Always put 'nation first, always first', says Modi

PM seeks support for Indian athletes in Tokyo with 'Victory Punch Campaign'

New Delhi, 25 July

Stressing on 'Nation First, Always First' mantra, Prime Minister Narendra Modi said on Sunday that as the country enters its 75th year of Independence, every citizen should lead a "Bharat Jodo Andolan" in the same manner as Mahatma Gandhi had led the "Bharat Chhoro Andolan".

In his monthly Mann Ki Baat radio broadcast, he noted that as India enters its 75th year of Independence on August 15, Amrit Mahotsav is being celebrated throughout the country to mark the year.

The need of the nation is to unite and work towards national progress, Modi said. "It is our responsibility that we do our work in such a manner that it helps in uniting our country which is full of diversities," the prime minister said, adding, "We have to move forward with Nation First, Always First."

Many programmes in connection with Amrit Mahotsav are being run, the prime minister said, adding that the Ministry of Culture has started an initiative to have maximum number of Indians sing the national anthem together.

For this, a website, <http://rashtragan.in> has been created.

"With the help of this website, you can render the national anthem and record it, thereby getting connected with the campaign. I hope you connect yourselves with this novel initiative. In the days to come, you will get to see many such campaigns and efforts," Modi said.

The Prime Minister urged people to keep encouraging and supporting

Noting that on July 26 the nation will mark Kargil Vijay Diwas, Modi asked people to pay tributes to those who made the nation proud in 1999.

On his Mann Ki Baat programme, he said it celebrates positivity and collectivity. "I am unable to take up all the inputs I receive for Mann Ki Baat, but I do forward many of them to government departments concerned," Modi said.

In the broadcast, he also cited a study by MyGov to highlight that of those sending messages and suggestions for Mann Ki Baat, close to 75 per cent are below 35.

"I view this as a very good indicator. Mann Ki Baat is a medium which has positivity, sensitivity. In Mann Ki Baat, we talk about positive things; its character is collective," he said.

Just the way people joined hands for the cause of freedom during the colonial rule, citizens now have to come together for the development of the country, the prime minister said, adding that they can contribute to nation building by supporting local entrepreneurs, artists, craftsmen and weavers should come naturally to us.

Noting that the National Handloom Day falls on August 7, he said handloom products are a major source of income in rural and tribal regions and urged people to purchase them.

With khadi products often finding mention in his monthly radio address, Modi said their demand has gone up manifold since 2014.

In his address, the Prime Minister also spoke of a number of individuals and local developments brought about by groups of people that have made positive contributions to society.

"You also share your victory punch along with your team and cheer for India," Modi said.

It was a mixed day for the Indian contingent at the Tokyo Summer Olympics on Sunday. Iconic boxer MC Mary Kom, 38, beat her 23-year-old opponent from over Dominican Republic, Miguelina Hernandez Garcia, to power her way into the pre-quarterfinals after a superb tactical victory in the 51kg category.

► **Sindhu shines**
PV Sindhu, the sixth-seed shuttler in the world, beat her 58th ranked opponent Ksenia Polikarpova 21-7, 21-10 with significant ease to sail into the second round of the Tokyo Games.

► **Batra stuns higher seed**
Manika Batra, 26, ranked 62 in the world, shocked world number 32 Margaryta Pesotska to make it to the third round in women's singles table tennis. Batra made a valiant comeback after losing the first two games, to prevail 4-11, 4-11, 11-7, 12-10, 8-11, 11-5, 11-7 in a match that lasted 57 minutes.

► **Malfunxion ends Manu's dream**
A major malfunction in her pistol cost Indian shooting ace Manu Bhaker dearly as she lost nearly 20 minutes during her qualifications, leading to a heartbreaking

exit from the women's 10m air pistol event at the Tokyo Olympics here on Sunday.

When the technical snag — the pistol's cocking lever broke down — happened, she was to take 44 shots in 55 minutes.

► **Aus thrash India**
Australia thrashed India 7-1 in the group stage encounter to retain their place on top. The world number one side literally toyed with India, scoring at will in each quarter, with India scoring their solitary goal in the third.

► **Chanu earns free pizza**
Domino's Pizza pledged free pizza for life to India's silver medalist Saikhom Mirabai Chanu, after the champion

said she wished to eat pizza after her feat at the Tokyo Olympics.

The chain on Saturday also delivered pizzas to her family to celebrate Chanu winning the silver medal for India.

► **Lone gymnast exits Games**
India's lone gymnast at Tokyo Olympics, Pranati Nayak, failed to qualify for the All Round finals of Artistic Gymnastics competition here on Sunday. The 26-year-old from West Bengal recorded a total score of 42.565 over the four categories — floor exercise, vault, uneven bars and balance beam — at the Ariake Gymnastic centre.

Pegasus row: CPI(M) RS MP moves top court

CPI(M) Rajya Sabha member John Brittas has moved the Supreme Court (SC), seeking a court-monitored probe into reports of alleged snooping of activists, politicians, journalists and constitutional functionaries using Israeli spyware Pegasus.

In a statement on Sunday, Brittas said despite the very serious nature, the central government has not cared to investigate into the allegations involved in the issue but "made only a hopeful hope that the time-tested processes in our country are well-established to ensure that unauthorised surveillance does not occur".

Congress leader P Chidambaram said the government should either call for a joint parliamentary committee probe into the snooping allegations or request the SC to appoint a sitting judge to investigate the matter, and demanded that PM Narendra Modi make a statement in Parliament clarifying whether there had been surveillance or not.

Shiv Sena MP Sanjay Raut asked who funded the alleged snooping and compared it with the Hiroshima bombing, saying while the attack on the Japanese city had resulted in death of people, the spying by the Israeli software led to "death of freedom".
