This Corrigendum is issued in continuation to the Notice and Explanatory Statement annexed thereto dated 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 2023 which was mailed to all the shareholders and uploaded on the Websites of the Company & Bombay Stock Exchange of India Limited on 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2023.

Pursuant to Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 and Rule 20 of the companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 as amended by the Companies (Management and Administration) Amendment Rules, 2015 and Regulation 44 of SEBI (Listing Obligations And Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015, the Company is pleased to provide the facility to vote at the 43rd Annual General Meeting (AGM) by electronic means and the business may be transacted through e-Voting Services provided by Central Depository Services(India)Limited (CDSL).

The Company shall provide facility for voting through polling paper which shall be available at the meeting and members attending the meeting who have not already casted their vote by remote e-voting shall be able to exercise their right to vote at the meeting. The Members who have casted their vote by remote e-voting prior to the meeting may also attend the meeting but shall not be entitled to cast their vote again.

The cut-off date for the purpose of voting (including remote e-voting) is Friday, the 18th August, 2023. The remote e-voting facility will be available during the flowing period after which the portal shall forthwith be blocked and shall not be available:-

21. Voting through electronic means Members are requested carefully read the below mentioned instructions for remote e-voting before casting vote.

The voting period begins on Tuesday 22nd August, 2023 at 09.00 am (IST) and ends on Thursday, 24th August, 2023 at 5.00 p.m.(IST). During this period shareholders' of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date 18th August,2023 may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.

ii. Shareholders who have already voted prior to the meeting date would not be entitled to vote at the meeting venue.

Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level. Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease

and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

iv. In terms of SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants.
