# NIA attaches one of PFI's largest arms, physical training centres in Kerala

**NEW DELHI, AUG 1 /--** The National Investigation Agency (NIA) has attached one of the oldest and largest arms and physical training centres of the banned Popular Front of India (PFI) in Kerala, an official said on Monday. This is the sixth PFI arms training centre and the 18th property of the outfit to be attached in Kerala as proceeds of terrorism' under the provisions of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, a spokesperson of the federal agency said here. The NIA, on March 17, filed a charge sheet against 59 accused, including the PFI as an organisation, in a case registered last year. "As part of its continuing investiga-

tions in the case, NIA has now attached this training centre spread over 10 hectares. "The Green Valley Academy, Manjeri, Kerala is managed by Green Valley Foundation' (GVF) and was used by the cadres of National Development Front and subsequently by the PFI into which it merged," the spokesperson said. The agency said the PFI had been using the property for imparting arms training, physical training, and training on the use and testing of explosives to its cadres, identified as part of their Service Wing. "The facility was also used to harbour several PFI Service Wing' members after they committed

crimes, including murders. The centre was further being used to impart radical and rabid type of ideological training in PFI's divisive and communal agenda and policies to its trained operatives, cadres and members," the spokesperson said. The agency said offices of PFI and its front organisations were functioning from these premises under the guise of educational institutions. The five other PFI training centres attached previously by NIA in Kerala were Malabar House, Periyar Valley, Valluvanad House, Karunya Charitable Trust and Trivandrum Education and Service Trust (TEST). Another 12 PFI offices, used

by the outfit's leadership intermittently to organise training in arms and physical training, ideological propagation, and training for the commission of various crimes, including murders and terrorist acts, have also been attached. "NIA investigations have revealed that the PFI has been running many such training centres in the guise of charitable and educational trusts formed by the organisation's members or leaders. "Investigations have also revealed that the PFI had hired several buildings for running their training camps and activities relating to terror and violence," the spokesperson said. (PTI)

# LS nod to Registration of Births and Deaths (Amendment) Bill

**NEW DELHI, AUG 1 /--** The Lok Sabha on Tuesday passed a Bill that allows the use of a birth certificate as a single document for admission to an educational institution, issuance of driving licence, preparation of voter list, Aadhaar number, registration of marriage or appointment to a government job. The Registration of Births and Deaths (Amendment) Bill, 2023 will also help create a national and state-level database of registered births and deaths which eventually would ensure efficient and transparent delivery of public services and social benefits and digital registration, Union Minister of State for Home Nityanand Rai said responding to a brief debate on the Bill in Lok Sabha. The Bill was passed amid vociferous protests by the Opposition on the ethnic violence in Manipur and demands for a statement by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in Parliament. Rai said the Act has not been amended so far since its inception and in order to keep pace with the societal change and technological advancements during the period of its operation and to make it more citizen friendly, there is a need to amend the Act. The Bill will facilitate insertion of provisions for digital registration and electronic delivery of certificate of births and deaths for the benefit of the public at large, to create a national and state-level database of registered births and deaths which would help in updating other databases resulting in efficient and transparent delivery of public services and social benefits. The legislation will provide for use of the birth certificate as a single document to prove the date and place of birth of a person born on or after the date of commencement of the Registration of Births and Deaths (Amendment) Act, 2023, for admission to an educational institution, issuance of a driving licence, preparation of a voter list, registration of a marriage, appointment to a post in Union or state government or a local body or public sector undertaking or in any statutory or autonomous body under the Union or state government. # Karnataka govt to formally launch 'Gruha Jyothi' free power scheme on Aug 5 in Kalaburagi

**BENGALURU, AUG 1 /--** Karnataka Energy Minister K J George on Tuesday said 'Gruha Jyothi' scheme, one of the five poll guarantees of the Congress promising to provide up to 200 units of free power to households, will be formally launched on August 5 in Kalaburagi. "We had announced that from July, the electricity will be free up to 200 units and July's bill will come in August. We have now started the process of giving the bills. Under this ambitious scheme, already 1.42 crore consumers have registered," George said. Speaking to reporters here, he said, on the suggestion of the Chief Minister, cabinet colleague, legislators and others, it has been decided to organise a formal launch of the scheme, outside Bengaluru, and it will be at Kalaburagi on August 5. Chief Minister Siddaramaiah, Congress

president and Leader of Opposition in Rajya Sabha Mallikarjun Kharge, Deputy Chief Minister D K Shivakumar, among others will grace the occasion, he said, adding that all the ministers have been asked by the Chief Minister to organise similar events in their respective districts. The benefit under this scheme is calculated based on average consumption for financial year 2022-23, plus 10 percent additional, but total amounting to less than

200 units. Of the 1.42 crore applicants so far, close to 18 lakhs were received from beneficiaries of various existing schemes such as Bhagya Jyothi, Kuteera Jyothi and Amrut Jyothi. Stating that those who exceed 200 units usage will not be eligible under the scheme and their application will be rejected, George said: "Those consumers who have applied and their consumption is within 200 units, based on the average

and ten per cent additional, they will get zero bill. If the consumer has used above average and 10 per cent, but is still under 200 units, they will be charged the differential amount (between average and used units)." Those who have registered under the scheme up to July 27 are eligible under the scheme, he said, adding there is no cutoff date for the scheme, and anyone who wants to register afresh and benefit from the scheme, can apply even now.
