Notes to Standalone Financial Results:

- 1. The Statutory Auditors have completed limited review of the financial results of the Corporation for the quarter ended 30th June 2024 under Regulation 33 and 52 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015. The above results have been reviewed and recommended by the Audit Committee to the Board at its meeting held on 19th July 2024.
- 2. The market sales of the Corporation for the quarter ended 30th June 2024 is **13.16 MMT** as compared to 12.75 MMT for the quarter ended 30th June 2023. Increase is mainly in MS-Retail (6.38%); LPG (4.45%) and ATF (14.53%).
- 3. The Average Gross Refining Margin (GRM) of the Corporation for quarter ended 30th June 2024 is \$ 7.86 per barrel (April-June 2023: \$ 12.64 per barrel, this is before factoring the impact of Special Additional Excise Duty and Road & Infrastructure Cess, levied w.e.f 01st July 2022).
- 4. Other expenses for the quarter ended 30th June 2024 includes ₹ **3.31 Crores** on account of foreign exchange loss. For quarter ended 30th June 2023, other income includes ₹ 24.51 Crores on account of foreign exchange gain.
- 5. During the quarter ended 30th June 2024 the Corporation had issued and allotted 2,16,92,52,744 ordinary shares of ₹ 10/- each, as fully paid up Bonus Shares in the proportion of 1 (One) Bonus Share of ₹ 10/- each for every 1 (One) existing ordinary share of ₹ 10/- each. Accordingly, the Earning Per Share (EPS) has been restated for all the periods.
- 6. Shares held by "BPCL Trust for Investments in Shares" and "BPCL ESPS Trust" have been netted off from paid up Equity Share Capital.

Further, weighted average number of shares outstanding during the reporting periods has been used for calculation of Basic Earnings per share and Diluted Earnings per share.

7. Exceptional item (expense) of ₹ 1,798.02 Crores for the Quarter and Year ended 31st March 2024 is on account of an impairment loss on Investment in Subsidiary.

5. Conclusion

6. Other Matter

a) We did not review the unaudited consolidated interim financial results / information in respect of a subsidiary company (including its subsidiaries, associates and joint ventures) whose interim unaudited consolidated financial results/information reflect total assets of Rs. 29,646.24 Crore as at June 30, 2024, total revenues of Rs. 33.96 Crore, total net loss after tax of Rs. 489.58 Crore and total comprehensive loss of Rs. 610.73 Crore for the period ended on June 30, 2024, respectively, as considered in the attached Statement. This unaudited consolidated interim financial results / information which have not been reviewed by the other auditor are as prepared by the subsidiary's management. According to the information and explanations given to us by the Holding Company's Management, this unaudited consolidated interim financial results / information of the subsidiary company (including its subsidiaries, associates and joint ventures) is not material to the Group.





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- b) The attached Statement of unaudited consolidated financial results also includes the Holding Company's share of net profit after tax of Rs. 0.33 Crore and share in total comprehensive income of Rs. Rs. 0.33 Crore for the period ended June 30, 2024 respectively, in respect of one joint venture company, based on their interim financial results/information which have been reviewed by their auditors and have been furnished to us by the Holding Company's Management and our conclusion on the Statement in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these joint venture companies is based solely on the reports of other auditors and the procedures performed by us.
- c) The attached Statement of unaudited consolidated financial results also includes the Holding Company's share of net profit after tax of Rs. 315.71 Crore and Holding Company's share in total comprehensive income of Rs. 315.74 Crore respectively for the period ended June 30, 2024, in respect of 12 joint venture companies and 6 associate companies, based on their interim financial results/information which have not been reviewed by other auditors and are as prepared by the management of the respective joint venture and associate companies. According to the information and explanations given to us by the Holding Company's Management, these interim financial results / information are not material to the Group.
- d) In paragraph c) above, the consolidated unaudited financial results includes one joint venture company 'Matrix Bharat Pte. Ltd' whose financial statements were drawn up to March 31, 2024. We are informed by the Management that there are no significant transactions or events from April 1, 2024 till June 30, 2024, that may require any adjustment.
- e) The Group has not consolidated the financial results of one joint venture company (Bharat Renewable Energy Limited) and one associate company 'Petronet CI Limited' wherein the Management has decided to exit from these companies.
- f) The Group has also not consolidated the financial results of one associate company 'Petronet India Limited' which is under liquidation and 'Ujjwala Plus Foundation' which is a section 8 Company under the Companies Act, 2013, wherein there are no operational activities during the quarter ended June 30, 2024. In the opinion of the Management, the above financial statements are not material to the group.

Accordingly, the Board of the Corporation does not have an optimum combination of executive and non-executive directors, as per Regulation 17(1) of the Regulations from the April 1, 2024 to May 10, 2024.
- h) The figures for the quarter ended March 31, 2024, as reported in these unaudited consolidated financial results are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the full previous financial year ended on March 31, 2024, and the published reviewed year to date figures up to the third quarter of the previous financial year ended December 31, 2023.
