Sub: Disclosure under Regulation 30 of the SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015.

We would like to inform that on 25th April 2024 the Hon'ble High Court for the State of Telangana passed a common order dismissing a batch of writ petitions filed by various Companies, including the Writ Petition No.26340 of 2010 filed by the Company, challenging the G.O.Ms.No.35, Dated 6th February 2010 of Environment, Forests, Science & Technology (For.I) Department, of Government of Andhra Pradesh, for amending the Rule 5 (5) of the Andhra Pradesh Forest Produce Transit Rules, 1970 in connection with supply of Form-I permits for Major Mineral/Minor Mineral/Granite by enhancing the permit fee from Rs.500/- per 100 permits to Rs.10/- per Ton/Cmt.

As per the interim directions of the Hon'ble High Court on 26th October 2010 in Writ Petition No.26340 of 2010, the Company is depositing one-third of the amount specified in the amended provision.

The Balance two-third of the amount specified in the said amended provision is being shown as contingent liabilities in the notes to the accounts of the Company, which amounts to Rs.16.06 Crores as on 31st March 2024.

The Company is examining the legal options available in this matter.
