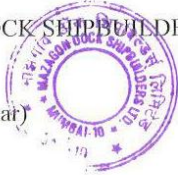

REPLIES OF INDIA TODAY QUESTIONNAIRE

1) Kindly outline the details of the recent events carried out in Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited?

Ans- Project 75: Sixth and last submarine 'Vagsheer' of Project 75 was launched on 20 April 2022 and the fifth submarine 'Vagir' is planned to be delivered in the current financial year (FY).

***P15B:** Delivery of Second Missile Guided Destroyer of Visakhapatnam Class under Project 15B- 'Mormugao' is also scheduled in current financial year, whereas, launching of the 04th Destroyer of P15B class 'Surat' was done B class on 17 May 2022. Basin Trials of the third ship of P15B 'Imphal' is also scheduled in current FY.

***P17A:** Second stealth frigate of Nilgiri Class 'Udaygiri' was launched on 17 May 2022. Further, the third Frigate of P17A class is scheduled for launch in end 2022.

2) Does MDL collaborates with other national undertakings?

Ans- Yes.

- MDL in collaboration with CFEES (DRDO) has developed Magazine Fire Fighting System (MFFS) for warships. MDL along with CFEES (DRDO) are joint owners of the technology.

- MDL is actively participating with NMRL – DRDO for development of Air Independent Propulsion (AIP) system for Submarines.

- MDL supported DRDO in setting up 500 bed dedicated COVID hospital in Lucknow in May 2021.

- MDL has signed a contract with M/s BEL for procurement and installation of LRSAM and MFSTAR for P15B and P17A projects.

3) Give us a brief history of MDL & how is it governed?

Ans- Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDL) is a defence public sector undertaking shipyard under the administrative control of Ministry of Defence (MoD). MDL is the oldest shipyard in India with inception in 1774, incorporated in 1934, and taken over by the Government of India in 1960. MDL is the only shipyard in India to have built Destroyers and two different types of conventional Submarines for the Indian Navy with its facilities located in Mumbai and Nhava and thus MDL is also one of the unique shipyards in the world with such diverse range of products ranging from Destroyers, Stealth Frigate, Submarines, Corvettes, Missile vessels to varieties of Commercial vessels such as Multipurpose vessels, tugs, dredgers, Oil Rigs, Oil Processing Platforms etc. From the time it was taken over by the Government of India in 1960, MDL has built 799 vessels, including 26 capital warships and 6 conventional submarines. MDL has also exported 243 vessels to its various clients abroad. MDL has the capacity to build warships, submarines, merchant ships up to 40,000 DWT. MDL is strategically located with an area spread across 75 acres at Mumbai and over an area of 37 acres at Nhava Yard - Navi Mumbai, which is about 15 nautical miles across the channel with a deep-water frontage. MDL presently has the capacity to build 10 Warships & 11 Submarines concurrently at various stages of construction. It is governed by a Board of Directors headed by the CMD and includes Government Nominee Director, Functional and Independent Directors.

4) MDL has come up with an outstanding financial figures in recent quarter, please throw some light on it? Also, highlight your recent efforts of new orders.

Ans- For FY22, MDL has registered all time high performance. Highest revenue from Operations Rs. 5733.28 crores, highest operating profit of Rs. 353.03 crores and highest profit for the year Rs. 586.47 crores. Revenue from operations growth is 41.54 percent.

With respect to new orders:

(a) MDL has embarked recently on a diversified business for construction of shipping containers for CONCOR which has significant market potential.

(b) MDL has won order for repair of two Indian Coast Guard Offshore Patrol vessel namely ICGS Shoor and ICGS Vikram. The repair order would be around Rs. 29 crores. Further the contract signing for repairs of both the vessels are in the final stages. Times lines for repair of both vessels is 120 days (04 months). MDL has also obtained order for repair of a launch boat from MbPT which would be around Rs 80 Lakh.

(c) In addition MDL is also bidding for refit orders for other naval, domestic and international ships.

(d) As per Maritime Capability perspective plan (MCP), Indian Navy & Coast Guard, the vessels requirement as available in the open domain are-

- i.** 08 NG Corvettes for Indian Navy
- ii.** 01 Hospital ship for Indian Navy
- iii.** 06 High Speed Landing craft for Indian Navy
- iv.** 07 NG Fast Attack Craft for Indian Navy
- v.** 06 Offshore Patrol vessel for Indian Coast Guard
- vi.** 14 Fast Patrol vessel for Indian Coast Guard
- vii.** 12 Air Cushion Vessel for Indian Coast Guard
- viii.** 01 Polar research Vessel (Civil)

The above translates into INR 30000 cr. In addition projects of submarines 06 Nos. 75 (I) pegged at INR 43000Cr & 05 Nos Next Generation Destroyers pegged at 50,000Cr are also under active consideration for the Indian Navy.

1`5) **On one hand it builds nations defense and at the same time, on the other hand, it undertakes lot of CSR activities what makes it possible?**

Ans- MDL has executed several projects as part of its CSR initiatives mainly in sectors of Education, Health & Sanitation, Skill Development and Village Development. Substantial contributions were also made by MDL to support the nation's fight against the Covid-19 pandemic, mainly in the aspirational district of Nandurbar and Government hospitals in Mumbai. The details of the major projects executed are as under: -

a) COVID Management: MDL has supported more than 600 doses of vaccines to local stakeholders, setting-up of 500 bedded dedicated COVID Hospital at Lucknow. Further, MDL has successfully installed Oxygen Plant at Bharat Ratna Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Memorial Hospital, Byculla. We have also supported setting-up of 13 KL Oxygen Tank at Cama & Albless Hospital, Mumbai.

b) Nutrition, Health & Sanitation: MDL has continued to support in transformation of 100 Anganwadis into Model Anganwadis and completed construction of 06 New Anganwadi centres in Nandurbar. Further, MDL has supported procurement of 04 Digital X-Ray machines at Govt. Hospitals in Nandurbar district.

MDL has continued the clean-ship of peripheral areas around MDL under Swachh Bharat Mission. Also we have completed construction of community toilet block at Bus Depot in Alibaug, Raigad District of Maharashtra.

c) Education Sector: MDL has provided support to 33 Zila Parishad Schools through supply of Digital Interactive Boards in Nandurbar district

MDL has continued to support “MDL Super 25” project in which total 25 students from Shahapur area have been supported to get quality education at Bhonsala Military School, Nagpur.

d) Village Development: MDL has continued its support for Kharade Gram Panchayat in Shahapur District Thane under Model Village Development project. Several new initiatives on school education, drinking water and health sectors have been taken up in the area.

e) Skill Development: MDL had continued its support for vocational training to 100 youths as Machine Operator in Plastic Processing and Injection Moulding trade in Aurangabad and Chandrapur through Central Institute of Petrochemical Engineering & Technology (CIPET).

f) Sports Development: MDL has provided support to Wheelchair Basketball Association of Maharashtra for development of Maharashtra Women and Men Wheelchair Basketball Team. MDL has also supported 10 underprivileged athletes in shooting through Gagan Narang Sports Promotion Foundation to enable them train and participate in National/International events.
