Gujarat HC reserves order on maintainability of petition moved by former ASG



Ahmedabad: The Gujarat High Court (HC) on Friday reserved its order on the maintainability of the petition moved by former Assistant Solicitor General (ASG) of India at the Gujarat HC IH Syed, against an FIR registered against him in Gandhinagar.

Syed, a designated senior advocate, is seeking to quash an FIR charging him alone with five others, for causing hurt, extortion, wrongful confinement and criminal intimidation, among other charges. The FIR registered on

May 15 at the Pethapur police station in Gandhinagar, was filed on the basis of a complaint by an Ahmedabad-based businessman Viral Mukunddhai Shah (46), naming six accused, including Syed. In his complaint, Shah alleged that he was called by the former Gujarat chief minister, Shankersinh Vaghela's house at Gandhinagar by his personal assistant Bhaumik Thakkar for signing an agreement on a business dispute. When he refused to sign the agreement he was allegedly threatened of harm to him and family members, Shah said.

"They pressured me and despite that when I did not sign, they threatened they'll fix me in a rape case. I got scared and got up when all of them started assaulting me," the FIR states. Apart from Syed, other accused include Thakkar and those involved in the business dispute with Shah - Jankar Solanki, Ravi Chaudhri, Kuren Amin and Ismit Amin. An FIR was lodged against Shah and 25 others by V Kuren in December 2021 at Ahmedabad CID Crime branch police station, on charges of cheating, forgery and misappropriation of funds by the accused. Shah was arrested in connection with this FIR in March this year and remained in judicial custody for 27 days. Shah purportedly entered into a settlement with Kuren, following which he was released on bail by consent. As part of the settlement, it was agreed that Kuren's FIR, would pay a sum of Rs 20 crores to Kuren's company, which was being re-issued by a senior advocate Syed. Thereafter, the FIR was quashed by the Gujarat HC on May 2. Senior advocates BB Naik and Asim Pandya - arguing on behalf of Syed - submitted before the court of Justice Samir Dave on Friday that there are inconsistencies in the FIR and that it is "well thought out" by the complainant in a bid to "wriggle out of his liability to pay, in the earlier settlement."

15 new, 118 active Covid cases in Ahmedabad

AHMEDABAD: The city on Friday recorded 15 new cases of Covid-19. With 119 patients discharged, the number of active cases in the city was 118. The state reported 23 new cases and 33 patients discharged, with 194 active cases.

The other cases included four from Vadodra, three from Gandhinagar and one from Rajkot cities. There are now 22 districts with no active cases. Not a single patient is on a ventilator. Gujarat in the past 24 hours vaccinated administered 3,651 first doses of Covid vaccine and 69,444 second doses. In all, 5,39 crore people have had at least one dose and 5.25 crore have had their second dose as well. The state administered booster doses to 32,690 persons, taking total number of these doses to 32.91 lakh. Meanwhile, NID's Gandhinagar campus reported seven cases in five days. The campus has been declared a micro-containment zone.

Gujarat: Mother drowns newborn in bucket at CHC toilet in Kheda

AHMEDABAD: A 20-year-old woman from a village in Matar taluka of Kheda district allegedly killed her newborn child after delivering him by drowning him in a bucket of water inside a toilet. The incident took place at a community health centre (CHC) in Vaso on Wednesday. It is suspected that the newly married woman had conceived the child following an illicit affair and may have committed the gruesome crime to hide the pregnancy from her husband.

According to Vaso police, Manisha Chunara, who hails from Shihoni village, had married Sunil Chunara from Pij village of Kheda on Saturday. On Wednesday, she told her husband that she was going to the CHC to consult a doctor for a gynaecological problem. She reached CHC around 10.15am.

As soon as she arrived at the CHC, she headed straight for the toilet and delivered the baby unassisted. When the newborn began crying, she cupped his face with her hand and drowned him in a bucket of water," said investigating officer and Vaso PSI H J Rajendra. Soon after, she left the hospital and went to her husband's place in Pij. Around 12.30pm, a sanitation worker found a newborn lying dead inside the bucket at the CHC toilet and alerted the hospital staff who called the police. "We reached the spot and found the newborn dead. The body has been sent for post-mortem. The hospital staff told the cops that four women had visited the CHC for health check-ups on Wednesday morning, but one of them left the premises without undergoing a medical

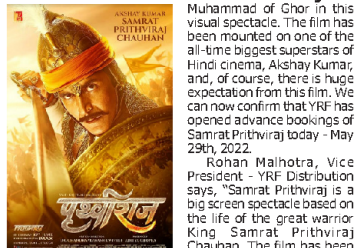
Bhupendra Patel to hear applicants in 'Rajya-Swagat' programme in Gandhinagar
