UK Impairment Costs Won't Hit Tata Steel Any More

ET Q&A Tata Steel will not be taking any more impairment charges on its books on account of the impending transition of UK operations to green manufacturing processes. TV Narendran, the managing director of the company, told ET in an interview. The negotiations with the British government, which is lending support of \$500 million for this transition, will serve as a benchmark for the company as it prepares for similar discussions with the Dutch government. Narendran told ET: "UKite Perival and Nehal Chialawala added excerpts: 'Will there be any more impairments or restructuring costs for the UK operations?' As far as the UK is concerned, it is

entirely done. We wanted to lock it in one shot. Though there has been a little bit of charge this quarter, the employee pension fund is also completely sorted and has gone to insurance, and we have no exposure to it. **Is the UK government okay with job cuts during the transition, given that it is lending financial support?** The UK government knows that fewer jobs will be required because it is a different process. The intention of both the UK government and Tata Steel is to build a sustainable business because the government is also putting taxpayer's money into business. **What will the cost structure for production look like in the UK post the transition?** Our expectation is that the cost of the UK business will be about 100-150 lower per tonne than what it is today.



As far as the UK is concerned, it is entirely done. We wanted to do it in one shot. Though there has been a little bit of charge this quarter, the employee pension fund is also completely sorted....

ONE-TIME EXPENSE Apart from fewer employees needed, the government is also working on bringing down energy costs. For scrap, the advantage we have is that the UK is an exporter of scrap. And, we can use locally available scrap instead of imported iron ore and coal. **Will discussions with the Netherlands government be similar to your UK negotiations?** The proposal is different because we have to shut down and transition into a new process route by 2030. **What kind of impairment will you have to take for the transition in the Netherlands?** So, it depends. Whether we do an impairment or, I've been a longer period, do we do an accrual depreciation? We will work that out once we have the contours of the deal in place. The other things that the Dutch assets have always been Ebitda and cash positive. So, the size of the issue is very different there. And, a lot of the value will also be in the downstream assets, which will continue. Unlike the UK, where the collections are coming to end of life and there is about a furnace relying due. In the Netherlands we're not there. So we can't make it better, more gradual and we can see what is the most optimal way to do it.

Will negotiations with the UK government be a benchmark when negotiating with the Dutch? To some extent yes, because, I think the principle in Europe has been to give or cross support from the government. It's not just us. If you see Thyssen or ArcelorMittal, that's been the principle. There will also be local stakeholder support if there are local costs which are higher. We will also look at what others have got in Europe because you want a level playing field. So, these are the basis on which we will have the discussion. The UK agreement is obviously going to be an input in that discussion. **In the UK, negotiations with employee unions were a big factor. Do you anticipate something similar playing out in the Netherlands?** The unions in Netherlands also know that we have to transition to new processes by 2030.

Lenders Set to Consider Adani Power's New Bid for Lanco Unit

NEW TURN Fresh offer is higher than the lender-approved plan

Mumbai: Lenders of Lanco Amarnath Power decided to consider favourably an improved offer made by Adani Power at a meeting held on Thursday and approved by the lender. Adani Power gave a belated revised offer of ₹3,650 crore to the lenders of the thermal power company. The new offer is higher than the lender-approved plan as well as an offer made by Adani Power last December. In January this year, lenders approved a ₹3,024 crore plan from a consortium led by state-run Power Finance Corporation (PFC). Adani had offered ₹3,350 crore earlier. During a meeting of the committee of creditors (CoC) on Thursday, Saurabh Kumar Khanna, the resolution professional, sought by KPMG, conveyed to the lenders that he has already filed an application with the bankruptcy court seeking approval for PFC's plan. The National Company Law Tribunal is scheduled to hear on November 7 the resolution plan given by the PFC-led consortium. It is likely that Adani

Tribunal Asks EPC Liquidator to Include Tax Dept's Delayed Claim

Mumbai: The bankruptcy court in Mumbai has allowed the revenue department's application to direct the liquidator of EPC Construction India (formerly Essar Projects) to include its claim of over ₹13 crore even after a delay of 52 days. EPC has an admitted liability of over ₹1,000 crore towards its creditors and the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) liquidated the company for liquidation on May 7, 2021, after lenders failed to recover any viable revival plan. "The liquidation proceedings are still underway and the admission of a claim, which is statutory due, will not derail processes the liquidation proceedings in respect of the corporate

debtor (EPC Construction), said the division bench of judicial member Eshwari Kumar Rorer and technical member Anil Raj Chellian. Last year, the state tax department moved the Mumbai bench of the NCLT seeking to allow a delay of 30 days in filing the claim in with the company's liquidator and sought to direct the liquidator to include the claim. "From the facts, it appears that the tax department filed its claim during the CIRP which specified the time and the delay in filing the claim occurred during liquidation," said Jyoti A. Singh, a founder of law firm ADA Legal. "The liquidator was duty bound to consider the claims as per Section 23 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code and Regulation 12(2)(c) of Liquidation Regulations taking into account the claims collected by him during CIRP." Originally, in January 2018, the company was admitted into the corporate insolvency resolution process (CIRP) and it was admitted for liquidation in 2021. The tax department submitted its claim in September 2021 for over ₹13 crore. However, the liquidator rejected the claim, stating that the last date of submission of the claim had lapsed. "This order certainly became precedent along with few other such judgments already pronounced by different benches of NCLT," said NPS Chawla, co-founder of law firm ADA Legal.
