## Penile sexual assault between thighs of victim held together amounts to rape : Ker HC

The decision came in an appeal filed by a man against a trial court verdict in a matter that involved unfortunate instances of repeated sexual assault of various degrees on a minor girl by him, who is also her neighbour. The Kerala High Court has held that any manipulation of the body of a woman such as penetrative sexual act between the thighs of a victim to simulate a sensation akin to penetration of an orifice is rape. The decision came in an appeal filed by a man against a trial court verdict in a matter that involved unfortunate instances of repeated sexual assault of various degrees on a minor girl by him, who is also her neighbour "...when the body of the victim is manipulated to hold the legs together for the purpose of simulating a sensation akin to penetration of an orifice, it amounts to rape," the court said. When penetration is there made in between the thighs so held together, it would certainly amount to "rape" as defined under Section 375," ruled a bench of Justices K Vinod Chandran and Ziyad Rahaman on Monday.

The court said when penetration is thus made in between the thighs so held together, it would certainly amount to "rape"



as defined under Section 375. "In short, considering the intention of the legislature as revealed from the above proposals, followed by the enactment of Criminal Law Amendment Act 2013 and judicial evolution of the concept of the offence of 'rape' from time to time, the irresistible conclusion is that, the definition of rape as contained in section 375 would take in, all forms of penetrative sexual assault onto vagina, urethra, anus or any other part of the body so manipulated with the intent to get the feeling or sensation of an orifice," the court said. The court said this while deciding whether

the penetration to "any part of the body of such woman" as mentioned in section 375(c) of the Indian Penal Code like sexual assaults beyond penetration into vaginas, urethra and anal canal from injuries in the human body to which such penetration is imaginably possible is rape. "We have already found that, Section 375 as amended by Act 13 of 2013, widened the definition of 'rape' by expanding its ambit beyond the penile penetrative assault into vagina. One of the consequences of such amendment is that, several penetrative sexual assaults, which would otherwise

be triable under Section 377, now come within the operative field of Section 375, the court said. However, Section 377 would still be applied in cases of multiple sexual assaults against the order of nature, which are not falling under Section 375, the court said. In its order, the court said it is established from the evidence that, the appellant had committed the offence of rape as defined per se, i.e., sexual manipulation of the thighs of the victim held together; an act of manipulation of the body of the victim to obtain sexual gratification, which culminated in ejaculation. Partly allowing the appeal, the court said as the prosecution failed to provide any evidence to prove that the acts were committed under the provisions of the POCSO Act and also under section 376(2)(i) of the Indian Penal Code are not attracted. "However the sexual acts committed by the appellant is sufficient to attract the offence of section 375(c) and with section 376 (1) of IPC," the court said. The court also guided the defence. Section 376(1) reads with Section 375(c) instead of Sections 376(2) (i) and 377 by the Sessions Court, the sentence of life imprisonment with the meaning of imprisonment of remainder of natural life.

## India not invited to 'extended Troika' meeting on Afghanistan convened by Russia

As the Taliban continues its offensive in Afghanistan, Russia has stepped up efforts to reach out to all key stakeholders in the war-torn country to stop the violence and push the Afghan peace process. India has not been invited to a crucial meeting being convened by Russia on the fast-evolving situation in Afghanistan that is expected to see the participation of Pakistan, China and the US, people familiar with the development said on Thursday. As the Taliban continues its offensive in Afghanistan, Russia has stepped up efforts to reach out to all key stakeholders in the war-torn country to stop the violence and push the Afghan peace process. The 'extended Troika' meeting is scheduled to be held in Qatar on August 11. Talks under the format had earlier taken place on March 18 and April 30. Russia has also been holding the 'Moscow Format' of talks to bring peace and create conditions for the process of national reconciliation in Afghanistan and around. Russian Foreign Minister Sergey Lavrov said in Tashkent that Russia will continue to work with India and other countries which can influence the situation in Afghanistan.

Following the comments, there was speculation that India may be included in the upcoming 'extended Troika' meeting. "We will continue working with the Americans in the extended Troika format as well as with other partners in the region to find the solution in Afghanistan including our partners from Central Asia, India, Iran and the US," he had told reporters. "We have a Moscow format that includes all the main players," Lavrov had said. Though Russia has differences with the US on various dimensions of the Afghan conflict, both countries are now pushing for the intra-Afghan talks and to put an end to the widespread violence being perpetrated by the Taliban. India is yet to comment on the upcoming

extended Troika meeting. Meanwhile, Afghan Ambassador to India Farid Mamundzay described as a positive development the decision to hold a meeting of the United Nations Security Council on August 10 to discuss the situation in Afghanistan. India's ambassador to the UN TS Tirumurti announced that the UN Security Council will meet on Friday under Indian Presidency to discuss and take stock of the situation in Afghanistan. "Convening an emergency UN Security Council Session on Afghanistan is a positive development. UN & international community must play a greater role to stop the unfolding tragedy in Afghanistan due to violence & attack by Taliban. We would like for India to play a role as UNSC President," Mamundzay tweeted. The decision to hold the UNSC meeting came two days after Afghan Foreign Minister Mohammed Hanif Atmar spoke to his Indian counterpart S Jaishankar on the convening of an emergency session of the UN Security Council to stop Taliban's violence. India holds the presidency of the UNSC for the month of August. The Taliban has been making rapid advances across Afghanistan by resorting to widespread attacks on the United States and Britain withdrawing its troops from the country in May. The US has already pulled back the majority of its forces and is looking to complete the drawdown by August 31. India has been a major stakeholder in the peace and stability of Afghanistan. It has already invested nearly USD 3 billion in aid and reconstruction activities in the war-ravaged country. India has been supporting a national peace and reconciliation process that is Afghan-led, Afghan-owned and Afghan-controlled. It has also been working upon all sections of the political spectrum in Afghanistan to work together to meet the aspirations of all people in the country, including those from the minority communities, for a prosperous and safe future.

## Two years of abrogation of Article 370 : Situation peaceful, say officials

PDP president and former J&K chief minister Mehbooba Mufti, who was present in Panchkula on Wednesday night shortly before the announcement of the bifurcation of the state into Union territories, termed the move "gross injustice". Two years after the abrogation of Article 370 of the Constitution, which revoked the special status of Jammu and Kashmir, the situation in the Valley remains peaceful on August 5, according to officials. While most shops in parts of Srinagar are shut, including the Lal Chowk city centre, shopkeepers in Srinagar bazaars alleged that the police were forcing them to keep their establishments open. Many of them claimed that the police broke open the locks of their shops, news agency reported. The public transport too, remained off the roads in several districts, according to officials. However, shops in other parts of Kashmir such as the Anantnag district and parts of Budgam, Ganderbal and Kupwara were open. In a virtual interaction on Thursday, Prime Minister Narendra Modi said that the situation in J&K will be "remembered in history" as two years ago on this day, Article 370 was abrogated, while the "first step was taken towards the construction of the Ram Temple in Ayodhya" in 2020. The official Twitter account of PM Modi's personal website, also stated that there has been "unprecedented peace & progress in the region" since the abrogation. PDP president and former J&K chief minister Mehbooba Mufti was placed under house arrest in 2019 shortly before the announcement of the bifurcation of the state into Union territories, termed the move "gross injustice".

"No words or pictures are enough to express the grief & upheaval inflicted on J&K on this black day two years ago. When unbridled oppression is unleashed & gross injustice heaped there is no other choice but to resist," Mufti said in a tweet on Thursday. Likewise, spokesperson of the All Jammu and Kashmir People's Conference, said, "August 5 will always be a negative milestone in the history of J&K. It was a political and psychological setback for the people of J&K." The Gupkar



area, which has pushed for the restoration of the special status conferred upon the state, held talks over the second anniversary at the residence of chairman and National Conference president Syed Ali Shah Geelani. Abdulla's residence in Srinagar was attacked by Modi government on August 5, 2019, and he was arrested. The actions of the government on August 5, 2019, "complicated the dispute further over the state of J&K, as it 'ignited the flames along the Line of Actual Control (LAC). It expressed regretment over the killing of Geelani and arbitrary actions" related to Articles 370 and 35-A, and urged the government to hold meaningful talks with all stakeholders. The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) in Jammu and Kashmir on Wednesday said in a statement that the Centre was working to ensure honourable resettlement of Kashmiri Pandits in the Valley. "Modi government is committed to ensure return of Kashmiri Pandits to their original homes and lands that they may be out of Kashmir because of compulsion but they yearn to go back to the valley. The government is working on ways for the honourable resettlement of the community in the valley as per the recommendations of Justice Giridhari Lal Ratrai was quoted as saying. Earlier, during an online interaction, Union minister Meenakshi Lekhi had suggested that Kashmiri Pandits were to be moved to Jammu and Kashmir to restore the Valley. However, Ratrai clarified, "individual opinions expressed here and there do not reflect change in the official position of the party". Meanwhile, isolated incidents of violence were also reported from parts of J&K on Thursday. Modis attorney general, Shashi Kapoor, in the Sopore area of the Baramulla district and an explosion, suspected to be an Improvised Explosive Device (IED), took place near the Jamia Masjid in Nowhatta area of Srinagar. No loss of life or injury were reported in either of the incidents, which are under investigation.
