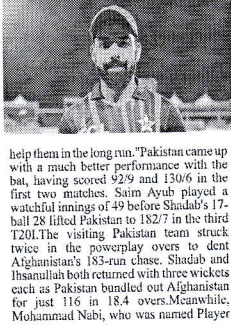


What does it take to become an impactful all-rounder? Also how much extra pressure does it come with being an all-rounder? People often say batting is difficult. I say if batting is difficult, then bowling is difficult too. These are different skills, and both are difficult. Batsman says things are hard for him. Bowler says things are hard for him as well. They both are focusing on one thing at a time. But an all-rounder must deal with both departments. He deals with both batting and bowling without complaining. An all-rounder needs to work a lot on his physical training. Things can be really tough for an all-rounder. He has to discipline himself or herself and try to achieve perfection in both departments. Being an all-rounder is not easy at all.

Pakistan's pride: Shadab Khan reveals motivation behind avoiding T20 series clean sweep against Afghanistan

NEW DELHI. Pakistan stand-in captain Shadab Khan admitted that his team wanted to play for the country's pride in the third T20I after losing the three-match series to Afghanistan. Pakistan avoided a T20I series clean sweep after defeating Afghanistan by 66 runs in Sharjah on March 27. Shadab, who scored 28 and took three wickets, said that Pakistan wanted to finish the three-match series on a "high note" after losing the series to Afghanistan. Shadab further noted that Pakistan took time to adapt to the conditions and stressed that the series was to give youngsters a chance to gain confidence which could help them in the long run.

There's enough talent, it's about how India prepare for big events: Sourav Ganguly

NEW DELHI. Sourav Ganguly likes to be absorbed in cricket. After overseeing a rigorous training session as Delhi Capitals' director of cricket at the Ferozeshah Kotla, as he sat down for an interaction, he went through every match happening around the globe on his phone. He is switching between the Women's Premier League (WPL) final between Delhi Capitals and Mumbai Indians and Johnson Charles bludgeoning a 46-ball 118 in a T20I against South Africa. He immediately looks Charles up online. Then he gathers himself and says with a smile: "It's different being back on the field after being BCCI president for three years. But with experience in cricket, I am looking forward to it." Excerpts from an interview... There's been a lot of talk around workload management of players in a World Cup year... I think players should be fine. I don't see a problem. Yes, there's a lot of cricket. The scheduling is like that. That's the way it is. Players will play. I really don't see a problem. When it comes to the World Test Championship after IPL, they anyway get enough time to prepare for it. I think they are very India have to play aggressively, especially in T20s. They have to team to do that. A team which sometimes has Axar Patel batting at No. 9 must play aggressively at the top. Pandya batting at No. 6 and Jadeja at No. 7, there's too much depth. It's about adjusting to the pressure, knowing your game and batting according to your game. Indian cricket will always have talent and a big pool. It's the ones who are more hungry go to the next level. It's about how you prepare for the big tournaments in World Cup years... IPL becomes a reference point for selection... I think selectors balance performances. They don't go blindly by IPL. Maybe while picking a T20 side, you might look into the IPL performances. I think selectors are mature enough to see overall performance. Then there's Rohit Sharma as captain and Rahul Dravid as coach. They have a major say in what they want. I think they are very India cricket. There's been a lot of chopping and changing. Do you think we tend to mix formats while selecting players in India? Good players adjust in all formats. India has so much talent that there will be some players common in all formats. That's the way it should be. Because I feel rhythm in sport is very important. I don't think the selectors do it that way with whatever my experience was in the BCCI.

Afghanistan vs Pakistan, 3rd T20I: Shadab Khan and Ihsanullah help Pakistan to avoid clean sweep



Rashid, Nabi and Karim Janat took one wicket each in reply. Afghanistan got off to a cautious start. Ihsanullah and Mohammad Wasim struck for Pakistan in the powerplay to remove Rahmanullah Gurbaz (18) and Sediqullah Atal (11). Shadab ensured that Afghanistan stay on the backfoot as he picked up the wickets of Ibrahim Zadran (3) and Usman Ghani (15), while Tayyab Tabir and Mohammad Harris combined to run out Nabi for 17. Afghanistan's middle-order and tailenders could not do much as the asking run rate went up. Pakistan bowlers kept on making inroads and Afghanistan folded on 116 in 184 overs.

UPDATED. Stand-in captain Shadab Khan and Ihsanullah helped Pakistan to beat Afghanistan by 66 runs in the third T20I and avoid a clean sweep. Pakistan displayed a much better performance with the bat, having previously scored 92/9 and 130/6. Saïm Ayub played a watchful innings of 49 before Shadab's 17-ball 28 lifted Pakistan to 182/7 in Sharjah on March 27. Pakistan scored 50 runs in the 5.5 overs but also lost two wickets in the powerplay. Mujeeb Ur Rahman dismissed Mohammad Harris cheaply for one, while Mohammad Nabi sent Tayyab Tabir packing for just 10. Abdullah Shafiq briefly joined Saïm in the middle but just when it seemed Shafiq had settled in, Rashid Khan cleaned him up for 23. Ihtikar Ahmed chipped in with 31 runs before Mujeeb finished with two wickets: Ferooqi, Fareed.
