Praja report: No state has devolved all 18 municipal functions to urban local bodies

No state has managed to devolve 18 municipal functions to urban local bodies, according to a report by the Praja Foundation, 'Urban Governance Index, 2020'



New delhi: Twenty-seven years after the 74th Constitutional Amendment Act was passed in 1992 aimed at strengthening democracy at the grassroots level through local bodies, no state has managed to devolve 18 municipal functions to urban local bodies, according to a report by the Praja Foundation, 'Urban Governance Index, 2020'.

In the study which spanned over three years (2017-2020) in 40 cities across 28 states and National Capital Territory of Delhi, Praja looked at the structural empowerment of the city governments by respective state governments. From Maharashtra, Mumbai and Pimpri Chinchwad were part of the 40 cities.

As no state has devolved all the municipal functions, the municipal bodies are dependent on the state for funds and decision-making. Some of these 18 functions include solid waste management, water supply, slum improvement and upgradation, promotion of education among others. Niti Mehta, founder and managing trustee, Praja Foundation, said, "There have been many urban governance schemes, policies and various

global and national level indices over the years. However, the majority of the schemes and indices have focused predominantly on the aspect of mapping the performance/delivery of urban services. But what we require are changes in the 'enabler' i.e., core reforms in the structure of city governments and long-term management of our cities." Odisha ranked first in the Urban Governance Index, while Maharashtra ranked second.

followed by Chhattisgarh, Kerala and Madhya Pradesh. The index ranked the states on a 100-point scale across 42 indicators under four heads: empowered elected representatives and legislative structure (30 marks), empowered city administration (15), citizens (25) and fiscal empowerment (30 marks). The study which formed the basis of the index included 1,568 interviews held with the city's elected representatives, city administrators and city-based civil society organisations. "The study was conducted mainly from the perspective of mapping the status of urban reforms in individual states. Later, it was realised that we need to make a broader national level comparison matrix to track the implementations of reforms by individual states. Therefore, this led to the quantification of the findings from the state-level urban governance studies and finally culminated into the Urban Governance Index (UGI)," said Milind Mhaske, director, Praja Foundation.

Google, Facebook win key concession in law to pay for news in Australia



A spokesman for Google, owned by Alphabet Inc., said it's too early to comment on the legislation.

Moderating its earlier stance, Facebook said Wednesday it's reviewing the Australian legislation. "We'll continue to engage through the upcoming parliamentary process with the goal of landing on a workable framework to support Australia's news ecosystem." Will Easton, managing director of Facebook Australia, said in a statement. The legislation is designed to support a local media industry, including Rupert Murdoch's News Corp., that has struggled to adapt to the digital economy.

New delhi: Google and Facebook Inc. won a key concession in Australia as the government unveiled details of a world-first law to force the digital giants to pay to display news articles. The legislation, introduced to Australia's parliament on Wednesday, requires Google and Facebook to compensate publishers for the value their stories generate for the platforms. But in a modification to an earlier draft, the legislation now also recognizes the monetary value the platforms provide to news businesses by directing readers to their websites. While the details

will be debated by lawmakers and could be altered, the change in wording follows a months-long campaign by Google to get the law blunted. The tech giant argued that publishers also benefit from additional readership online when articles are available on platforms. Facebook had taken a harder line. The U.S. social media company has threatened to block Australians from sharing any news on its sites if the law is passed. The different responses has made Australia a test case as watchdogs worldwide seek to rein in the vast advertising power of the digital

"Australian news media businesses need to be fairly compensated for generating original content and the rules of the digital world should mirror the rules of the physical world," Australia Treasurer Josh Frydenberg said on his website. "This new mandatory bargaining code is a world-first."

Family in Kerala finds crocodile lounging on their verandah



New delhi: A family residing near the Chalakkudy river in

Athirappally, Kerala was horrified to find a full-grown crocodile lounging on the verandah of their home early Wednesday morning. Thachiyath Shajan opened the doors of his home in his usual morning stupor around 5 am Wednesday to find the reptile on his verandah. Terrified, he ran back inside and dialled his neighbours and the forest department officials.

Initial rescue efforts began by the locals who attempted to entice the reptile out of the home by poking it with a pipe. But the crocodile was in no mood to relent and settled himself under a sofa on the verandah. Visuals taken by locals on their phones show the crocodile resisting the attempts by the public to relocate it in an aggressive manner.

It took a combined team of forest officials and locals over two hours to finally secure the crocodile using ropes and carry it to the river for its release. The reptile was released back in the Chalakkudy river near the base of the popular Athirappally waterfalls, a region known for the sighting of crocodiles and alligators. In fact, forest officials have repeatedly warned tourists from taking a dip in the river in that area due to the threat of crocodiles.

T Ajikumar, Range Forest Officer, Charpa Range, told The Indian Express, "The crocodile was about 2.5 to 3 metres in length. It may have accidentally wandered into the home because it is located close to the river. In recent days, tourists have reported spotting them even on the main road especially in the evenings."
