6 JeM terrorists including 2 Pakistani terrorists neutralized in Kashmir

Srinagar (Hindusthan Samachar) : During past 24 hours, two anti-terrorist operations were carried out in twin districts of South Kashmir resulting in elimination of 6 terrorists of proscribed terror outfit JeM including 2 Pakistani terrorists, this was stated by IGP, Kashmir. Among the killed terrorists, two terrorists were involved in gruesome terror attack on Police Bus at Zewan. Incriminating materials and huge cache of arms and ammunition were also recovered from the encounter sites. In Anantnag, based on specific input generated by Police regarding presence of terrorists in Nowgam Dooru area, a joint cordon and search operation was launched by Police, 19RR and the 164 Bn CRPF in the said area. During the search operation, as the presence of terrorists was ascertained they fired indiscriminately upon the joint search party which was retaliated leading to an encounter. In the initial exchange of fire, four security forces personnel including a policeman received gunshot injuries. They were evacuated to hospital for treatment of their injuries however, one Army Jawan



encounter, 03 terrorists of proscribed terror outfit JeM were killed and their bodies were retrieved from the site of encounter. They have been identified as Sultan @Rayees @Mavia (a foreign terrorist), NisarAhmad Khanday resident of Dudwanan Kapran and Altaf Ahmad Shah resident of Nathipora Dooru. As per police records, all the killed terrorists were part of group involved in several terror crime cases including attacks on security forces and civilian atrocities. Several terror crime cases were registered against them including attack on family of a police personnel at Kokagund in which his wife and daughter received injuries. IGP Kashmir has termed the elimination of most wanted terrorists as a big success and congratulated the joint forces who work relentlessly with great synergy and coordination on ground. He also paid rich tributes to the martyred Army Jawan who made supreme sacrifices in the line of duty and also prayed for the speedy recovery of the injured personnel.

States start creating makeshift hospitals for Covid cases in kids



NEW DELHI : Covid-19 cases rise continues to unabated Centre on Saturday issued a fresh set of instructions to states asking them to start creating makeshift hospitals, to tie up with hotels to convert them into temporary hospitals and to keep an eye on paediatric cases. The directions come as the government is fearing an exponential rise in Covid-19 cases which may lead to a large number of people getting moderately or severely ill within a very short period of time. On Saturday morning, a total of 22,775 new Covid-19 cases were recorded in the country while the number of active cases shot past 1,04,781, the highest in nearly two and a half months. In letters sent to the state chief secretaries, the Union health secretary said that with the sudden rise in cases, parts of the country may start seeing a stressed health infrastructure. "To address a potential surge in cases, with a view to ensuring preparedness, states are advised to initiate the creation of field or makeshift hospitals to augment the availability of health infrastructure," said the letter. It added that states may take

the help of agencies such as DRDO, CSIR, corporations, private sector or NGOs. The health secretary also said that states may also consider leveraging hotel rooms and other accommodations linked with the Covid dedicated hospitals in the government and private sector to cater to patients with mild or moderate cases. The Centre also said that as a large number of patients will need to isolate at home, the states need to ensure that the home isolation guidelines are properly implemented, using measures such as the creation of special teams, call centres and control rooms which may guide patients on hospitalization in case of need. "A clearly defined mechanism to assess testing, ambulances and hospital beds needs to be put in place and communicated to the public at large," said the letter, adding that a mechanism where people can call and get ambulances and beds in a transparent manner. States have also been instructed to ensure that the existing Covid dedicated health infrastructure is revisited and necessary action to ensure its operational readiness be taken, with a clear focus on rural areas and paediatric cases.

Dozens Joins Apni Party in Marh

Jammu (Hindusthan Samachar) : Apni Party while strengthening its roots in Jammu region has started mass contact program in Jammu Rural. Devi Dutta Sr Vice President Jammu Rural Apni Party conducted a series of tours in the Marh Assembly Constituency where he discussed the party's manifesto and agenda for the development of J&K. Getting impressed by the party's fundamentals and objectives, dozens of people resigning from Congress, NC and PDP joined Apni Party. Speaking on the occasion Devi Dutta said that J&K has gone far behind in means of

development from the last few years. He said only a visionary leader like Altaf Bukhari can lead J&K on the track of development from here. He said Apni Party is the only party in J&K which has concrete plans for creating employment for unemployed youth of J&K. Dutta lambasted previous NC, PDP and Congress regimes for dragging the youth of J&K into darkness by not providing them adequate employment opportunities. He appealed to youth to strengthen the Apni Party for their secure future. He said the Apni Party will unite people of all castes, religions and regions for a prosperous J&K.

Tripura Father-son duo shot police in Mizoram

AGARTALA : A 40-year-old man and his teenager son, both residents of North Tripura district, were shot at by the Mizoram Police when they had entered the neighbouring state for jhum cultivation, a senior officer said on Saturday. According to district Superintendent of Police Bhanupada Chakraborty, Ramuhai Reang and his 14-year-old son Rathindra, along with other locals of Kanchanpur subdivision, often visited the neighbouring state for farming. On Friday afternoon, however, the Mizoram Police opened fire at the father-son duo "for reasons still unclear", following which the two sustained bullet

injuries, the SP said. He further noted that the Mizoram Police has claimed the two entered their state with drugs. Ramuhai managed to escape and re-enter Tripura, but his son was taken into custody by the Mizoram Police, Chakraborty explained. "We have come to know that the boy underwent an operation at an Aizawl hospital. His condition is stable," the SP stated. Ramuhai is undergoing treatment at Dharmanager Hospital in the district. A case has been registered at Vangmun police station and a probe is underway, the SP said, adding that additional forces have been mobilised along the interstate border, where the situation is tense but under control.

sexual assault booked for Tourism department MD Telangana

Hyderabad: The managing director of Telangana Tourism was booked by Narayanguda police for sexually assaulting a worker. The incident occurred in August, 2016 when the woman was employed by the Tourism department. A case has now been registered against him after the High Court ordered the city police to register an FIR and investigate into the matter. As per the FIR, a copy of which is in possession of Deccan Chronicle, the accused B. Manohar Rao sexually assaulted a woman while he was staying in a suite during the inauguration of boat units at Nagarjuna Sagar in 2016.

The woman, belonging to the ST community, was working as a general helper at Vijay Vihar Guest House, Nagarjuna Sagar when the incident occurred. On August 31, 2016, at around 10 am, Rao had called her to his room to clean the

bathrooms and when she came out, she saw him standing with a towel. He pushed her on the bed. When she resisted, he threatened to remove her from her job. She somehow managed to escape and informed her colleague, who pointed out that he was a very influential person. In July 2017, when she came to Hyderabad along with her colleagues, she came in contact with an advocate who advised her to lodge a complaint with her management head, Dr. Christina Z Chongtu. When she approached her in September, the matter was not referred to police and a departmental enquiry that was ostensibly launched never progressed. In December of the same year, the victim was told that her contract period had expired," read the FIR.

Rs 102.50 prices slashed Commercial LPG cylinder

New Delhi : In some relief for consumers on New Year, National Oil Marketing companies have slashed the prices of 19 kg commercial LPG cylinder cost by Rs 102.50 effective from January 1, 2022. It will provide some relief to restaurants, eateries and tea stalls etc which constitute the largest user segment of the 19 kg cylinder. Last month on December 1, prices of 19 Kg LPG cylinders were increased by Rs 100 bringing the prices of 19 kg commercial cylinders to Rs 2,101



in Delhi which was the second-highest price of 19 kg commercial cylinder after 2012-13 when it cost around Rs 2,200 per cylinder. However, there is no decrease in prices of other domestic

rise of Rs 266, increasing the prices to Rs 2,000.50. A 19-kg cylinder, following the new rate cut, will cost Rs 1,998.50 as against Rs 2,101 in Delhi. LPG Cylinder rate is revised monthly for all the states and union territories in India. Earlier on October 1, prices of 19kg cylinders were increased by Rs 43 and on October 6, Rs 2.50 decrease in 19 kg commercial cylinder. On September 1, prices of 19kg cylinder were increased by Rs 75.

UT of J&K emerges leading performer in incremental performance in country: NITI Aayog Health Index Report

JAMMU, (Hindusthan Samachar) : Jammu & Kashmir has emerged as the leading performer in terms of incremental performance as per data released by NITI Aayog in the fourth Health Index report. Among union Territories, Delhi followed by Jammu & Kashmir, has shown the best incremental performance. In incremental performance, J&K is ranked at number second position with a score of 9.55. In J&K, most of the indicators are in the improved/most improved/fully achieved category so far as the Incremental Performance from the Base Year (2018-19) to Reference Year (2019-20) is concerned. The Health & Medical Education Department while giving information about the development said that a robust and acceptable mechanism is used for measuring performance by NITI Aayog. Data is collected online through a portal maintained by NITI on agreed indicators. The data is then validated through an independent validation

agency selected through a transparent bidding process. The importance of this annual tool is reemphasized by MoHFW's decision to link the index to incentives under National Health Mission. This has been instrumental in shifting the focus from budget spending and inputs to outputs and outcomes. According to the report, the health index comprises three domains: health outcomes, governance and information, and key inputs and processes. In terms of overall health performance, the UT of J&K has moved one position up and is categorized as an aspirant and has substantial scope for improvement, the statement added. The report was released

jointly by NITI Aayog Vice Chairman Dr Rajiv Kumar, CEO Amitabh Kant, Additional Secretary Dr Rakesh Sarwal, and World Bank Senior Health Specialist Sheena Chhabra. The report has been developed by NITI Aayog, with technical assistance from the World Bank, and in close consultation with the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW).
