Centre initiates anti-dumping investigation on solar imports

Complaint was filed by Mundra Solar PV and Jupiter Solar Power with the DGTR under the ministry of commerce

The government has initiated an investigation into the dumping of solar imports from China, Vietnam and Taiwan. The complaint was filed by Mundra Solar PV (the solar manufacturing unit of Adani Enterprises), and Jupiter Solar Power to the Directorate General of Trade Remedies (DGTR), under the ministry of commerce.

In a gazette notification dated May 15, the DGTR said it has submitted the case under the prima facie evidence of injury to the domestic industry by such solar imports. This is the third time since 2012 that domestic solar manufacturers have approached the government for relief from imported solar content "dumped at below market price."

This comes at a time when the Union government has already announced a basic customs duty of 40 and 25 per cent on solar cells and modules, with effect from April 1, 2022. There is already a 15 per cent safeguard duty levied on solar imports, expiring in July

this year. The complainants have alleged that the domestic industry has suffered material injury due to dumped imports of solar cells (whether or not assembled into modules or panels), originating in or exported from China, Taiwan and Vietnam.

While admitting the case, the DGTR said, "There is prima facie evidence that normal value of the subject goods in the subject countries are higher than the net export prices, thereby indicating that the subject goods originating in or exported from the subject countries are being exported at dumped prices, so as to justify initiation of investigation."

In the notification, the DGTR also noted evidence of the price undercutting, price suppression and price depression effect on the domestic industry by the imports.

"The domestic industry is able to sell under the central public sector undertaking (CPSU) scheme but not in the open market in India. The volume of sale by the applicant is negligible during the period of investigation in the open market in which the imported goods compete with them. Even after making sales under the CPSU scheme, unutilised capacity exists with the applicants," said the notification.

The CPSU scheme entails that public sector companies, while setting up solar power plants, would use domestic content (solar cells and modules).

India imports close to 90 per cent of its solar cells and modules, with 80 per cent being from China. According to industry data, India has 3,100 Mw of cell manufacturing capacity and 9,000 Mw of module making. India's installed

capacity of solar power stands at 39.08 Gw (including ground mounted and rooftop). India aims to have 100 Gw of solar power capacity by next year.

This is the third such attempt by the Indian solar manufacturing industry in the past decade to get relief from imports, especially coming from China. In 2014, the ministry of commerce finalised duties to tune of \$0.48-\$0.81 per unit on solar cells and modules imported from the US and China. But the ministry of finance did not impose them and let the duty lapse. A similar application in 2018, by the Indian Solar Manufacturers' Association, was withdrawn by them later.

The period for the current investigation has been taken from July 2019 to December 2020. However, the injury period will be from 2016 to 2020.

WhatsApp privacy policy not really a choice: Experts

WhatsApp's new privacy policy update, which came into force on Saturday, received criticism from several quarters for not really giving users the choice to opt out.

The company had earlier set a deadline of February 8, but deferred it to May 15 after facing a backlash over fears that data will be shared with Facebook. The Indian government had also asked WhatsApp to withdraw the update.

In an earlier update to its frequently asked questions page, the Facebook-owned messaging service said it would give everyone time to review, and continue to remind those who haven't had the chance to do so to review and accept. After a period of several weeks, the reminder people receive will "eventually become persistent".

The reminders will not become persistent for all users at the same time. But once they do become persistent for users, WhatsApp said they would "encounter limited functionality on WhatsApp until you accept the updates". Further, people "won't be able to access your chat list, but you can still answer incoming phone and video calls. If you

have notifications enabled, you can tap on them to read or respond to a message or call back a missed phone or video call. After a few weeks of limited functionality, you won't be able to receive incoming calls or notifications and WhatsApp will stop sending messages and calls to your phone," it said.

The website Gizmodo had said WhatsApp will turn accounts into "useless zombies" if people do not accept its privacy policy update.

WhatsApp, meanwhile, has maintained that it is not doing anything new or novel. In an affidavit filed with the Delhi High Court on Friday, WhatsApp said the update would not affect the privacy of personal messages of its users.

It further said that companies like Google, Microsoft, Zoom, Zomato, Republic World, Ola Cabs, Truecaller, BigBasket, Koo, and public companies such as Aarogya Setu, Bhim, Air India, Sandes, Government e-Marketplace (GeM),

Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC), also have similar policies, the legal portal LiveLaw reported.

"WhatsApp's new terms requiring users to accept them by a cut-off date to continue to avail full functionality has brought click wrap contracts and their intended manner of operation under the glare. Such contracts require a user to click 'yes' or 'ok' to the terms, which constitutes legal consent for availing a service. Given the substantial user base and the apparent network effect, it literally leaves little room for users to make a choice. The law may not oblige them to provide the service unless their terms are accepted, and hence the question really is will users click 'yes' even if they are not 'ok'? Germany has temporarily banned the update, raising privacy concerns, and the EU may also be looking into it closely," said Raj Ramachandran, partner at J Sagar Associates.

What's at stake?

Flagging concerns over the update, digital liberties organisation Internet Freedom Foundation said more details about usage and log information and device and connection information will be collected by WhatsApp.

Adani Green in talks to acquire SB Energy

Exploring buyout of the renewable energy firm through an all-stock deal

Adani Green Energy, majority-owned by Indian billionaire Gautam Adani, is in advanced talks to acquire privately-held SB Energy Holdings Ltd., according to people familiar with the matter.

A deal could value SB Energy, owned by SoftBank Group Corp. and Bharti Enterprises Ltd., at more than \$650 mil-

lion, said one of the people, who asked not to be identified as the information is private. Adani Green is exploring a buyout of the renewable energy company through an all-stock deal, another person said.

An announcement could come in coming weeks, the people said. Discussions could still be delayed or fall apart, they added.

A representative for SoftBank

declined to comment, while representatives for Adani Green and Bharti Enterprises didn't immediately respond to requests for comment.

A deal could help Adani Green to reach its planned generation capacity of 25 gigawatts by 2025. Shares in Adani Green have risen more than 370 per cent in the past year, giving the company a market value of about \$23 billion.

'Food ordering has not seen downward trend'

Westlife Development, which runs McDonald's restaurants in western and southern India, reported same-store sales growth of 10.5 per cent in the March quarter (Q4) of financial year 2020-21 (FY21) as dine-in operations improved. Convenience channels have emerged as a strong platform for Westlife, triggered by the Covid-19 pandemic. It contributes 60 per cent to overall sales, with dependence on the channel expected to grow during the second wave. In an interview, AMIT JATIA, vice-chairman, Westlife Development, talks to Viveat Susan Pinto about the road ahead for the company. Edited excerpts:

How do you see FY22, since Covid-19 has resurfaced?

We are better placed than before to take on this time's issues. We learnt a lot in the first wave and the consumer too has evolved over the last year. We've entered FY22 and the second wave with a strong balance sheet. We are also coming into this wave with our convenience channels well-entrenched. Food ordering has not seen a downward trend. I believe that in the next three-four months, the situation will settle down as far as the second wave is concerned. We should be the first brand to get back on the growth path once it abates. I am feeling quite good about FY22.

What in your view will be the restaurant of the future?

There is a shift towards the organised sector from the unorganised segment, triggered by the pandemic, since consumers want safety and hygiene. To that extent, the trend is good for organised players like us. The question is when will things normalise? That is an answer that many are seeking. As I mentioned earlier, I believe the second wave will abate in about three-four months. Of course, there is a third wave looming. From a long-term perspective, things may settle down in a year or two. However, I remain bullish about the market because the shift to the organised sector will continue. Plus, the out-of-restaurant consumption has grown during the pandemic and that is here to stay. Also, McDonald's is a convenience brand. All of this will aid growth. And we will continue to invest in the business, open new stores as well as drive our convenience channels.

Can convenience channels really make up for dine-in sales?

While dine-in is an important constituent of the restaurant business, as I mentioned earlier, food ordering has not come down at all. People are, therefore, turning to take-aways, drive-throughs, on-the-go and delivery to compensate for the lack of dining-in due to lockdown curbs. Our convenience channels have added a lot of value to our total sales. Also, as an impulse business, consumption for us is not restricted to in-store alone. Globally, 70 per cent of McDonald's business is off-premise. That speaks for itself, especially during the pandemic in the last one year, when in-store sales had suffered. It was convenience channels that were ticking. Even after dine-in sales touched 70 per cent of pre-Covid levels in January-February, there was no drop in sales from our convenience channels. That clearly shows that this has become a habit for consumers.

What relief measures do you expect from the government for the sector?

Definitely, the challenges faced by the industry are a cause for concern for many. Restaurants in the rest of the world have been through a similar phase. But they got tremendous support from their governments in terms of furlough pays, taxation and financial assistance, which helped sustain them. Some support to sectors such as restaurants, hospitality and tourism in India will go a long way towards preventing job loss and closure of businesses. This is the need of the hour.

What is your outlook on store

Coal India Jharkhand arm CCL loses 47 personnel to Covid

Central Coalfields Ltd (CCL) supplying dry-fuel to the nation's power plants and other projects even during the pandemic has lost 47 of its personnel to Covid-19, an official said.

Many others and their family members are battling for life, the Jharkhand arm of the Coal India Limited (CIL) said.

"Mining activities of Central Coalfields Ltd, a Jharkhand based subsidiary of Coal India, are going on round the clock but around 47 employees of CCL have lost their lives while serving the nation during the ongoing pandemic," a CCL official said. This maharatna coal miner claims to have set up around 2,000 beds which include ICU, isolation and covid care beds with oxygen support. While oxygen supported beds are over 750 the ICU beds number nearly 70.
