Job at Doorstep

As per the guideline allowing doorstep vaccination, a registered Private Covid Vaccination Center can manage the vaccination at housing societies and workplaces. One of their senior staff will be appointed as a "Nodal Officer" to coordinate and support vaccination activities. This Nodal Officer shall oversee and facilitate all aspects of vaccination at Work Place CVC/Housing Society like registration of beneficiaries, availability of physical and IT infrastructure and oversight to vaccination etc. Besides, it will still be mandatory for the beneficiaries to be registered in the Co-WIN portal before vaccination. The PCVC Nodal Officer shall ensure registration of all targeted beneficiaries. In the case of the workplace, on-the-spot registration shall also be available only to employees of the workplace. (The family members of employees must be registered in the Co-WIN portal before vaccination). All the registered PCVCs on the CoWIN portal can have linkages with all such Work Place/Housing Society for vaccination. One PCVC can have linkages with one or more Work Places or housing society. "The information of all such linked workplaces/Housing Societies will be given in detail to Local Health Authority (respective ward MOH) & EPI. These registered housing societies and workplaces shall act as a sub-center of PCVC. Availability of three rooms as waiting, vaccination and observation rooms at Work Place/Housing Society CVC will be mandatory. Minimum eligible number of registered beneficiaries (Multiples of 10) and sessions can be planned for optimal utilization of vaccine dosage and reduce wastage. The most important thing will be the availability of an ambulance at the sub-vaccination site along with linkages to the nearby health facility for the management of AEFI," said a senior BMC official. The SoP further states that each of the PCVC shall have one registration on Cowin App as parental PCVC and one registration as workplace PCVC. The Co-operative Housing Societies and workplace vaccination shall be done through workplace registration. "Some of the Work Places may have health infrastructure in form of hospitals, health clinics, nursing centres etc. This infrastructure may be utilized to set up vaccination site in case they have sufficient space for waiting, vaccination and observation rooms are available. The health care workers of this health infrastructure of the Work Place (such as doctors, nurses and other staff) will be trained & deployed for the COVID-19 vaccination activities at Work Places," the official said. The SoP makes it mandatory for the management of the Work Place / Housing Society to take responsibility for arranging adequate rooms / space for vaccination (waiting room, vaccination room and observation room) . It will also be mandatory for all Work Place / Housing Society to have an anaphylaxis kit for management of any adverse event and needs to quickly report the event to the nearest Health Facility (AEFI Management Centre). Deployment of basic life support (BLS) ambulance at the Work Place / Housing Society and shall be utilized for shifting beneficiaries during the adverse event if any. "It will be mandatory for these sub-centres (housing societies and workplaces) to ensure sessions are conducted as per the type of vaccinations. The second dose and first dose should not be mixed up and be administered in different sessions to avoid mix up. PCVC nodal person must ensure that there is no interchangeability of vaccine of 1st dose and 2nd dose," the official said. PCVC Nodal officer shall be responsible for providing a printed copy of the vaccination certificate, both after 1st and 2nd doses, to the beneficiary, on-site after vaccination. The remaining protocol of beneficiary verification will remain the same and these guidelines will come into effect immediately.

Ward-wise jobs for residents?..

The official added that the idea would have to be first discussed with the BMC commissioner before rollout. For now, there are 136 covid vaccine centres, with more being set up across the city, considering the population density. There are also plans to start allowing walk-ins for registered beneficiaries between 18 and 44 years of age. "We have been receiving many complaints on our Twitter handle about people failing to get a vaccine despite trying to do so for three days in a row. We are planning to allow walk-ins at the vaccine centres for those who have failed to do so. Presently, we are only considering all aspects to make the vaccination drive smoother, as work continues to be a huge shortage of vaccines," the official added. Health experts have welcomed these ideas, saying the BMC should start implementing them, instead of merely considering them. Ensuring that beneficiaries only go to vaccine centres in their ward of residence will not only reduce chaos at the centres but will also help vaccinate everyone and achieve their target. "The civic body should implement these ideas with immediate effect so that they can cover large sections of the population, considering the third wave is likely to hit in July. Moreover, beneficiaries will get the vaccine on time and they will not have to run from pillar to post," said Abhijeet More, co-convenor, Jan Arogya Abhiyaan.

Bodies wash up on Ganga ghats

Also, there is a problem of paucity of space in the two cremation grounds, where normally six to seven bodies are cremated every day; this figure has touched a shocking 100. There is an acute shortage of wooden logs owing to the back-to-back cremations. Those who facilitate the last rites often demand Rs 5000 to Rs 10,000 per body. The scary graphics emanating from the ghats showing the bodies afloat seem to reinforce the belief that the authorities have been unable to fathom the scale of the tragedy that is unfolding before their eyes, pointed out a veteran journalist. The local administration has been espousing the theory that the bodies have floated downstream from Uttar Pradesh. "They are bloated and have been in the water for at least five to seven days. We are disposing them of. But before that we need to ascertain where they are from, which town in UP - Bahraich or Varanasi or Allahabad," an official told a TV channel. "The bodies are not from here as we don't have a tradition of disposing of bodies in this manner," the official explained. Another theory is that some of the bodies are dumped by the hearse drivers.

Covaxin shortage persists

and 44 years of age. There were eight beneficiaries who experienced side effects. According to a BMC report, a total of 1,77,914 people have been administered Covaxin in the city, of whom 1,21,416 have received their first dose and 56,452 have got the second dose as well. The BMC, through its Twitter handle, put out a list of 105 vaccination centres that would be functional on Monday but only be administering Covishield. It was the same story on the day before. Additional Municipal Commissioner Suresh Kakani said the BMC had 20,000 Covaxin doses and had accordingly directed vaccine centres to administer Covaxin to only a limited number of beneficiaries. "We only have two days' worth of vaccine stock and if we don't get stock by Tuesday or Wednesday, then the vaccination drive will come to a halt," he said. Meanwhile, BMC officials said they had floated a tender to procure 60 lakh vaccine doses to overcome the shortage. "We are constantly making efforts to continue the vaccination drive and ensure that more people are vaccinated in Mumbai. Accordingly, a tender has been floated on Monday for procuring 60 lakh vaccine doses," said a senior health official. However, several citizens expressed anger and frustration at the state of affairs as many of them are due for their second dose, having received their first job over 42 days ago. As per the government guidelines, the recommended gap between two doses of Covaxin is four to six weeks and for Covishield, the suggested interval is four to eight weeks. "There is absolute unavailability of covaxin in Mumbai/Nav Mumbai. Plus the booking of slots making it harder. My father took 1st dose, it's more than 8 weeks now he is yet to find Covaxin. Which is way above the max window period between 1st & 2nd dose," tweeted @kharatshashank. "my #dad is due for 2nd dose of #Covaxin #vaccine Already crossed 45 days ... Unable to book for paid or free... Please help..." shared @karan. Meanwhile, many beneficiaries complained that those from the 18-44 group were getting Covaxin as the first dose when there were many in the 45-plus group who had not received their second dose. "What about Covaxin 2nd dose for 45+ . When the stocks are low, why is it still being administered to 18+ as 1st dose? Why are senior citizens being left high n dry? What about this is so difficult for the administration?" asked @amrit. Until Friday evening, 27,31,474 people had been vaccinated in Mumbai - 20,67,623 beneficiaries received their first dose while 6,63,851 people got their second shot. Maharashtra Tourism and Environment Minister Aaditya Thackeray said on Monday that the Maharashtra government had asked the BMC to explore possibilities of global procurement of vaccines. "Working on a method to ensure non-tech-savvy citizens and those who can't operate CoWin app get access to vaccines in time. Efforts to increase vaccination centres are constantly ongoing. BMC shall be having a centre in every municipal ward. BMC shall have a drive-in vaccination centre across all zones of Mumbai," he tweeted.

Statistics helps boost PM's image?

Modi's team now spins statistical tales to salvage his battered image

The government on Monday attempted to salvage Modi's globally battered image by claiming that it is the fastest country in the world to administer 17 crore COVID vaccine doses. India's total active caseload has reached 37,45,237. "China took 119 days and USA took 115 days for reaching the same landmark," said the Health Ministry almost in "collars up" tone to emphasise how the Indian government has outpaced China and the United States. It said that the cumulative number of COVID-19 vaccine doses administered in the country has crossed the landmark of

17 crore as the Phase-3 of the nationwide Vaccination Drive expands further. The government's presentation on superfast vaccination comes in the middle of immense criticism by the global media, world leaders, opinion makers, award winning authors, Hollywood actors and opposition leaders in India of its poor handling of the COVID pandemic. Add to this the growing chorus for Modi's resignation. The Health Ministry further claimed that India's cumulative recoveries stand at 1,86,71,222 today. The National Recovery Rate is 82.39 per cent. It said that 3,53,818 recoveries were registered in the last 24 hours and

Maharashtra is on the top of ten states that account for 74.38 per cent of the new recoveries. Meanwhile, the Congress Working Committee, the apex decision making body of Congress, on Monday voiced concern over the "horribly wrong data on COVID deaths and massive non reporting of deaths." The CWC said it is deeply concerned about Modi government's vaccination strategy. "Vaccine supplies are grossly insufficient, yet the government denies the facts. The pricing policy is opaque and discriminatory and the government has passed on the financial responsibility for vaccinating the 18-44 year population to the states."

The government reiterated that it is ensuring that the global aid is being expeditiously delivered to States and UTs through fast custom clearances, and use of air and road. These clarifications on speedy dispatch of all incoming foreign aid consignments are being made in the wake of criticism that consignments are stranded at airports. The Health Ministry on Monday said that 6,738 Oxygen Concentrators, 3,856 Oxygen Cylinders, 16 Oxygen Generation Plants, 4,668 ventilators/ Bi PAP/ C PAP and over 3L Remdesivir vials received as part of global aid have been delivered/discharged to states to augment their infrastructure, so far.

States told to adopt zero tolerance on black marketing: Centre

All states must ensure special teams at different levels to "mercilessly clamp down" on hoarding and black marketing of drugs during the COVID-19 pandemic and send a clear message that "trading in human miseries" shall not be tolerated, the Centre has told the Supreme Court. In an affidavit filed in the apex court, the Centre has said the Drugs Controller General of India (DCGI) had communicated to all state drugs controllers (SDCs) that there should be zero toler-

ance to any kind of hoarding or black marketing of drugs and also to instruct their enforcement staff to keep strict vigil and take stringent action. It said the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has requested state governments to take all necessary measures to stop black marketing or hoarding of drugs the provisions of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, The Essential Commodities Act and other applicable rules and regulations. 'Nobody must be refused admission' All central and state government hospitals managing

COVID patients have been directed to ensure that no patient is refused admission due to lack of a valid identity card and a positive test report for coronavirus, the Centre has told the Supreme Court. In an affidavit on the points raised by the top court, the Centre submitted that the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has intimated all state governments regarding the policy of setting up three-tier Health infrastructure for appropriate management of suspect/ confirmed COVID-19 cases.

MGNREGA works stopped in Rajasthan

The government has to stop MGNREGA and other rural development project works in villages of Rajasthan from the first time due to Covid infections. The works are stopped till May 24, but the order can be extended if the situation does not improve. As of today around 30,000 works under MGNREGA and other rural development projects are going on in the villages of the state and more than 20 lac people are getting employment in these works.

Positivity rate falls in C'garh

RAIPUR: Chhattisgarh, which witnessed a spike in Covid infection cases, where over 10,000 people died till date, has observed steady decline in infection rate after May 5, 2020. Covid positivity rate was recorded below 20 per cent on May 9, a government statement said on Monday. COVID positivity rate in Chhattisgarh is declining steadily for the last six days. Based on the results of 48 thousand 732 samples tested on May 9, 9,120 individuals were found infected. Positivity rate has declined below 20 per cent for the first time after April 5, the communique added. On May 4, 2021, the positivity rate in Chhattisgarh was recorded at 28 per cent. On May 5, it was 25 per cent. —Avdhesh Mallick

400-bed centre at Rakab Ganj

NEW DELHI: The historic Rakab Ganj Gurdwara, built in 1783, much before the Parliament House came up next to it in 1921, on Monday opened a Covid-care facility with 400 beds to mark the 400th birth anniversary of Guru Teg Bahadur. The facility created by the Delhi Sikh Gurdwara Management Committee has equipped the beds with the Oxygen concentrators and provides free ambulances, medicines, Oxygen or food. "Donations made by the 'Sangat' (Sikh community) are sufficient, said DSGMC president Manjinder Singh Sira. —Our Bureau

Complete lockdown begins in TN

CHENNAI: After partial lockdowns and full lockdown on Sundays, a fortnight-long lockdown began in Tamil Nadu from May 10 to May 24. With the government providing time to stock essentials including groceries and medicines, no heavy rush was witnessed in shops on Sunday. However, the TASMAC shops of Tamil Nadu witnessed huge sales on Saturday and Sunday with the business in two days across the state crossing Rs 900 crore as several tippers rushed to stock up for the two-week long lockdown.

HC lauds Kerala for rate caps

KOCHI: The Kerala High Court on Monday appreciated the Kerala government for fixing the rates which are to be levied by private health care sector when treating Covid patients. The appreciation was made by the court while hearing a plea on the way private health care sector was fleecing patients.

226 O2 cylinders seized in Bihar

PATNA: The district administration on Monday morning seized 226 oxygen cylinders in Bihar's Katihar district. Shankar Sharan Omi, the SDM Katihar said: "The raid was conducted on the tip-off of local informers. "The cylinders are booked from Mumbai in the luggage compartment of the train bound to Katihar," the officer said.

Tablighis help perform last rites

TIRUPATI: When 26-year-old K Damodar Reddy lost his battle to Covid-19 at SVIMS Hospital in this temple town, his blood relatives did not come forward to perform his funeral, but a group of Muslims ensured his last rites as per Hindu traditions. When a church pastor Vetti Dasu died of Covid at Ruia Hospital, nobody from his relatives came to receive the body and again the Muslim group rushed to the hospital, received the body and arranged for his last rites as per Christian customs. Unfazed by the hateful propaganda carried out against Tablighi Jamaat last year, blaming it for spreading Covid-19, members of this Muslim religious organisation in this Andhra Pradesh town are conducting last rites of Covid victims, irrespective of their religion.

First O2 Exp to arrive in B'luru

BENGALURU: The first 'Oxygen Express' to Karnataka with six cryogenic containers -- a total of 120 tonnes -- left Jamshedpur on Monday. The affidavit, media sources said, has defied the dual vaccine pricing policy, with the Centre insisting that overzealous judicial interference, though well-meaning, may lead to unforeseen and unintended consequences. "In the context of a global pandemic, where response and strategy of the nation is completely driven by expert medical and scientific opinion, there is little room for judicial interference. Any over-zealous, though well-meaning, judicial intervention may lead to unforeseen and unintended consequences..." the Centre has said. Justifying the differential pricing, the Centre has told the Supreme Court that there should be no fuss over it since all state governments have already declared their policy decision to vaccinate free of cost. Moreover, the Centre has said the prices of vaccines are

"uniform" for all the states. "Those who choose to be vaccinated and can afford to pay the price, can go to private hospitals," the affidavit said, noting that it would reduce the operational cost of the government vaccination facilities. Explaining the differential pricing for procurement by the Centre and the state governments, the Centre said: "It is based on the concept of creating an incentivized demand for the private vaccine manufacturer to instil a competitive market, resulting in increased production of vaccines and market driven affordable prices for the same." It will also attract offshore vaccine manufacturers to enter the country, resulting in an increased availability of vaccines, the affidavit said. While the Centre continues to spend only Rs 150 per dose for either Serum Institute's Covishield or Bharat Biotech's Covaxin, states must pay Rs 400 per dose for Covaxin and private

hospitals Rs 1200. Covishield costs Rs 300 per dose for states and Rs 600 for private hospitals. The Centre has also turned down the Courts suggestion to issue compulsory licence for vaccines and essential drugs, saying it is doing the best to increase their supplies. It cited the main constraints in availability of raw material and essential inputs, because of which any additional permissions and licences may not result in any increased production immediately. Ban on Govt... The government order is a part of its austerity drive amid revenue shortfall brought on by the pandemic-induced lockdown and the economic downturn. Besides, the government wants to maintain continuity in the functioning of the departments. As per the lockdown notification, it is not mandatory for government or semi-government offices to function at 50 per cent capacity but they are expected to stagger office timings and allow staff to work from home. They are expected to work out the staggered work hours to maintain social distancing or allow employees to work from home. A senior general administration department official told The Free Press Journal, "The state government, through a special order on May 4, 2020, had banned transfers and promotions as a part of austerity drive. In the meanwhile, the government had relaxed the ban and allowed a few transfers. As per Monday's order, the government has banned transfers till June 30, 2021, considering the second wave and a possible third wave in the state. Besides, the government is striving to cope with the shortfall in revenue. The state had mopped Rs 19,298.17 crore revenue in April 2021, which is 5.23 per cent of the budget estimate. The state government, in its annual budget for 2021-22 presented on March 8, had projected a total revenue of Rs 3,68,986.86 crore." He said the state government had, in 2020-21 estimated Rs 3,47,456.89 crore in revenue, which was revised to Rs 2,89,497.76 crore amid the lockdown and the economic slowdown. The state's actual revenue collection was Rs 2,63,192.87 crore, which was 75.75 per cent of the budget estimate.
