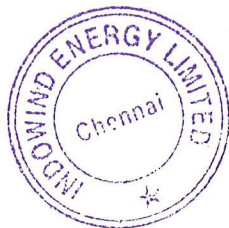

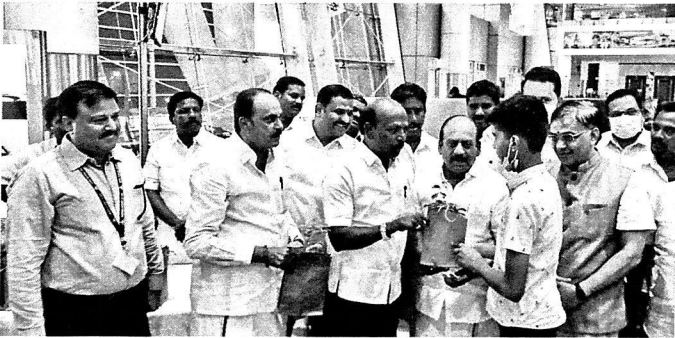

Chennai, June 8: Union Minister of Commerce and Industry Piyush Goyal on Monday said that the aim of the country is to double marine product exports from more than Rs 50,000 crore to Rs 1 lakh crore within the next five years.

This target can be achieved through sustainable fishing, ensuring quality and variety, promotion of coastal shipping and aquaculture, and by supporting the entire fisheries ecosystem, the Minister said this while speaking to newsmen at Marine Products Export Development Authority (MPEDA).

Earlier, the Minister also held discussions with fishermen from Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry and Karnataka.

Piyush Goyal said that Free Trade Agreements had been finalized with UAE and Australia, while negotiations were progressing for such agreements with UK and Canada.

The Minister said negotiations to reach an FTA with the EU will begin in Brussels on the 17th of this month. He said the effort was to provide market access and new opportunities for the country's exporters and consequently give fishermen a better future.

The Minister also ruled out the possibility of shifting the office of MPEDA from Kochi.

Earlier, the Minister had an interaction with Seafood Exporters Association of India (SEAI) at MPEDA and had an extensive discussion on various issues, challenges and solutions facing the sector.

The Minister assured interventions from the Ministry to minimize the hurdles on the import of

raw materials for value addition so that India can be transformed to a seafood processing hub in the near future.

The exporters were urged by the Minister to educate, assist and encourage fishermen to follow sustainable measures in fishing and also to preserve the quality of the catch so that they will get better returns. The Minister also informed that the Indian missions abroad had geared up to help exporters in expanding their trade.

SEAI was represented by Jagdish Fofandi, National President and Regional Presidents from Andhra Pradesh,

Chennai, June 8: The Tamil Nadu government on Tuesday filed a petition against Cauvery Water Management Authority (CWMA) in the Supreme Court asking the Court to give direction to the CWMA not to discuss the Mekedatu issue.

In a June 4 reply to a communication, dated May 25, which said the CWMA could take up the issue for discussion, the Tamil Nadu government contended that the project would be in violation of the Cauvery Water Disputes Tribunal's final order, as modified by the Supreme Court in February 2018, and the set-up and functions of the CWMA.

"At the 16th meeting [scheduled for June 17], the Tamil Nadu representative will strongly oppose this and point out that this subject is beyond the jurisdiction of the CWMA," Mr. Duraimurugan said in a statement. Tamil Nadu

The vehicle boasts a highly impressive real-world driving range, ultra-fast charging capabilities, and a spacious, high-tech interior. The company has received an overwhelming response for the car with 355 bookings which is 3.5 times the planned numbers for 2022.

Tae-Jin Park, Managing Director and CEO, Kia India, said, "Now, we are ready for the next phase of our India journey with our investment in R&D, manufacturing, and development of EV infrastructure in India. We will offer futuristic and sustainable BEVs developed ground up to offer matchless in-cabin experience, long-range to reduce range anxiety, and the same thrill of driving as our other products."

would continue to take steps to protect the interests of its farmers and people, he said.

Chief Minister M.K. Stalin, at his meeting with Prime Minister Narendra Modi in June last year, requested him to urge Karnataka to drop the project. In a representation to Union Jal Shakti Minister that month, Mr. Duraimurugan, too, opposed the project.

In July 2021, an all-party meeting, chaired by the Chief Minister, adopted a resolution opposing Karnataka's

proposal for a dam across the Cauvery at Mekedatu. Later that month, the Union Minister said assent to the project would not be granted without Tamil Nadu's permission, Mr. Duraimurugan recalled.

However, the Karnataka government, in its 2022-23 Budget, allocated Rs. 1,000 crore for the proposal. As a result, the Tamil Nadu government in March this year adopted a unanimous resolution in the Assembly against the proposal, and it was sent to the Union government, the Minister recalled.
