- (i) The Prospective Resolution Applicant shall not be eligible to submit an EOI for Bid in this Bidding Process if it suffers from any of the disqualification/ineligibility criteria set out in Section 29A of the Code (as amended from time to time). The Bidder shall submit the relevant information and records to enable an assessment of ineligibility as set out under the provisions of Section 29A of the Code including but not limited to the details of its Connected Person as required in Annexure G of this document.
- (ii) Furthermore, the Prospective Resolution Applicant shall have either of the following to become eligible to submit EOI under this document:
 - a) Category A An Individual, HUF, Private/Public Limited Company, LLP/Registered Firm, Government Organizations/Registered Trusts and any Body Corporates whether incorporated in India or outside India having:
 - -Minimum Net Worth (NW) of INR 50 Crores as on latest available audited financial statements, but not earlier than 31st March 2022;
 - b) Category B Financial Institutions (FI)/Funds/Private Equity (PE) Investors/Venture Capital/Domestic or Foreign Investment Institution/NBFC/Eligible ARC/AIF & Similar Entities having:
 - -Minimum Assets Under Management (AUM) of INR 200 Crores as on latest available date but not earlier than 31st March 2022: or
 - c) Category C Consortiums:
 - -There shall be a designated lead member of the consortium, and such lead member shall hold at least 26% of total equity/voting rights/ capital contribution in the consortium. All other members would need to have a minimum stake of 10% of total equity/voting rights/ capital contribution of each in the consortium;
 - -In case of **homogeneous consortium**, it shall meet the following threshold on consolidated basis:
 - •For the consortium of members from Category A: Minimum Net worth of the Consortium shall be at least INR 75 Crores as on latest available audited financial statements but not earlier than 31st March 2022.
 - •For the consortium of members from Category B: Minimum Assets Under Management (AUM) of INR 200 Crores as on latest available date but not earlier than 31st March 2022.

ANNEXURE E

Section 29A of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016

Person not eligible to be resolution applicant

A person shall not be eligible to submit a resolution plan, if such person, or any other person acting jointly or in concert with such person:

- (a) is an undischarged insolvent;
- (b) is a wilful defaulter in accordance with the guidelines of the Reserve Bank of India issued under the Banking Regulation Act, 1949 (10 of 1949);
- (c) at the time of submission of the resolution plan has an account, or an account of a corporate debtor under the management or control of such person or of whom such person is a promoter, classified as non-performing asset in accordance with the guidelines of the Reserve Bank of India issued under the Banking Regulation Act, 1949 (10 of 1949) or the guidelines of a financial sector regulator issued under any other law for the time being in force, and at least a period of one year has lapsed from the date of such classification till the date of commencement of the corporate insolvency resolution process of the corporate debtor:

Provided that the person shall be eligible to submit a resolution plan if such person makes payment of all overdue amounts with interest thereon and charges relating to non performing asset accounts before submission of resolution plan:

Provided further that nothing in this clause shall apply to a resolution applicant where such applicant is a financial entity and where such an entity is not a related party to the corporate debtor.

Explanation I- For the purposes of this proviso, the expression "related party" shall not include a financial entity, regulated by a financial sector regulator, if it is a financial creditor of the corporate debtor and is a related party of the corporate debtor solely on account of conversion or substitution of debt into equity shares or instruments convertible into equity shares, prior to the insolvency commencement date.

Explanation II— For the purposes of this clause, where a resolution applicant has an account, or an account of a corporate debtor under the management or control of such person or of whom such person is a promoter, classified as non-performing asset and such account was acquired pursuant to a prior resolution plan approved under this Code, then, the provisions of this clause shall not apply to such resolution applicant for a period of three years from the date of approval of such resolution plan by the Adjudicating Authority under this Code;

- (d) has been convicted for any offence punishable with imprisonment –
- (i) for two years or more under any Act specified under the Twelfth Schedule; or
- (ii) for seven years or more under any law for the time being in force:

Provided that this clause shall not apply to a person after the expiry of a period of two years from the date of his release from imprisonment:

Provided further that this clause shall not apply in relation to a connected person referred to in clause(iii) of Explanation I;

(e) is disqualified to act as a director under the Companies Act, 2013 (18 of 2013):

Provided that this clause shall not apply in relation to a connected person referred to in clause (iii) of Explanation I;

- (f) is prohibited by the Securities and Exchange Board of India from trading in securities or accessing the securities markets;
- (g) has been a promoter or in the management or control of a corporate debtor in which a preferential transaction, undervalued transaction, extortionate credit transaction or fraudulent transaction has taken place and in respect of which an order has been made by the Adjudicating Authority under this Code:

Provided that this clause shall not apply if a preferential transaction, undervalued transaction, extortionate credit transaction or fraudulent transaction has taken place prior to the acquisition of the corporate debtor by the resolution applicant pursuant to a resolution plan approved under this Code or pursuant to a scheme or plan approved by a financial sector regulator or a court, and such resolution applicant has not otherwise contribute to the preferential transaction, undervalued transaction, extortionate credit transaction or fraudulent transaction:

- (h) has executed a guarantee in favour of a creditor in respect of a corporate debtor against which an application for insolvency resolution made by such creditor has been admitted under this Code and such guarantee has been invoked by the creditor and remains unpaid in full or part;
- (i) is subject to any disability, corresponding to clauses (a) to (h), under any law in a jurisdiction outside India; or
- (j) has a connected person not eligible under clauses (a) to (i).

Explanation [I]. — For the purposes of this clause, the expression "connected person" means—

- (i) any person who is the promoter or in the management or control of the resolution applicant; or
- (ii) any person who shall be the promoter or in management or control of the business of the corporate debtor during the implementation of the resolution plan; or
- (iii) the holding company, subsidiary company, associate company or related party of a person referred to in clauses (i) and (ii):

Provided that nothing in clause (iii) of Explanation I shall apply to a resolution applicant where such applicant is a financial entity and such an entity is not a related party of the corporate debtor:

Provided further that the expression "related party" shall not include a financial entity, regulated by a financial sector regulator, if it is a financial creditor of the corporate debtor and is a related party of the corporate debtor solely on account of conversion or substitution of debt into equity shares or instruments convertible into equity shares, prior to the insolvency commencement date;

[Explanation II—For the purposes of this section, "financial entity" shall mean the following entities which meet such criteria or conditions as the Central Government may, in consultation with the financial sector regulator, notify in this behalf, namely:

- (a) a scheduled bank;
- (b) any entity regulated by a foreign central bank or a securities market regulator or other financial sector regulator of a jurisdiction outside India which jurisdiction is compliant with the Financial Action Task Force Standards and is a signatory to the International Organisation of Securities Commissions Multilateral Memorandum of Understanding;

- (c) any investment vehicle, registered foreign institutional investor, registered foreign portfolio investor or a foreign venture capital investor, where the terms shall have the meaning assigned to them in Regulation 2 of the Foreign Exchange Management (Transfer or Issue of Security by a Person Resident Outside India) Regulations, 2017 made under the Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999 (42 of 1999);
- (d) an asset reconstruction company registered with the Reserve Bank of India under section 3 of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (54 of 2002);
- (e) an Alternate Investment Fund registered with Securities and Exchange Board of India;
- (f) such categories of persons as may be notified by the Central Government

Amritpal's convoy knocked down 4-5 two-wheelers while escaping

Chandigarh: A .315-bore weapon, 57 live cartridges, a walkie-talkie set and a kirpan were found in the pickup truck used by fugitive Khalistan sympathiser and self-styled preacher Amritpal Singh to escape Punjab Police's dragnet before switching to a Mercedes, Jalandhar (Rural) SSP Swarandeep Singh said.

The vehicle's owner, Manpreet Singh of Nawanshahr district, was arrested later. In Amritsar, interrogation of the seven associates of Amritpal arrested on Saturday led cops to another cache of weapons and ammunition comprising five .12 bore rifles and 193 cartridges. Another 34 Waris Puniab De members and protesters attempting to disturb peace were arrested on Sunday, taking number of arrests to 112. Search teams earlier in the day found two aban-

doned Ford Endeavour SUVs suspected to be part of Amritpal's convoy. Jalandhar Rural police registered a fresh case against the absconding Khalistan sympathiser and his associates in connection with the seizure. Jalandhar DIG Swapan Sharma said investigators had received leads about Amritpal having links with Pakistan's ISI and were trying to verify these.

Sharma said the police

had already confirmed that his fleeing convoy knocked down "four to five" two-wheelers while racing down a lane.

Three people were injured at different spots, but there could be more. We have videos of specific incidents." Jalandhar police commissioner Kuldeep Singh Chahal said one of the teams going after Amritpal chased his car for 20 to 25km Saturday before he managed to escape. DIG Shar-

pal was still on the run, the police operation so far had been successful in terms of "breaking his will and his network, including arresting his associates". "Our objective was not to use any force and ensure public safety. No physical harm was caused to anybody," he said. The police are investigating people who provided the vehicles used by Amritpal. The Mercedes he was seen in belongs to a person whose brother was killed in an encounter with the police, the DIG said.

Amritsar (Rural) SSP Satinder Singh said the seven arrested associates of Amritpal-identified as Ajaypal Singh, Gurvir Singh, Baljinder Singh, Harminder Singh, Gurpal Singh, Sapreet Singh and Amandeep Singh-were produced in Baba Bakala court Sunday and remanded in police custody till March 23.

DIPLOMAT SUMMONED

Indian embassy in UK attacked by Khalistani supporters

New Delhi: After the Indian high commission in London was vandalised on Sunday by Khalistan supporters, New Delhi summoned the seniormost UK diplomat in town to register a strong protest and sought an explanation for "complete absence of British security". Visuals on social media showed a Khalistan supporter climbing the walls of the high commission to pull down the Indian flag on top of the building. It was apparently replaced by the Khalistani flag. UK high commissioner Alex Ellis condemned the "disgraceful acts" against the people and premises of the Indian high commission, saying this was totally unacceptable. Ellis could not be summoned as he was travelling. So deputy high commissioner was summoned.

"The senior-most UK diplomat in New Delhi was summoned late evening today [Sunday] to convey India's strong protest at the actions taken by separatist and extremist elements against the Indian high commission in London," said the government. "An explanation was demanded for the absence of British security that allowed these elements to enter the high commission premises. She senior-most UK diplomat in Ellis's absence] was reminded of the basic obligations of the UK government under Vienna Convention," it added. New Delhi also said it finds unacceptable the indifference of the UK government to the security of Indian diplomatic premises and personnel in the country, "It is expected that the UK government would take immediate steps to identify, arrest and prosecute those involved in today's incident, and put in place stringent measures to prevent recurrence of such incidents," said ministry of external affairs said. TNN



Rise in Covid cases among sharpest in Guj, 3.5x in 1 wk

The seven-day average of daily Covid cases in India has doubled in the last eight days, rising from 353 on March 10 to 704 on March 18, as per TOI's Covid database. Last week, the doubling rate was close to 11 days, indicating that infections have spread more rapidly in the current week.

As of Sunday, the number of active cases in India had crossed 6,000, rising from 3,778 last Sunday. The test positivity rate (TPR) the percentage of test samples that are positive - was still low for the country as a whole, which indicates that cases aren't rising yet in many parts of India. The daily TPR crossed 1% on Saturday, although the seven-day average was around 0.8% but rising gradually.

In the past seven days, Maharashtra displaced Karnataka as the state recording the highest number of fresh cases. Maharashtra reported 1,165 new infections during the period (March 12-18), a 2.3-fold in-



crease from the previous seven-day period. Kerala reported 739 cases, up from 520. The rise appeared to be slowing down in Karnataka, with the state logging 656 cases, up from 584 in the previous seven days.

The rise in numbers was among the sharpest in Gujarat, which reported 660 cases in the seven-day period ending Saturday, a 3.5 times increase over the previous seven days when the state had recorded 190 cases. In the north, Himachal Pradesh registered a similar ra-

te of increase, with fresh cases rising from 49 to 177.

Numbers rose steadily in the national capital as well. Delhi reported 235 new cases during the period, up from 97. On Sunday, 72 more new cases were added to the capital's tally. Although the numbers were lower, infections were on the rise in other northern states such as Rajasthan, Haryana, UP, Punjab and Uttarakhand.

While deaths from Covid have been generally decreasing, the spike in cases was now pushing up the toll.

MP crash: Plane was flying very low & hit a hill

Bhopal: The training plane that crashed in Madhya Pradesh's Balaghat on Saturday was seen flying very low before plunging into the ground and catching fire, witnesses have told police. The Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has started its investigation and officers inspected the site on Sunday.

The Diamond 40 aircraft was owned by Indira Gandhi Rashtriya Uran Akademi. Instructor Mohit Thakur, from Himachal Pradesh, and trainee pilot B Maheshwari, from Gujarat, died in the crash.
