Go First to Avail ₹600cr Loan under ECLGS

Mumbai: Budget airline Go First plans to avail ₹600 crore loan under the Emergency Covid-19 Loan Scheme (ECLGS) for its operations amid rising air travel demand, according to a source. The source said the airline also said that it has already received ₹2,000 crore in the last 10 months which has helped the carrier tackle multiple headwinds, including rise in petroleum, freight costs and higher fuel costs.

To help the airline industry, which is on the recovery path after being significantly hit by the pandemic, the government, last month, notified the ECLGS by raising the limit of loan that can be availed by an entity to ₹2,500 crore from ₹100 crore earlier. The government said the limit will be applied to all firms that are eligible. Go First carried 0.53 lakh domestic passengers and its market share was at 7.9%.

Earlier this week, aviation minister Bhupendra Patel estimated the loss of Indian Airlines to exceed ₹23 billion this year. This is higher than its earlier projection of ₹4.5-7 billion for the same period. PFI

Pfizer, BioNTech Start Covid-flu Combination Vaccine Study

Researchers Pfizer and its German partner BioNTech SE have started a early-stage study to evaluate a combination vaccine targeting Covid-19 and influenza, the companies said on Thursday. The single dose vaccine candidate is a combination of Pfizer's mRNA-based, BNT162b2 and the company's Omicron-targeted Covid-19 booster shot.

The early-stage study, which is sponsored by BioNTech, aims to evaluate the combination shot's safety, tolerability and immunogenicity, or the ability to generate an immune response. The trial is being conducted in the United States and the companies aim to enroll 100 volunteers between the ages of 18 and 64. The first part of the study was aimed earlier this week.

Not Able to Contact Mallya, says Lawyer; SC Discharges Him from Case

New Delhi: The lawyer of fugitive businessman Vijay Mallya on Thursday told the Supreme Court that he was not reaching any communication from him and sought to be discharged from the case as it involved a bench of Justices D.Y. Chandrachud and Hima Kohli allowed the discharge of E.C. Aggrawal from the case and asked him to furnish the e-mail ID of the lawyer along with his present residential address in the United Kingdom to the court registry. "Coercive seeking discharge from the case because of communication from him and, no strictum in Scithening," the bench said and asked the lawyer to file the status of discharge. Aggrawal told the top court, "I want to be discharged from this matter as I am not receiving any instructions from my client. I am not able to establish contact with him. He is communicating for a long time." SC discharged the lawyer from the two petitions filed by Mallya against the October 3, 2020 and September 15, 2020 orders of the Karnataka High Court directing him to pay ₹63.30 crore to a consortium of banks.

HPCL Posts ₹2,172 cr Loss in Q2

New Delhi: Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Ltd (HPCL) on Thursday reported ₹2,172.14 net loss in July-September after losses arising from increasing petrol and diesel prices typically be made up by accounting for a one-time government grant that came after the quarter had ended.

Standalone net loss of ₹2,172.14 crore in the second quarter of the current fiscal year compares to ₹1,023.5 crore profit in the same period last year, according to the company's filing to the stock exchanges.

This is the first time that the company posted a net loss quarterly loss. HPCL posted a record of ₹10,28.94 crore in the April-June quarter.

Just like HPCL, Indian Oil Corporation (IOC) — the nation's largest oil firm — too had posted a second straight quarterly loss as state-owned firms sold petrol, diesel and cooking gas (LPG) at rates below cost to help the government contain inflation.

The loss in the second quarter of the current fiscal was despite accounting for a one-time grant that the government had announced on October 12 to make up for most of the losses that the oil PSUs had incurred on selling cooking gas LPG below cost in the last two years.

HPCL said it got ₹61.87 crore "to compensate under economies incurred on the sale of domestic LPG during the financial year 2021-22 and current period, which has been duly recognised in July-September 2022".

The government had on October 12 extended a one-time grant of ₹12,000 crore to three state-owned fuel retailers to cover for losses they incurred on selling domestic cooking gas LPG below cost in the last two years.

IOC had got ₹18,800 crore, yet it booked a ₹1,712.31 crore loss in Q2.

HPCL, IOC and Bharat Petroleum Corporation Ltd (BPCL) did not revise petrol, diesel and cooking gas LPG prices since early April despite a rise in input cost. This was with a view to helping the government contain inflation, which has been above the consumer zone.

The three firms had reported a combined net loss of ₹18,486 crore in the first quarter (April-June).

While the government regulates cooking gas rates, petrol and diesel prices are deregulated and oil companies are not compensated for any losses or economies incur on them.

Oil Minister Hardeep Singh Puri had, however, on Wednesday stated that his ministry would look up the issue of compensation for petrol and diesel losses with the finance ministry.

The three firms, who are supposed to revise petrol and diesel prices daily in line with cost, however, changed the rates for over six half-months now — the longest freeze in recent times. Fuel pricing was deregulated.

For the first half of the current fiscal, HPCL, now has a cumulative standalone net loss of ₹2,288.06 crore — double the ₹1,166.31 crore net profit it had earned in the full 2021-22 (April-June) to March 2022 fiscal.

HPCL said it incurred USD 5.62 bn in foreign exchange loss of over \$100 million during April-September compared to a gross refining margin of USD 2.87 a barrel in PFI.
