#### UTTAR HARYANA BIJLI VITRAN NIGAM : CGRF TO HEAR CONSUMER COMPLAINTS

The Chairman Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum (CGRF) of Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam along with the members of the Forum would take the proceedings of the forum in the office of XEN'OP' Division Panchkula #517-18, Power Colony Industrial area phase-II Panchkula to redress the grievances/ to hear the complaint of the consumers and to entertain new complaints from 10:00AM to 04:00 PM on dated 21.05.2021.

The CGRF shall take all grievances/complaints of consumers like billing problem, voltage complaints, problems in metering, disconnection and reconnection of power supply, interruptions, failure of power supply, efficiency, safety, reliability, noncompliance of Haryana Electricity Regulatory Commission orders etc. However, the cases of theft and unauthorized use of electricity, offences and penalties as specified under section 126 and section 135 to 139 of Electricity Act, accidents and inquiries as under section 161 of the Act would not be considered by the Forum.

All the consumers are requested to avail the opportunity for the redressal of their grievances.

Overcoming all hurdles and finding new solutions, Indian Railways is continuing its journey of bringing relief by delivering Liquid Medical Oxygen (LMO) to various states across the country. So far, Indian Railways has delivered more than 8700 MT of LMO in more than 540 tankers to various states across the country.

It may be noted that 139 Oxygen Expresses have completed their journey so far and brought relief to various States.

Till the time of this release, 6 loaded Oxygen Expresses on run with more than 475 MT of LMO in 35 tankers.

Oxygen Expresses have been delivered nearly 800 MT of LMO to the Nation each day for last few days.

It is Indian Railways endeavour to deliver as much LMO as possible in the shortest time possible to the requesting states.

Andhra Pradesh has got its First Oxygen Express in Nellore with 40 MT of LMO.

One Oxygen Express is racing towards Kerala with 118 MT of load to boost Oxygen supply in the region.

Till the time of this release, so far 521 MT of Oxygen has been flooded in Maharashtra, nearly 2350 MT in UP, 430 MT in MP, 1228 MT in Haryana, 308 MT in Telangana, 40 MT in Rajasthan, 361 MT in Karnataka, 200 MT in Uttarakhand, 111 MT in Tamil Nadu, 40 MT in Andhra Pradesh and more than 3084 MT in Delhi.
