We have audited the accompanying Statement of half year and year to date Consolidated Annual Financial Results of **Emmforce Autotech Limited** ("the Holding Company") and its subsidiary with company – Emmforce **Mobility Solutions Private Limited** (the Holding Company and Its subsidiaries together referred to as the Group"), for the half year ended 31st March 2024 ("the Statement") being submitted by the Holding Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 as amended ('Listing Regulations').

- (ii) are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations read with the Circular, in this regard; and
- (iii) give a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable standard on auditing ("SAs"), and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, of consolidated net profit/loss and other financial information of the Group for the half year ended 31st March 2024 and for the year ended 31st March 2024.

#### **Basis of Opinion**
