent Global Positioning System (GPS) stations in different parts of the Country with an aim to monitor plate movement and also map areas with strain in homogeneity. GSI has established Seismo-Geodetic Data Receiving and Processing Centre which receives and processes real time Seismo-Geodetic Data from Remote Broadband Seismic Observatories located in various parts of the Country. The information on seismic activities recorded by these organizations.
