Delhi HC upholds bail granted to DHFL's Wadhawans in loan scam case

NEW DELHI: The Delhi High Court on Tuesday upheld the statutory bail granted to former Dewan Housing Finance Corporation Limited (DHFL) promoters Kapil Wadhawan and his brother Dheeraj in connection with a multi-crore rupees bank loan scam case, holding the decision to grant them bail was "based on good reasoning and logic".

Justice Dinesh Kumar Sharma dismissed the petition filed by the CBI challenging the trial court order of December 3 last year.

The judge also said the charge sheet filed by the agency was incomplete and termed it as a "final report" on investigation to deny statutory bail to the accused would be against the law and the Constitution.

The criminal procedure code (CrPc) mandates that an accused shall be released on bail if the investigation is not completed within the stipulated time.

"This Court is of the considered opinion that the charge sheet filed by the CBI in the present case is an incomplete piecemeal charge sheet and terminating the same as a final report under



section 173 (2) Cr.Pc. merely to ruse the statutory and fundamental right of default bail to the accused shall negate the provision under Section 167 Cr. PC and will also be against the mandate of Article 21 of the Constitution of India," said the court.

"There is no illegality or perversity in the order of the learned Sessions Judge..

Accordingly, the order dated 03.12.2022 passed by I.D. Special Judge, P.C. Act, Rouse Avenue District Courts, New Delhi, is upheld. The present petition is dismissed," ordered the court.

Wadhawan brothers were arrested in this case on July 19 last year. The court, in its 53-page order, observed that the right to speedy trial

goes to the root of the fundamental rights of an individual and the purpose behind laying down the time period for completion of investigation is to ensure that after a person has been arrested, the probe should be completed on time without any fail and the trial should begin and be completed as expeditiously as possible. Although the police have

a right to conduct further investigation, they cannot, under the garb of further investigation, be allowed to file the report without completion of investigation, only to defeat the right of statutory bail, it added.

The court said in the present case, even though the allegations against the accused persons were very serious, the material collected by the investigating agency so far "fell short".

"In the present case as has been shown by the learned defence counsel during the course of arguments that substantial investigation even qua the present accused persons is incomplete. The offence alleged against the accused persons are very serious and very high in magnitude.

"The material collected by the investigating agency so far, to the mind of this Court falls too short. Rather, if this report is considered to be a complete investigation qua the accused persons, the investigating agency will suffer a lot," it added.

ture needed to make certain provisions for extending the time granted for completion of investigation in such serious offences.

It, however, clarified it has not gone into the merits of the case.

The charge sheet was filed on October 15, 2022 and cognisance was taken.

The FIR in the case was based on a complaint made by the Union Bank of India.

It had alleged that DHFL, its then CMD Kapil Wadhawan, the then Director Dheeraj Wadhawan and other accused persons entered into a criminal conspiracy to cheat the consortium of 17 banks led by the Union Bank of India, and in pursuance of the criminal conspiracy, the accused and others induced the consortium to sanction huge loans aggregating Rs 42,871.42 crore.

Much of that amount was allegedly siphoned off and misappropriated by alleged falsification of the books of the DHFL and dishonest default in repayment of the legitimate dues of the consortium banks, the CBI has claimed.

'We need food, not tobacco' theme for World No Tobacco Day 2023



NEW DELHI: The World No Tobacco Day is here again and the theme for this year is 'We need food, not tobacco'.

World No Tobacco Day is celebrated on May 31 every year to raise awareness about the harms of tobacco use. This year's theme aims to raise awareness about alternative crop production and marketing opportunities for tobacco farmers and encourage them to grow sustainable and nutritious crops.

Tobacco cultivation contributes to increased food insecurity worldwide, said Dr Poonam Khetratal Singh, WHO Regional Director for South-East Asia. Around 3.5 million hectares of land are converted for tobacco growing each year globally.

In Southeast Asia Region, India leads in acres of land under cultivation and tobacco production, followed by Indonesia. Tobacco is also grown in Bangladesh, DPR Korea, Thailand, Myanmar, and Sri Lanka.

"I am happy to share that we have success stories from Bangladesh, India, Indonesia, and Sri Lanka, where tobacco-growing farmers have successfully shifted over to economically viable alternative crops," Singh said.

"Sri Lanka is leading the way by successfully implementing pilots to promote alternative crops replacing tobacco growing with encouraging results," Singh added. Nine of the 10 largest tobacco cultivators are low- and middle-income countries and four of these are defined as low-income food-deficit countries. Land used to grow tobacco could be more efficiently used to achieve United Nations Sustainable Development Goal 2.

Kerala: CM Vijayan directs officials to conduct monsoon preparedness activities

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: In the background of IMD predicting the onset of monsoon around June 4 in Kerala, Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan on Tuesday directed the state officials to carry out the monsoon preparedness activities vigorously. He was chairing a meeting of the State Disaster Management Authority here.

Due to the unpredictable nature of rainfall availability, a review of monsoon preparedness activities in the districts should be conducted especially in the first week of June, July, August and September. The meeting should be held under the leadership of the district in-charge ministers or district collectors, the Kerala CM directed. In case of heavy rains, the possibility of waterlogging in urban areas should be foreseen and the drainage systems should be cleaned and the activities to facilitate the flow of water should be completed. A separate system should be set up in all districts to monitor these, Pinarayi Vijayan instructed.

The cities of Kochi, Kozhikode and Thiruvananthapuram are prone to severe waterlogging in case of heavy rainfall. Operation Breakthrough, Operation Ananta etc should be continued in such cases. Their current condition should be checked and emergency precautions should be taken.

Safety boards should be put up at the work sites on the road. Immediate steps should be taken to fill potholes on the road. Basic facilities including toilets and electricity should be ensured in the camps. Information about the buildings found to convert into camps should be published in local government offices and public places. A strong awareness campaign and training should be provided among the people in hilly areas prone to landslides. Hazard warnings should be displayed at tourist destinations said the Chief Minister. In the meeting, State Disaster Management Authority Vice Chairman and Revenue Minister K Rajan, Agriculture Minister P Prasad, Chief Secretary V. P. Joy, District Collectors and various other state officials were present.

"It is unconstitutional," CPI(M)'s Sitaram Yechury extends support to Delhi CM Kejriwal on Centre's ordinance

NEW DELHI: Communist Party of India (Marxist) General Secretary Sitaram Yechury on Tuesday met Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal in the national capital and extended his support to the Aam Aadmi Party convener against the Centre's Ordinance on control over administrative services in Delhi.

After the meeting, Yechury said, "We have condemned the ordinance brought by the Centre. It is unconstitutional. It is also contempt of Court. We appeal to the biggest opposition party Congress to come forward to save our constitution." Addressing mediapersons on the issue of the Centre bringing in an ordinance negating the Supreme Court order, Kejriwal said that he stands with the people of the national capital. Chhattisgarh liquor scam: "Petitioners challenging PMLA provisions bypassing other forums," observes SC

NEW DELHI: Hearing pleas regarding the money laundering case relating to the Chhattisgarh liquor scam, the Supreme Court on Tuesday observed that there is a trend of filing petitions going on these days before the top court challenging the constitutional validity of certain provisions of Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) bypassing other forums which are open to petitioners.

The observation of the bench of justices Bela M Trivedi and Prashant Kumar Mishra came when various petitioners on Tuesday sought to withdraw petitions challenging money laundering cases relating to the Chhattisgarh liquor scam and certain provisions of the PMLA. The top court said despite the Vijay Madanlal judgment passed by the Supreme Court last year, there is a trend prevailing in writ petitions filed before this court under Article 32 challenging the constitutional validity of certain provisions of PMLA which has been decided. The top court remarked that these reliefs are bypassing other forums open to petitioners.

Various petitions challenging money laundering cases relating to the Chhattisgarh liquor scam and certain provisions of the PMLA were withdrawn from Supreme Court on Tuesday.

The SC bench, however, granted liberty to petitioners to seek remedies available as per law in other appropriate



forums. The top court said that this is becoming an alternate forum instead of going to High Court.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta submitted before the top court that these days people are approaching the supreme court to challenge the provisions of laws instead of asking for anticipatory bail. SG Mehta called such petitions an abused process of law. He urged the top court that the top court should make some observations otherwise it will keep going.

Chhattisgarh's Excise official Niranjan Das and various others including Karishma Dhebar, Anwar Dhebar and Pinki Singh approached Supreme Court. They challenged certain provisions of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA). The petitioner has also sought quashing of the Enforcement Case Information Report (ECIR) in liquor irregularities matter in Chhattisgarh.

The Enforcement Directorate (ED) is conduct-

ing an investigation into the liquor scam which ran between 2019 to 2022 in which corruption was done in multiple ways. The agency said the bribe was collected from the distillers per each case of liquor procured from them by the CSMCL.

ED investigation revealed that Arun Pati Tripathi through his direct actions at the insistence of Anwar Dhebar, corrupted the entire liquor system of Chhattisgarh to maximize corruption in the department. He made policy changes in conspiracy with his other colleagues and gave tenders to associates of Anwar Dhebar so that maximum benefits could be taken.

Despite being a senior IAS Officer and MD of CSMCL, he went against the ethos of the functioning of any State Excise Department. He used the State-run shops to sell unaccounted kacha liquor. ED alleged ED alleged that his complicit actions resulted in massive losses to the State Exchequer and filled the

pockets of the beneficiaries of the Liquor Syndicate with more than Rs 2000 Crore in illegal proceeds of crime. He also received a substantial share in this loot.

Thus, the very objective of CSMCL to increase the State's revenue and to provide quality controlled liquor to citizens was violated by him for his personal illegal gains, read the official statement.

ED conducted consequential search operations at locations in Raipur, Bhillai and Mumbai and the searches resulted in the discovery of 53 acres of land in Naya Raipur having a book value of Rs 21.60 crore acquired by Anwar Dhebar by using proceeds of crime in the name of a JV.

This property was purchased through a maze of transactions in the name of an associate by routing proceeds of crime acquired from the FL-10A licensee. During recent search proceedings, ED has seized cash worth Rs 20 lacs and multiple incriminating documents, mentioned the official statement.

In searches in Mumbai, unaccounted investments worth around Rs 1 Crore, with a Share trading firm in the name of Arvind Singh and Pinki Singh, wife of Arvind Singh were found and the same have been frozen under PMLA. Earlier, ED had frozen Fixed Deposits worth Rs 27.5 Crore from Trilok Singh Dhillon. Earlier, ED had seized jewellery worth Rs 28 Crore from the house of a Country Liquor Distiller.

निजी तालाबों के जीर्णोद्धार के नाम पर हो रही लूट घोटाले के दोषियों पर हो कार्रवाई

चाईबासा : पश्चिमी सिंहभूम जिला में इन दिनों भूमि संरक्षण विभाग, चाईबासा के द्वारा जिले में बंजर भूमि राइसफेलो योजना अंतर्गत सरकारी/निजी तालाबों का जीर्णोद्धार हो रहा है, उन सभी तालाबों का उच्च स्तरीय टीम बनाकर जांच कराने से विभागीय पदाधिकारियों एवं बिचौलियों के मिली भगत का भंडाफोड़ एवं लाखों रुपए के घोटाला का पदाफाश हो सकता है।

संरक्षण विभाग चाईबासा के द्वारा इस जिले में जितने भी बंजर भूमि राइसफेलो योजना अंतर्गत सरकारी/निजी तालाबों का जीर्णोद्धार हो रहा है, उन सभी तालाबों का उच्च स्तरीय टीम बनाकर जांच कराने से विभागीय पदाधिकारियों एवं बिचौलियों के मिली भगत का भंडाफोड़ एवं लाखों रुपए के घोटाला का पदाफाश हो सकता है।

लेकर मुझसे संपर्क साधने के बाद मैंने देखा कि झींकपानी प्रखंड के पंचायत केलेन्डे अंतर्गत टोला टुंगलुईकु स्थित तालाब का जीर्णोद्धार किया गया है उसमें केवल नाम मात्र का ही खुदाई की गई है। इन तालाबों में पूर्व के तालाब आड़ी पर ही जमीनी स्तर से 4 फीट ऊंचा एक परत दर्शाया गया है एवं बाकी 6 फीट नीचे दर्शाया गया है। पूर्व में भी मैं दो तालाबों का प्रखंड और पंचायत के नाम का जिक्र करते हुए जांच के लिए लिखित शिकायत किया था।

पूरे जिले में तालाबों का जीर्णोद्धार विभागीय पदाधिकारियों एवं बिचौलियों के मिली भगत से हो रहा है। पानी पंचायत के अध्यक्ष-सचिव एवं सदस्यों को इसकी जानकारी तक नहीं हो पाती है। बहुत सारे पानी पंचायत के अध्यक्ष-सचिव तो भूमि संरक्षण विभाग का कार्यालय तक नहीं पहुंच पाते हैं, सारा खेल बिचौलियों के द्वारा ही होता है। भूमि संरक्षण विभाग द्वारा जिले में चल रहे सभी तालाबों का 15 दिनों के अंदर उच्च स्तरीय जांच

अपनी वाहनों को खड़ा कर अनिश्चितकालीन हड़ताल पर चले गये हैं। वाहन मालिक उक्त एसोसिएशन के बैनर तले हाथी चौक के पास जमे हैं, ताकि कोई हाइवा एसोसिएशन के विरुद्ध जाकर अयस्क ढुलाई न शुरू कर दे। ऐसे वाहनों को रोका जाएगा। लेकिन अब तक ऐसी स्थिति नहीं आयी है। आंदोलन शांतिपूर्ण चल रहा है। एसोसिएशन के अध्यक्ष ने बताया कि 13 मार्च को टीएसएलपीएल कंपनी को भाड़ा वृद्धि को लेकर मांग पत्र सौंपा गया था लेकिन प्रबंधन ने कोई
