8 states, 55 raids, 44 arrested: NIA moves against border trafficking

A CRACKDOWN that began early morning by the National Investigation Agency to bust "illegal human trafficking support networks", which facilitate immigration via the India-Bangladesh border, ended in 44 arrests on Wednesday.

The central agency, which was assisted by the Border Security Force and state police forces, arrested 21 people from Tripura, 10 from Karnataka, five from Assam, three from West Bengal, two from Tamil Nadu, and one each from Haryana, Telangana and Puducherry.

"After that, our vigil and operations increased and 450 illegal migrants, both Bangladeshis and Rohingyas, were stopped and turned back with the assistance of border guarding forces. Enquiries and questioning increased afterwards, and it was found that the illegal migration was being facilitated and run by touts and mid-

dlemen. It was found that they are not only here, but also in Bangladesh and different parts of mainland India," he said.

He said the matter was found to be a "national security concern with inter-state ramifications", because of which the Government of Assam requested the Union Ministry of Home Affairs to transfer one of the cases to the NIA.

In a statement, the NIA stated its investigations into this case revealed different modules of an illegal human trafficking network "responsible for infiltration and settlement of illegal migrants across the border into India" were spread across several states, following which it registered three new cases in Chennai, Bengaluru and Jaipur.

On Wednesday, the NIA said, "The simultaneous raids were carried out across 55 locations which led to arrests and recovery of various items of significance including digital devices, identity-related documents including Aadhaar and PAN cards (suspected to be forged), more than Rs 20 lakh in cash and foreign currency amounting to USD 4,50."

"The arrested accused individuals will be presented before the respective jurisdictional courts. Further investigations into the activities and modus operandi of these illegal human trafficking networks would continue to dismantle the entire ecosystem of these networks," stated the NIA.

Goa begins allotment of temporary beach shacks

WITH TOURIST season underway in Goa, a delayed process for setting up of temporary beach shacks has finally started with the state government allotting 353 shacks - 255 in North Goa and 98 in South Goa - after a draw of lots for the next three tourist seasons.

As per the 'Goa State Shack Policy 2023-2026', 259 shacks had been permitted on nominated beach stretches in North Goa and 105 shacks allowed in South Goa. These beach shacks, typically built from eco-friendly material such as bamboo, wooden poles and thatched palm leaves, have long been a popular means of accommodation for visitors to the coastal state.

Officials said 353 shacks have been allotted while 11 could not be allocated in the draw on Tuesday owing to a lack of applications for shacks on four beaches. The majority of shacks have been allotted at Calangute beach stretch (108) and Candolim beach stretch (84) in North Goa.

"For shacks not allotted in the draw, there is a waiting list and the allotment for them would be done as per provisions of the policy," an official said.

Shack owners said it will take another week or more to set up the shacks, after the Tourism Department completes the demarcation exercise and clearances are received from other departments. Cruz Cardozo, president of the Goa Shack Owners Welfare Society, said the Tourism Department should ideally have issued provisional licences to the shack owners a month before the tourist season began.

THE ALLOTMENT of shacks this year has been a stormy affair. A new policy by the Goa government had some clauses that led to protests from shack owners, including one that mandated applicants must be between the age of 18 and 60 years. After a pushback by shack operators, the government backtracked on this clause. An owners' association now says the delay has led to loss of business for them.

Shack owners said it will take another week or more to set up the shacks, after the Tourism Department completes the demarcation exercise and clearances are received from other departments.
