Chinese diplomat praises India for impressive economic growth, Chandrayaan

Mumbai, Feb 6 (UNI) : Kong Xianhua, Consul General of China in Mumbai, has praised India for its impressive economic growth and Chandrayaan on the occasion of the Chinese New Year Reception.

As the Year of the Dragon is around the corner, the Chinese Consulate General in Mumbai held the Chinese New Year Reception and Chinese Cultural Festival. Since the Spring Festival is now a UN holiday with more than 7 billion people all over the world celebrating it fervently, over 300 people from all walks of life attended the event.

On the occasion, the Chinese Consul General Kong Xianhua delivered a welcome speech. Kong extended his congratulations to the Indian people and said: "India has made significant achievements in various aspects in 2023, including a 7.3% economic growth rate, a

wonderful performance in the Asian Games held in China, and Chandrayaan-3's successful landing on the moon."

Kong then stated: "2023 marks a year of achievement and harvest for both China and India as the China-India trade volume surpasses \$136.2 billion." He added, "The tunnel under Malabar Hill, the hardest part of the Mumbai Coastal Road project, was built with a Chinese tunnel boring machine by the efforts of both Chinese and Indian engineers."

He said, "When we enjoy a peaceful and prosperous life today, we cannot forget the heroes like Dr. Kotnis who sacrificed their lives for national independence against imperialism."

Chinese people still pay their respect and tribute to Dr. Dawrkadas Kotnis. Nagesh Bhosle, the famous Marathi actor and director, visited China recently and has made a documentary on Dr. Kotnis.

Pune police chief warns of action against illegal businesses

Pune, Feb 6 (UNI) : Strict action will be taken against those who give silent consent to illegal businesses in the city and those who are directly or indirectly involved in them (including police personnel and officials), warned new police commissioner Amitesh Kumar on Tuesday. Talking to media here, he said that pubs in the city will totally shut after midnight. No illegal activities will continue in the city in future, he noted.

Police personnel and officers performing duty in the same police station or in the same department (Crime Branch / Traffic Branch / Special Branch / Headquarters) for more than five years will be transferred, he informed.

Accordingly, 77 police sub-inspectors and assistant police inspectors will be transferred today and tomorrow (Wednesday).

Considering the rise in number of cyber crimes, more police personnel and officers will be appointed in the cyber cell, he added. The police chief assured that traffic jams in the major intersections of the city will be solved shortly.

ECI's decision a victory of 'invisible power', conspiracy against State : Supriya Sule

Mumbai, Feb 6 (PTI) : NCP MP Supriya Sule on Tuesday dubbed the ECI's decision to recognise the Ajit Pawar faction as the real Nationalist Congress Party a "victory of invisible power" and a conspiracy against Maharashtra and Marathi people.

The Election Commission of India also allotted the NCP symbol 'Wall Clock' to the group led by Ajit Pawar.

"The ECI's decision is the victory of the invisible power. This is a huge conspiracy against Maharashtra and Marathi people. However, I am not at all surprised by this decision," Sule, daughter of NCP founder Sharad Pawar, told reporters in New Delhi.

She also drew a parallel between the ECI's ruling in the Shiv Sena (undivided) case, referring to the poll body acknowledging the Eknath Shinde-led group as the real Sena after he

rebelled against Uddhav Thackeray in 2022.

"Both parties (the NCP and undivided Shiv Sena) were born in Maharashtra and led by Marathi people. This is one more example of how the invisible powers make decisions that would hurt the Marathi people and the state," said Sule.

She said the "conspiracy" hatched against the late Bal Thackeray's family is now replicated against Sharad Pawar.

"Pawar saheb started his political career without any legacy or background. The ECI's decision is not the truth. It is an injustice to the people of Maharashtra," Sule added.

She said new names will be submitted to the ECI ahead of the upcoming Rajya Sabha elections.

Speaking to reporters in Mumbai, Maharashtra NCP president (Sharad Pawar group) Jayant Patil said

they will challenge the ECI decision in the Supreme Court, which is the "last hope". He said the NCP was founded by Sharad Pawar who developed it from the grassroots and also helped many leaders grow in their political careers.

Sharad Pawar loyalist and former minister Jitendra Awhad also alleged the ECI decision was "managed" from the top.

Queried on a huge number of affidavits filed before the ECI by both sides of the NCP ahead of the ruling, Awhad said, "The ECI exercise was a circus. It was pre-decided who would get the NCP name and symbol".

Targeting Ajit Pawar and other MLAs who sided with him, Awhad said he felt sad as those who enjoyed the fruits of Sharad Pawar's efforts to expand the NCP are now trying to "politically strangle" the

veteran. When asked about the future course of action, Awhad said, "Sharad Pawar is our party. He is our symbol and people of this state know him. There are many people in the state who are still firmly behind Pawar". He said it was Sharad Pawar who expanded the party base in other states as well.

"Who made him (Ajit Pawar) deputy chief minister (in erstwhile UPA and MVA governments)? Who made (Sunil) Tatkare the irrigation minister (in previous governments)? The answer is Sharad Pawar," he added.

Awhad also targeted senior leaders Dilip Walse Patil and Hasan Mushrif, who aligned with Ajit Pawar when he joined the Shiv Sena-BJP government last July, terming them as "opportunists". "Sharad Pawar will rise as a proverbial phoenix bird. No one can paralyse him," he added.

Two Naxalites sentenced to life imprisonment in Sonbhadra

Sonbhadra (UP), Feb 6 (UNI) : Two Naxalites were sentenced to life imprisonment along with a penalty of Rs 25,000 each by a local court here in Sonbhadra district here in Uttar Pradesh on Tuesday, prosecution sources said here. Prosecution sources said that on May 23, 2012 night acting on a specific information the police team led by the then Superintendent of Police (SP) Subhash Chandra Dubey raided the jungles of Kanachh Kanhaura jungle. "During the raid a gunfight ensued between the police and Naxalites," they said.

Prosecution sources said that during encounter

the police arrested two Naxalites Munna Vishwakarma alias Vidrohi and Ajit Kol alias Abhishek alias Ramvriksh. "The police recovered arms of prohibited bore along with the ammunition from the possession of the arrested accused. While Munna carried a reward of Rs 10 lakh on his arrest announced by UP, Madhya Pradesh and Bihar police, a reward of Rs 50,000 was declared on Ajit Kol," they said. Prosecution sources said that based on the evidence available on record and testimony of witnesses the court of Additional Session Judge Ehsanullah Khan held Munna Vishwakarma and Ajit Kol guilty and sentenced them to life imprisonment.

Gujarat paid Rs 8,200 cr in excess to Adani Power as energy purchase charge: Congress ; govt trashes claim

Gandhinagar, Feb 6 (PTI) : The Congress on Tuesday alleged the Gujarat government has paid Rs 8,200 crore in

excess to Adani Power towards electricity purchase charges in two years which it dubbed "favouritism", a claim dismissed by the power minister who cited the rise in coal purchase cost.

The Congress also demanded that the government recover the "additional Rs 8,265 crore" from Adani and invest it in increasing the capacity of state-run power generators.

During Question Hour of the budget session of the Assembly, Congress MLA Tushar Chaudhary sought to know the rates at which the government purchased electricity from Adani Power Ltd during 2022 and 2023. In his reply, Power

Minister Kanubhai Desai said electricity

is purchased as per the "meritor" system which was introduced by the former Congress-led UPA government. "The state government had entered into an agreement with Adani Power in 2007 to purchase power at Rs 2.89 per unit under bid-1 and at Rs 2.35 per unit under bid-2 for 25 years. Such power purchase agreements were also signed with two other private players - Tata Power and Essar Power," Desai stated in a written reply. Since these thermal power generators were dependent on imported coal from Indonesia, they went into trouble and shut their plants after the coal prices shot up exponentially after 2021, the minister stated, adding that revised agreements were signed in 2018 and 2022 to

adjust the rise in coal purchase cost. Unhappy with the reply, Congress MLA Amit Chavda said as against an average energy charge of Rs 2.62 per unit agreed to in 2007 for 25 years, the state government paid an average charge of Rs 7.18 per unit in 2022 and Rs 5.33 per unit in 2023.

"Despite the agreement, the government paid Rs 8,265 crore more to Adani Power. We are worried because taxpayers' money was paid to Adani. Eight years are still left for the completion of 25 years. So, are you planning to review your decision and sign a new agreement with

Adani?" asked Chavda. He also demanded that the government recover the "additional Rs 8,265 crore" from Adani and invest it in increasing the capacity of state-run power generators.

Desai said Adani was not given any preference because electricity was also purchased from other private players as per the Gujarat Electricity Regulatory Commission's merit order, a system which was introduced when Congress was in

power. When some BJP MLAs accused Congress of unnecessarily hounding Adani, Chavda said his party is concerned because taxpayers' money is involved. "During the last two years, the energy charges paid to Adani were higher than what was agreed upon in the past. You are saying that rates were revised because coal became costly. But today, Adani owns coal mines in Australia and other countries and can get coal at cheaper rates.
