Google's Al chatbot Bard is now Gemini

JEFFREY DASTIN San Francisco, February 8

GOOGLE ON THURSDAY renamed its Bard chatbot after the new artificial intelligence that is powering it, called Gemini, and said consumers can pay for better reasoning capabilities as it vies with Microsoft to win subscriptions.

US customers can subscribe for \$19.99 a month to access Gemini Advanced, which includes a more powerful Ultra 1.0 AI model, the Alphabet subsidiary said. Subscribers will receive two terabytes of cloud storage that typically cost \$9.99 monthly and they will soon gain access to Gemini in Gmail and Google's productivity suite. This bundle, known as the Google One AI Premium plan, represents one of the company's biggest answers yet to Microsoft and its partner OpenAI. It also shows growing competition over consumers, who now have several paid AI

subscription options.

models and other features, while Microsoft recently announced a competing subscription for AI in programs such as Word and Excel. Both subscriptions cost \$20 a month in the United States.

In an interview, Product Lead Jack Krawczyk said cloud storage, Gmail and other integrations would put Google's subscription in harmony with how people work.

"When I pay \$20 a month, access to a model alone is not really enough," he said. Krawczyk said the target market is people who want the most capable generative AI technology that can conjure new content on command and handle queries where no obvious answer exists **— REUTERS** online.

UPA plunged economy into a crisis: White Paper

ALSO, THERE WASN'T any explicit comparison of the economic growth rates between the 10 years of the Modi regime and the previous decade. The Covid-19 pandemic had wreaked havoc on the economy during the NDA government, but the recovery was smart, and the fiscal cost of it controlled.

The White Paper said there is "miles to go and mountains to scale before we sleep" as the destination is to make India a developed nation by 2047."It is our Kartavya Kaal," said the paper.

The paper tabled in the Lok Sabha by finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman said the UPA's governance record was marred by price instability, banking crisis, external vulnerability, messy public finances with underreporting of deficits and lack of asset creation.

"In 2014, when we formed the government, the economy was in a fragile state; public finances were in bad shape; there was economic mismanagement and financial indiscipline and there was widespread corruption. It was a crisis situation,"it said.

The economy under UPA suffered from "double-digit inflation, ailing banking sector following excessive lending during the boom phase, and high policy uncertainty marred India's business climate, dented its image and the people's con-

The UPA government's economic policies were mediocre to start with and worsened increasingly as the decade evolved," the paper quoted an economist as saying.

"When our government came to office, public finances were not in a healthy state. To restore public finances to good health, our government went to great lengths to transform India's fiscal system into a reformed tax and spending ecosystem," the White Paper said giving examples goods and services tax (GST) rollout and thrust on capital expenditure.

Moving away from the past practice, below-the-line financing is now being transparently disclosed. "So far, this government has expended about ₹1.93 trillion in the last ten

years towards repayment of principal and interest for special bonds issued to oil marketing companies, fertiliser companies and Food Corporation of India in lieu of cash payout of subsidy prior to 2014." The White Paper recalled

that the NDA constituted an expenditure reform commission to rationalise and prioritise government expenditures to achieve desired development outcomes. "In absolute numbers, the budgeted capex has increased over five-fold from FY14 to FY24 (RE), without any heating-up of the economy. The share of capex to total expenditure, which was on an average 12% during FY10 to FY14, increased to about an average of 14.5% during FY15 to FY24 (RE) and notably to an average of 15.8% in the past five years. As a result, the deterioration in the quality of expenditure witnessed during the pre-2014 phase has now been effectively reversed," according to the paper. The paper noted that the central government's net market borrowings (G-secs), which had gone up 4.5 times during the UPA regime, went up by only 2.6 times under the Modi government despite the higher spending requirements necessitated by the once-in-a-century global pandemic.

BAT signals stake sale in ITC

MARROCO HAD SAID that BAT wanted to retain a level of influence at ITC and that a 25% stake was required for veto rights. Shares of ITC, however, fell 5.4% intra-day on the BSE and finally settled at ₹414.45 apiece, down 4.04% versus the previous day's close

Some of the other key shareholders in ITC are LIC (15.21%) FPIs (14.23%), retail investors (11.29%), mutual funds (9.66%) and SUUTI (7.82%). The Centre had decided against divesting the SUUTI stake in ITC last year. On the other hand, BAT, best known for brands such as Dunhill and Lucky Strike cigarettes, had disappointed investors when it opted against a fresh buyback programme last year, experts said, to focus instead on reducing debt and investing in new products.

BSE data shows that BAT's shareholding in ITC has reduced by 347 basis points in the last 22 years, from 32.77% to 29.03% now. Based on the current market price, the value of BAT's current shareholding in ITC is ₹1.5 trillion (\$18 billion). This is almost 26% of its current market capitalisation of nearly \$70 billion on the LSE.

- The above unaudited financial results for the guarter and nine months ended December 31, 2023 have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and then approved by the Board of Directors at their meeting held on February 08, 2024.
- Series B1 & Series B3 bonds have matured and due for mandatory conversion into equity shares on its maturity date i.e. October 27, 2022. The Company has requested bondholders to share their respective details for converting bonds and crediting equity shares to their respective account. However, the Company is still awaiting the relevant details of bondholders w.r.t 27,728.50 Series B1 Bonds and 10,330 Series B3 Bonds, which upon receipt of relevant details are convertible into 18,06,19,567 and 6,72,88,173 equity shares respectively. Series B2 Bonds are redeemable and have matured on October 27, 2022. The lead secured lender has, however, informed the Company that till the time the entire outstanding Secured debt of the Secured lenders is fully paid off, no other creditor including Series B2 Bondholders, which rank sub-ordinate to the secured creditors, can be paid in priority. Hence, the Company could not redeem Series B2 Bonds on its maturity. In terms of Terms & Conditions of Series B2 Bonds, bondholders can exercise their right for conversion of bonds into equity shares till the

date of receipt of redemption amount by the Principal Agent / Trustee of the Series B2 bonds. If all Series B2 bondholders exercise their option for conversion of 37,612 bonds, the resultant

- There was no bond conversion during the Quarter ended December 31, 2023. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India held that telecom tower is exigible to Property Tax and States can levy property tax on the same. The matter being still sub judice with respect to the component of Property Tax, non-receipt of demand notices for majority of the towers of the Company and the Company's right to recover property tax from certain customers, the Company is unable to quantify actual property tax amount payable. The provision will be considered as and when the matter is resolved. In respect of the above, the auditor/s have issued modified reports on the results for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2023 and also on the financial statements of earlier years.
- IDBI Trusteeship Services Limited ("ITSL"), Security Trustee at the behest of Edelweiss Asset Reconstruction Company Limited ("EARC")/lenders has, without the consent of and information to the Company, have debited from the TRA account a sum of ₹14,000 Lakhs during the Nine months ended December 31, 2023. Thereby total Debits being made till date stands at ₹ 114,501 Lakhs (₹ 100,501 Lakhs till previous Year).

In view of the above, the interest on borrowings has been provided after adjusting the aforesaid amounts in principal.

- The Hon'ble National Company Law Tribunal, Mumbai Bench ("NCLT") vide its order dated November 18, 2022 has dismissed petition filed by one of the secured lenders for initiation of Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process ("CIRP") under Section 7 of the Insolvency & Bankruptcy Code, 2016 ("IBC"). The said lender has filed an appeal against this order before the Hon'ble National Company Law Appellate Tribunal ("NCLAT"). In the meantime, EARC who is the lead lender of the Company has filed its Intervention Application in abovementioned Appeal. The Company has filed its reply to the appeal as well as EARC intervention application and now matter is posted for hearing.
- Shut down/exit of 14 telecom customers resulted into abandonment of more than 14,000 towers of the Company by them, making such towers unoccupied and loss of revenue towards the Infrastructure Provisioning Fees / Rental on such towers in respect of which the Company continues to pursue contractual claims of approx. ₹ 15,43,020 Lakhs from various customers. In view of above, the rental to landlords, taxes & other dues related to unoccupied towers remained unpaid, many of which are pass through payments for the Company. Further, the Company has requested EARC, being Monitoring Institution, for payments due to the landlords of the unoccupied sites, however the same is yet to be approved. Due to non-receipt of rentals, many of landlords blocked access to Company's employee to site. Resultantly, disgruntled landlords / unknown miscreants resorted to unauthorized dismantling of the tower sites. 130 sites and 806 sites got dismantled during the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2023 (2,932 sites during the year ended March 31, 2023) out of the above unoccupied sites. As a result, the Company has recognised a Loss (net) ₹ 84 Lakhs and ₹ 565 Lakhs for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2023 (Loss (net) ₹ 34,169 Lakhs for year ended March 31, 2023) which is included in other expenses in the above results. The Company continues to pursue its insurance claims and appropriate actions against the landlords/unknown miscreants including filing of FIR, wherever applicable.
- The Company lost substantial number of tenancies in the last few years, due to various events which were beyond management control, such as shutdown/exit of 14 telecom customers including Aircel Group, Reliance Communications, Shyam Sistema and Tata Tele, Business combination of Vodafone & Idea, Telenor & Airtel, etc. These developments have resulted in reduction in the revenue and earnings, Cash losses, erosion of Company's net worth, provision for impairment of property, plant and equipment. Considering the above events and pending debt restructuring, the principal and interest have become overdue. Further the Company has received notices of recall of loans from EARC and IDBI Bank claiming alleged default in terms of Master Restructuring Agreement dated December 31, 2011. The Company has strongly refuted the claims and responded to such notices appropriately. The above events cast significant doubt on the Company's ability to continue as a Going Concern
- However, with telecom sector moving towards stabilisation, management believes that, the revival package approved by the Government of India for Telecom Sector, hike in mobile call & data tariffs by telecom operators and mapping of sites for 5G rollout by the operators will lead to, increased demand for its towers and thereby increase in the revenue and EBITDA levels, subject to restructuring the debt by lenders. In addition to the above, various resource optimization initiatives undertaken by the Company can lead to stabilization and revival. The Company is also regular in payment of statutory dues, taxes, employee dues etc. Further, the Company also continues to pursue contractual claims of approx. ₹ 15,43,020 Lakhs from various customers in respect of premature exits by them in the lock in period. Considering above facts, decision of NCLT in favor of the Company and as the Company does not have any intention to stop its operations or liquidate its assets, the Company continues to prepare the books of account on Going Concern basis
- Exceptional items for the year ended March 31, 2023 represents the provision for impairment in respect of Property, Plant & Equipment. The Company will assess the impairment of Property, Plant & Equipment if any, at the year end.

Modified opinion of the Auditor -

We draw attention to the Note No. 3 to the statement which inter alia states that, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India held that "Mobile Telecommunication Tower" is a building and State can levy property tax on the same. Pending petitions of the Company before the appropriate Courts, non-receipt of demand notices for property tax in respect of majority of the Telecommunication Towers and also due to Company's right to recover such property tax amount from certain customers, the company is unable to quantify the amount of property tax to be borne by it and accordingly has not made any provision for the same. We are unable to quantify the amount of the property tax, if any, to be accounted for and its consequential effects on the statement.
