Unlock 4.0: Delhi Metro may start, schools to stay shut

THE METRO SERVICE in Delhi NCR, suspended since March 22 in the wake of the coronavirus outbreak, is likely to resume September in a limited manner. An official of the Ministry of Home Affairs said Monday that a plan to operate the service at 50 per cent capacity, with strict enforcement of social distancing and hygiene norms, is being considered. The announcement on the resumption of the Metro service in the NCR, the official said, may form part of Unlock-4 guidelines expected in the coming days.

State government officials, the official said, are still not in favour of reopening schools and colleges, so the restrictions on educational institutions are likely to continue. "The government is also not in favour of reopening multiplexes because of the closed environment, and swimming pools," the official said.

Entertainment parks, theatres, badminton courts, swimming pools and similar places are also likely to remain closed. The plan on social, political, sports, entertainment, academic, cultural, religious functions and other large congregations too is likely to continue.

On the resumption of the Metro, Union Minister Hardeep Puri, speaking at the Idea Exchange programme of the Indian Express Media Summit, said: "The hard facts are DMRC MD Mangru Singh and Metro are ready to operate the services for about two months now. I periodically talk to him."

"Delhi Metro is a very professional organisation. They are ready to take up two months ago. And the DMRC MD tells me that services can resume at a two-day notice. I think everybody will agree now. Not just the central government, but the state government and the DMRC also believe that the time has come to resume (the service)," he said.

"Now whether you resume in a calibrated manner, even the Ministry of Civil Aviation started with 30 per cent and now we will expand more. I personally think Delhi Metro should resume very quickly. It is not a decision that I take, but the input that I have provided to the decision-making people is that let us get it started, and I am hopeful it will be very soon. I saw a statement by the CM who is saying the same thing," Puri said.

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and his government have been pushing for resumption of the service. In a meeting when he met a group of think tanks, Kejriwal requested the Centre to resume the Metro in Delhi even if it is not done in other states.

DMRC spokesperson Anuj Dayal said the public transport will be prepared to commence operations whenever the government issues directions.

EC: Said not to police over poll row data in Delhi riots probe

AN UNUSUAL request, the Delhi Police sought the digital electoral database of three districts in connection with its investigation into the North-East Delhi riots earlier this year, but did not pursue the matter after the Election Commission (EC) denied access and offered physical inspection of voters' lists instead. The Indian Express has learnt.

According to a letter released by activist Saket Gokhale on Monday, the Delhi Police sought the database in March to match the photographs of voters in the Shahdara, North-East and East Delhi districts with the "photographs of culprits captured through CCTV and other video footage" available with the official police database.

The Delhi Police had approached the state Chief Electoral Officer, and the Commissioner of Police, S N Shivastava, had also written directly to the police panel in the first week of March. Police sources said a similar request was also sent to the transport department, which shared photographs from driving licences to be used as a soft copy for matching through its software to match them with the photographs of suspects. In case of a match, police would send details of the individual for further investigations, an officer said.

On Monday evening, the EC issued a press statement saying that it had not, in any way, deviated from its original guidelines of 2008 and clarifying orders of 2020 on sharing of electoral roll and EPIC database with various government departments.

"It also needs to be stated that as far as criminal investigations by regulatory departments/enforcement agencies is concerned, it is under their own extant Acts, Rules and guidelines, which in any case can be challenged in the Hon'ble Courts of law. In fact, the entire super structure of criminal justice system is erected on this. It is why in the Model Code of Conduct is enforced that Election Commission invariably takes note of any such incident(s) incident(s), which have the potential of disturbing and/or disrupting the smooth conduct of electoral process and ECI does not interfere in the day to day functioning of the regulatory departments/enforcement agencies," the statement said.

AHEAD OF HARYANA ASSEMBLY SESSION

Khattar, Speaker test positive for Covid

TWO DAYS before the Monsoon Session of Haryana Assembly is set to begin, Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar, Speaker Gian Chand Gupta and two BJP MLAs tested positive for Covid-19 on Monday.

Several senior officials who recently held meetings with the Chief Minister or the Speaker, including Principal Secretary to the Chief Minister, R K Khullar and Additional Chief Secretary (Home) Vijai Vardhan, have now gone into self-quarantine.

"I was tested for Novel Coronavirus. My test report has now turned positive. I appeal to all colleagues and associates who came in my contact over the last week to get themselves tested. I request my close contacts to move into strict quarantine immediately," Khattar tweeted Monday evening.

The Chief Minister was taken to hospital for a high-resolution CT scan on Monday evening. "The Chief Minister has a cough. Apart from that there are no other symptoms. After he tested positive for Covid-19, we tested a baseline chest X-ray done, which was found normal. The EC was also found normal and oxygen saturation levels were 94 per cent. Still, as a matter of caution, doctors advised a high-resolution CT scan," a senior official said.

Khattar's two associates, who handle the Chief Minister's social media accounts and move around with him most of the time, tested positive for the infection a couple of days ago. Speaker Gupta, who represents Panikula, underwent a Covid-19 test Sunday. His report came in positive on Monday. His condition is stable and he is in isolation at his Panikula residence. Gupta's political secretary and nephews had earlier tested positive for Covid-19. In Gupta's absence, Deputy Speaker Ranbir Gangwala will be conducting proceedings of the Assembly.

Manohar Lal Khattar said. The scan report came in normal late Monday night. "On doctors' advice, the Chief Minister shall be staying at his residence in isolation. He is doing fine," the senior official said. Khattar went into self-quarantine three days back and his Chandigarh residence turned positive. I appeal to all colleagues and associates who came in my contact over the last week to get themselves tested. I request my close contacts to move into strict quarantine immediately," Khattar tweeted Monday evening.
