

# Americans 1st priority: US, on India's request for vax

It is in the world's interest that Americans are vaccinated and the US has to first take care of the requirements of its own people, State Department Spokesperson Ned Price (pic) has said about Washington's restrictions on exporting raw materials for making the Covid-19 vaccines.

Asked at his briefing on Thursday if President Joe Biden's administration had made a decision on the requests made from India to lift the ban on the export of vaccine raw materials to India, Price said bluntly, "we have a special responsibility to the American people."

"It's, of course, not only in our interest to see Americans vaccinated, but also in



the rest of the world. We will, of course, always do as much as we can, consistent with our first obligation," he declared.

US Secretary of State Anthony Blinken and India's External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar discussed

Covid-19 and health cooperation last week and it had opened the possibility of Washington allowing vaccine raw materials to be exported.

Earlier this month, Serum Institute of India (SII) CEO Adar Poonawala appealed

to Biden to allow the exports of vaccine raw materials. "If we are to truly unite in beating this virus, on behalf of the vaccine industry outside the US, I humbly request you to lift the embargo of raw material exports out of the US so that vaccine production can ramp up," he tweeted. Price said, "we have a special responsibility to the American people. Number two, the American people, this country has been hit harder than any other country around the world - more than 550,000 deaths, tens of millions of infections in this country alone," he said.

He added, "When it comes to India, (there is) the Quad and the arrangement with the Quad, including to increase production capacity in India."

## China firmly backs India

**BEIJING:** China on Friday said it firmly supports the Indian govt and the people in their fight against the coronavirus pandemic and is in communication with New Delhi on its offer to provide assistance to deal with the surge in Covid-19 cases. Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesman Zhao Lijian said, "The Chinese government and the people firmly support the Indian government and their people in their fight. We believe the Indian people will surely conquer the epidemic at an early date."

## Pak's Taliban claims responsibility for Quetta blast

**Quetta:** The Tehreek-e-Taliban Pakistan (TTP) claimed responsibility on Wednesday for a deadly bomb blast at a luxury hotel, Quetta's Serena Hotel, hosting the Chinese ambassador in the southwest of the country, as officials raised the death toll to four and 12 others injured.

"A TTP suicide bomber targeted police and senior government officials in a high-security area," read the TTP statement, though police have said that initial investigations show the explosives were planted in a car and were detonated remotely, reported Newsweek.

"Our own people are involved in these acts of terrorism," Balochistan Home Minister Mir Ziaullah Langoi told a press conference

after the explosion, lamenting that there was a renewed wave of terrorism sweeping the region. He clarified there had been no threat alerts before the attack. To another question on reports of the bombing targeting the Chinese ambassador, Langoi said the envoy had not been present at the hotel at the time of the explosion. "I have just met the Chinese ambassador and he is in high spirits," he said, adding that police would investigate the target of the bombing, reported Newsweek.

The Bomb Disposal Unit has said that 40-50 kg of explosives were used in the blast, which produced a deafening sound that was heard by people located several kilometers away.

"We will maximise the effort today, until the time limit tomorrow at 3 a.m.," military spokesperson Maj. Gen. Achmad Riad told reporters.

There have been no signs of life from the submarine, but family members held out hope that the massive search effort would find the vessel in time. "The family is in a good condition and keeps praying," said Ratih

Wardhani, the sister of 49-year-old crewman Wisnu Subiyantoro. "We are optimistic the Nanggala can be rescued with all the crew." 24 Indonesian ships and a patrol plane were mobilised for the search Friday, focusing on the area where an oil slick was found after the submarine disappeared during an exercise.

An American reconnaissance plane was expected to



join the search Saturday and a second Australian ship was due soon. "These two Australian ships will help expand the search area and extend the duration of the search effort," Australian Navy Rear Adm. Mark Hammond said. Singaporean and Malaysian res-

cue ships were also expected in the coming days.

Indonesian President Joko Widodo cancelled a visit to Banyuwangi port, where some rescue ships left earlier, to prepare for a weekend regional summit in Jakarta, officials said. He asked Indonesians to pray for the crew's safe return, while ordering all-out efforts to locate the submarine. "Our main priority is

the safety of the 53 crew members," Widodo said. "To the family of the crew members, I can understand your feelings and we are doing our best to save all crew members on board."

There's been no conclusive evidence the oil slick was from the sub.

# Blinken reaffirms US-India ties



**Washington:** US Secretary of State Antony Blinken on Thursday (local time) spoke to External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar and reaffirmed the importance of the US-India relationship while agreeing to coordinate closely to establish peace in Afghanistan and restoration of democracy in Burma.

Moreover, both diplomats discussed US-India cooperation on climate change, COVID-19, and other global challenges and pledged to remain in close contact on these and other issues of mutual concern, said Price.

## NATO commits support to Afghanistan

**Kabul:** The NATO alliance on Friday reiterated its support to Afghanistan and the political resolution of hostilities in the country. Stefano Pontecorvo, NATO Senior Civilian Representative to Afghanistan, said. On Thursday, the official met with Abdullah, head of the Afghan High Council for National Reconciliation. According to Pontecorvo, they held fruitful discussions. "We agreed on the importance of a political settlement and on the need for a united Republic front to act in the interest of peace and for the benefit of all Afghans," the official said, quoted as saying by the regional alliance office in a tweet.

## Tycoon Sanjeev Gupta's father leaves UK as group battles for survival



**LONDON:** Parduman Gupta (pic), father of embattled metals tycoon Sanjeev Gupta, has moved out of the UK, just as the pair's GFG Alliance teeters on the brink following the collapse of its largest lender Greensill Capital. The senior Gupta has changed his country of usual residence from Britain to India, according to several filings made over the past few weeks at Companies House, the business registry. He owns Simec Group, the branch of the busi-

ness empire which deals in renewable energy, shipping and mining, and was founded by the magnate as an export-and-import house in India. It's not clear where Parduman Gupta is currently, but a spokesman for Companies House said that a company director must list their country of residence, and that this "should correspond with their usual residential address." A spokesman for GFG Alliance declined to comment.
