Details of the violation(s)/ contravention(s) committed or alleged to be committed	Suzuki Motor Gujarat Private Limited (SMG), a wholly owned subsidiary company of Maruti Suzuki India Limited, has received an Adjudication Order dated 21 st December, 2023 which has been issued by Gujarat GST Department for the period July, 2017 to August, 2022 upholding the demand of Rs. 1,739 million, levying interest and imposing penalty of Rs. 174 million in the matter of tax liability under reverse charge basis on certain services. SMG had already paid the tax amount of Rs. 1,739 million before issuance of Show Cause Notice.
Impact on financial, operation or other activities of the listed entity, quantifiable in monetary terms to the extent possible	SMG will be filing appeal against the order to the first appellate authority. The order will have no major impact on the financial, operation or other activities of the Company.
