# For greater good Sudan should avoid the mistakes that kept Angola in conflict for 27 years

Involuntary unemployment arises not because of any shortcoming on the part of the unemployed but because of a failure of the social arrangement within which we live. This is why societies feel obliged to devise schemes to assist the unemployed, from unemployment allowance in the northern countries to our own Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme. All such schemes, however, are conceptually half-hearted: they recognise unemployment as a social failure and, yet, involve some degree of personal penalisation of the unemployed. Unemployment allowance in the north is only a fraction of the average wage; and MGNREGS in India offers a statutory minimum wage against manual labour for a maximum of one hundred days to only one person in a family, that too only in rural India. Societies adopting such schemes accept responsibility for unemployment, but do not accept full responsibility. It is only the Soviet Union and eastern European socialist societies that had achieved full employment, even a state of labour shortage; but with their collapse, unemployment is now a generalised phenomenon as is the half-hearted acceptance of social responsibility for it. Such half-hearted acceptance of social responsibility makes these schemes appear as largesse on the part of the State, as charitable acts on the part of this or that benevolent government or leader. Notwithstanding the fact that they are supposed to be demand-driven — that is, the benefits they confer are supposed to accrue to everyone who is eligible for them — they are turned on and off depending upon the fiscal situation; at least this is so with the MGNREGS in India where all kinds of ruse are used to keep the number of beneficiaries as low as possible. In fact, the latest government decree confining beneficiaries only to those who have an Aadhaar link is an example of this. Even the half-hearted acceptance of social responsibility for the phenomenon of unemployment is thus further whittled down, at least in India. A society that fully accepts responsibility for the phenomenon of involuntary unemployment, that fully accepts, in other words, the proposition that unemployment is not the fault of the person who is unemployed but of the social arrangement within which that person lives, should compensate such a person fully by paying him or her a statutorily fixed living wage appropriate to that person's skill and training if it cannot provide work. Since governments would generally be reluctant to institute such an arrangement, and even if perchance it does get instituted, there will always be an attempt to scuttle it or reduce the scope of its coverage under one pretext or another owing to the fiscal claims such a scheme would make, it is best if it is written into the Constitution as a fundamental economic right. The right to employment, failing which the person involuntarily unemployed has a right to a full, statutorily-fixed wage, should constitute in short a universal, justiciable, constitutionally-guaranteed fundamental economic right.

When General Mohamed Hamdan Dagalo, the leader of Sudan's paramilitary Rapid Support Forces (RSF) and former deputy chairman of the Transitional Sovereignty Council of Sudan, landed in Gauteng, South Africa on January 4 for talks with President Cyril Ramaphosa, he looked civil and dapper in a navy blue suit. His calm, confident and businesslike demeanour implied he was on a mission to rescue Sudan from the violent excesses of his obstinate adversaries in the Sudanese Armed Forces (SAF), led by Abdel Fattah al-Burhan. Thus, as Dagalo, known widely as "Hemedti", posed for pictures with a smiling Ramaphosa, he did not look like a rogue military commander who is alleged to have overseen horrendous war crimes — torture, extrajudicial killings and mass rape among others — in Darfur in 2014 and 2015. Standing proudly next to the president of Africa's second wealthiest nation, acting like a dignified and magnanimous statesman, he did not look like a vicious, power-hungry military operative who had just nine months ago launched a devastating civil conflict that already killed 12,000 people and displaced over seven million others.

Hemedti's recent rebranding as a mainstream political leader and a rightful representative of the Sudanese people — achieved through well-advertised performances of camaraderie not only by Ramaphosa but also the leaders of Uganda, Kenya, and Rwanda among others —



is of course nothing but a charade. Since the beginning of Sudan's latest civil war, Amnesty International says, fighters from both Hemedti's RSF and al-Burhan's SAF have committed egregious human rights violations and war crimes including deliberate attacks on civilians, attacks on civilian infrastructure like churches and hospitals, mass rape and other sexual violence. The RSF has also been accused of driving the Masalit people out of Sudan's volatile West Darfur region through an ethnically targeted campaign of violence, sparking fears of a new genocide in the region. At best, Hemedti, who has acquired a dubious fortune by seizing gold mines and selling gold, is a political reincarnation of his former boss, ousted Sudanese President Omar al-Bashir, who ruled with an iron fist, rigged general elections, stifled dissent through systemic violence, and only paid lip service to constitutional freedoms for 30 years.

At worst, he is a rebel without a cause, palpable ideology, or moral compass who appears determined to exploit the Sudanese people's genuine struggle for democratic change for his own political ends. After he met with Un-

derstanding of the Sudanese Armed Forces" seek to impede the peace process and prolong the war.

And he claimed he was engaged in a military effort to "rebuild the Sudanese state based on new, just foundations". Then, on January 2-3, Hemedti held talks with the leader of the Coordination of Civilian Democratic Forces (Taqqaddum), Sudan's former Prime Minister Abdalla Hamdok, in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. These discussions concluded with the two leaders signing the Addis Ababa Declaration, supposedly a comprehensive blueprint for

peace talks and civilian rule. However, Malik Agar, the deputy chairman of Sudan's ruling Sovereign Council, dismissed the plan as "an agreement between partners, as Taqqaddum and the RSF are essentially one body with two faces", adding "there is nothing new or groundbreaking here". That Hemedti appears to have developed a newfound appetite for civilian rule at a time when the RSF has been scoring significant military victories against its rivals, including the capture of Wad Madani, the country's second city, comes as no surprise.

## Gang selling leopard skin, nails caught

Surat: After a WhatsApp message to sell a leopard skin proved to be disastrous decision, Valsad South forest department's Kaporada range caught seven persons with the skin and nails attached to it on Saturday. Accused were sent to judicial custody by a court after arrest. "Accused tried to sell the skin around Gujarat-Maharashtra border. They claim it to be of a dead leopard which was found in Narwad village of Kaporada taluka," Rushirajsinh Puwar, deputy conservator of forest (DCF Valsad South), told. Kaporada range forest officer Anil Patel said, "We were alerted by the Wildlife Crime Control Bureau (WCCB) that some people are trying to sell a leopard skin to local Bhua-Bhagat (faith healer) through WhatsApp message. We laid a trap with help of dummy customers and caught them." The leopard was found dead in Haresh's farm in Narwad and one of the Bhagat's advised him to remove the feline's skin and nails for using them in rituals.
