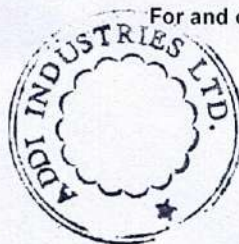

We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited consolidated financial results ("the Statement") of **Addi industries limited** ("the Parent") and its Subsidiary (the Parent and its Subsidiary together referred to as "the Group") for the quarter ended September 30, 2024 and year to date results for the period from April 01, 2024 to September 30, 2024, being submitted by the Parent pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("the Regulation"), including relevant circulars issued by SEBI from time to time ("the Circulars").
2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Parent's Management and approved by the Parent's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 (Ind AS 34) "Interim Financial Reporting", prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, as amended read with relevant rules issued thereunder, the Circulars and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

The consolidated unaudited financial results of the Parent includes the financial statements of one Subsidiary which have not been reviewed by their auditor, whose financial statement reflects total assets (before eliminating inter-company balances ₹ Nil) of ₹ 232.97 lakh as at September 30, 2024 and total revenue (before eliminating inter-company transaction ₹ Nil) of ₹ 4.18 lakh and ₹ 8.30 lakh, total net profit after tax (before eliminating inter-company transaction ₹ Nil) of ₹ 3.51 lakh and ₹ 6.98 lakh and total comprehensive income (before eliminating inter-company transaction ₹ Nil) of ₹ 3.51 lakh and ₹ 6.98 lakh for the quarter ended September 30, 2024 and year to date results for the period from April 01, 2024 to September 30, 2024, respectively, and Cash flow (net) of ₹ (0.70) lakh for the period April 01, 2024 to September 30, 2024, as considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results. According to the information and explanation given to us by the management, these interim financial statements are not material to the Group. Our conclusion on the statement is not modified in respect of this matter.
