Biz mood down, likely to improve ahead: Report

New Delhi, 1 September

Business sentiment weakened across all parameters in micro and small manufacturing and services enterprises in the April-June quarter, a joint report by CRISIL and Small Industries Development Bank of India has shown. Sentiment is the weakest in the past seven quarters, in line with the falling rate of economic growth, the report shows.

Most pronounced moderation was observed in capacity utilisation, production volumes, and new orders, in comparison to the same quarter a year ago. But these parameters, along with profit margins, could marginally improve in the current quarter (July-September), the CrisidEx index shows.

The index dropped from 127 a year ago to 120 in the April-June quarter. CrisidEx is a qualitative measure of the mood of the services and manufacturing sectors. On the CrisidEx scale, 0 indicates extremely negative sentiment, 100 signifies a neutral sentiment, while 200 indicates an extremely positive sentiment.

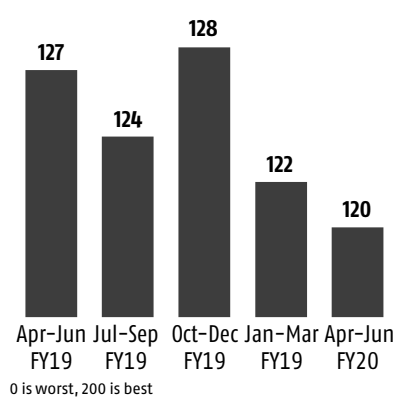
Consumption slowdown stemming from higher ownership cost, axle norms, and inventory build-up pushed down sentiment in the auto and the auto-components sector. As the quarter witnessed general elections across the country, low rate of new tenders in capital goods segment pushed down activity, the report said.

Further, cautious outlook on export demand of apparels and textiles owing to tepid global growth hurt the labour intensive sector.

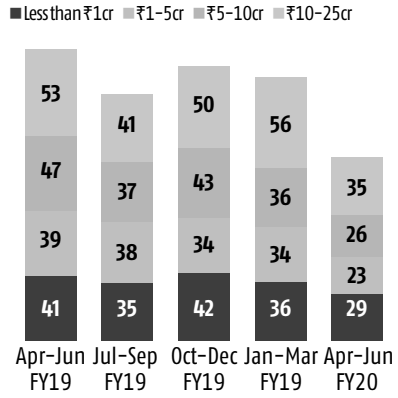
The same quarter saw GDP growth



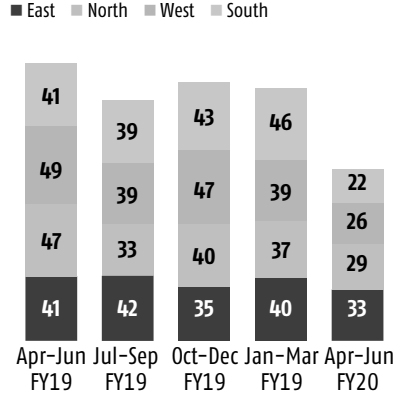
BUSINESS MOOD WEAKENS

stumble to six-year-low, at 5 per cent year on year.

The current quarter could bring good news for chemicals, metals, pharma sectors, and a host of commercial services companies, the survey noted. However, gems and jewellery, auto, real estate would still remain subdued, it said.

While imports remain subdued and

lenders (banks and non-banking financial companies) are unwilling to up the ante, asset quality of loans has improved marginally, the report noted. Hiring in some sectors rose, too, it said.

Bigger companies were better adjusted to handle the slowdown, and those in the eastern states were least hurt by the sentiment, said the report.

Let data protection Bill deal with personal health data, says IAMA

Private players in the health and technology space have responded to the proposed National Digital Health Blueprint (NDHB) and asked for issues pertaining to personal data to be held off until the Personal Data Protection (PDP) Bill becomes law.

The blueprint, introduced by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) in July, suggests provisions for anonymiser, consent manager, health information exchange, and so on, with regard to health records of individuals.

"All data collected from individuals come under the permit of the Personal Data Protection Bill, which is under consideration by MeitY (Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology). The proposed Consent Management Framework would have to come under the purview of the Data Protection Authority (DPA) under the PDP Bill and the regulations formulated by the DPA for sensitive personal information like healthcare data," the Internet and Mobile Association of India (IAMAI) said in response to the blueprint.



The PDP Bill has been in the works for over a year now, and is expected to get introduced in the Winter session of Parliament. The blueprint has proposed a National Digital Health Mission (NDHM) on the lines of the Aadhaar database, and setting up 'digital health' as public infrastructure. It has proposed to provide the technology platform for collecting core health data from providers and patients, a personal health record repository with consent, and health analytics.

"The IAMAI requests that all such provisions be put on hold till the PDP Bill is passed to prevent duplication of efforts and

multiple regulatory compliances for digital service providers," the association has said in its submission.

The IAMAI counts technology majors like Google, Facebook, and Apple as members as well as health tech firms such as Netmeds, Practo, Img, and mfine.

The MoHFW's health blueprint also lays stress on involving the private sector, including service providers and insurance, and suggests interoperability of health care data. In addition, it has also said personal health records for the industry should be created in accordance with international standards and

leveraging information systems already available in the health sector. The IAMAI has pointed out that international standards may not be easily adaptable to the Indian context and there is a lack of standardisation in the existing digital health information. The NDHB has also proposed "to design, develop and put in place certain core and reusable applications and services, which are commonly used across the country and across the health domain".

The IAMAI has said that instead of designing applications and services themselves, the NDHB could consider existing health systems.

"The private tech start-up sector has several developers working on such applications. The proposal for the NDHB to design its own applications is redundant, as long as these existing applications conform to the digital health standards," it has said in its submission.

The association has alternatively suggested that the government encourage private developers to build on the NDHB framework and allow users the option of choosing the most efficient and user-friendly option.

Auto sales crash in Aug, too

The compact segment, including models such as the Swift, Celerio, Ignis, Baleno, and Dzire, was down 23.9 per cent at 54,274 units, against 71,364 cars in August last year.

However, sales of utility vehicles, including the Vitara Brezza, S-Cross, and Ertiga, rose 3.1 per cent at 18,522 units, compared to 17,971 in the year-ago month.

The Maruti Suzuki management has kept its fingers crossed about any uptick in demand in the festive season and has stopped pushing any new stock

to dealers to keep the inventory level at a comfortable level of a maximum of 35 days. "We are optimistic, but have to wait and watch how the festive season pans out," Kenichi Ayukawa, chief executive officer, Maruti Suzuki, said recently.

Mumbai-based Tata Motors' sales in the domestic market declined 58 per cent, compared to the similar period last year.

The company sold 7,316 units in August, against 17,351 units in the same month last year. Mayank Pareek, president (passenger vehicles business

unit), Tata Motors, said he expected things to turn around due to the government sops.

"We hope the financial package will help in improving liquidity and reduce the ownership cost," said Pareek. Honda Cars India saw a 51.28 per cent decline in domestic sales at 8,291 units in August, against 17,020 units in the same month last year.

Similarly, Mahindra & Mahindra (M&M) on Sunday reported a 25 per cent fall in sales to 36,085 units in August. The company had sold 48,324 units in the corresponding

month last year.

"The auto industry continued to be subdued in August due to several external factors. We are optimistic and hopeful of a good festive season," said Veeraj Ram Nakra, M&M chief of sales and marketing (automotive division).

Analysts are not optimistic. "A turnaround in the industry is months away since any of the measures recently taken to deal with the sales slowdown or to prop up consumer sentiment will take time," said Sridhar V, partner, Grant Thornton India.

Realty players see some festive cheer

Northern market hopes for revival

According to major real estate players, there has been a sharp increase in enquiries over the past few weeks. There are more than 50 established developers with ready-to-move-in inventory in Delhi-National Capital Region (NCR) and nearby regions.

"The demand for investment and housing in transit oriented development regions is expected to rise. These are regions easily accessible via the Metro network and highways. Supply of ready-to-move-in homes will see enhanced demand," said Parveen Jain, vice-chairman, Naredco and chairman and managing director (CMD), Tulip InfraTech.



Southern market holds the key

Southern India will, however, be the one which would lead the way this festive season and help the real estate sector end the year on a cheery note.

"The recent assurance by banks on the transmission of repo rate cuts to homebuyers, a move that would lead to reduction in equated monthly instalments for housing loans, will serve as a major incentive for homebuyers. We are hopeful this season will improve the sentiments and bring back fence sitters into the market. We feel residential real estate in South India continues to hold immense potential in the long term. Owing to a slide in the rupee, enquiries from non-resident Indians have increased across our integrated developments," said Surendra Hiranandani, CMD, House of Hiranandani. According to the 2019 data from ANAROCK Property Consultants for the first half of the year, 26,380 units were sold in NCR, while Bengaluru alone saw absorption of nearly 28,730 units, followed by Hyderabad with 9,830 and Chennai

with 7,550.

Expect freebies

The latest curb on subvention schemes by the National Housing Bank will do away with the flexi-payment option plans by most developers.

"On analysing latest trends, it emerges that waiving the goods and services tax charges (5 per cent of the total cost) and stamp duty and registration charges are among the most popular deals already on the table for prospective homebuyers. This is largely popular in Mumbai Metropolitan Area and Pune and also in NCR. In Bengaluru, upfront discounts such as ₹5 lakh on three-bedroom homes are being rolled out by builders. Few flexi-payment options like 'pay 10 per cent now and nothing for the next 18 months' are also being floated by a few builders," added Puri.

Oberoi luxury resort to be named after Ambani son

"The top three performing districts in Mumbai are BKC, which includes Bandra, then north Mumbai or the area around the airport, and finally, the south Mumbai area," he said, adding Mumbai is the single-best market for hotels in the country.

The rates for Oberoi's 'vilas' hotels are much higher than its Trident or other city-based hotels. For example, Rajvilas Jaipur starts at ₹75,000 per night for a premier room and goes up to ₹11 lakh per evening for a villa with a pool.

The Oberoi Group won't be the first to bring a resort destination to a major metro. International luxury hotel chain Aman Resorts International, which has historically used exotic locales for



its resorts worldwide, built a resort in the middle of Tokyo. It has plans to build similar hotels in other urban areas such as the heart of Manhattan in New York, and also in London, Paris, Hong Kong, and Singapore. EIH attributed its drop in revenue and profit in the first

quarter of the current year to a general slowing of business activity, the decline in air travel and reduction in the airline catering business. The quarter resulted in a loss before tax of ₹11.25 crore, compared to a profit of ₹16 crore in the same period a year before. Loss after tax was ₹7 crore, as against a profit in the comparative period of ₹10.2 crore. Total revenue fell to ₹303 crore, from ₹343.5 crore.

While Executive Chairman P R S Oberoi was not present at the company's annual general meeting recently, his son and managing director and CEO Vikram Oberoi read his speech out to shareholders and indicated that revenue and profit would improve over the next three quarters.
