Vaghela joins BJP two days after stepping down from Youth Cong

FORMER GUJARAT Youth Congress president Vishwanathsingh Vaghela, along with a number of workers and leaders from the Youth Congress and the National Students' Union of India (NSUI), joined the BJP Tuesday.

Vaghela had stepped down as Gujarat Youth Congress president and quit the party's primary membership Sunday, a day ahead of Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's visit to Gujarat, leveling a number of allegations against the Congress.

The former leaders and workers of the Youth Congress and NSUI who joined BJP with Vaghela include Vinay Tomar, Nikul Mistri, and Parth Desai. They joined the BJP at the party's state headquarters Shree Kamalam in the presence of party vice-president Gorhan Zadachia and Gujarat BJP's Youth Morcha president Prashant Korat.

After joining the saffron party, Vaghela stated that he joined the party as he got inspired by the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Union Home Minister Amit Shah, BJP national president JP Nadda and Gujarat party president CR Patil and Gujarat Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel.

Vaghela claimed that the Congress is not the party it used to be. He alleged that Congress's

image among the masses has worsened so much that they had to face the music while going among the public. He also alleged that after becoming the president of Gujarat Youth Congress, he tried to bring in changes but was not encouraged by the party leadership. Vaghela also alleged that currently factionalism is at its height in Gujarat Congress.

After Vaghela's resignation, Harpalsinh Chudasama was appointed the Gujarat Youth Congress president.

Vaghela alleged that a conspiracy was going on for the past three-four months to oust him from the post of Youth Congress

president and replace him with

Chudasama--the incharge of Rajasthan Youth Congress. He alleged that a conspiracy was being hatched so that Gujarat Congress incharge Raghunath Sharma's son, Siddharth, could be given an important post in Rajasthan Youth Congress.

Vaghela said he would make efforts to induct disgruntled Congress youth workers into the BJP in the coming days.

Vinay Tomar, too, alleged factionalism and nepotism in the Congress. He alleged that youth workers of the Congress are unhappy because the established leaders are trying to establish their sons in the party at the cost of other workers.

Vaghela's exit a double whammy for Congress

EIGHT MONTHS is a long time in politics, even longer in the case of Vishwanathsingh Vaghela.

In January 2022, the 36-year-old took over as Gujarat Youth Congress president thinking Rahul Gandhi, saying: "It is in a democratic and visionary party like the Congress can the son of a police constable rise to my position." On September 5, Vaghela quit the Congress, a day ahead of Rahul's visit to the state, with a personal attack on him, adding: "There is no place for a common youth like me in the Congress." On Tuesday, he joined the BJP.

For the Congress, Vaghela's resignation after 18 years in the party was a double whammy because he was chosen for the Youth Congress post via an election that was once touted as Rahul's bold initiative to kickstart democracy within the party.

In his six-page resignation letter, Vaghela decried the factionalism in the Congress and said: "Rahulji when you introduced elections to the NSUI and Youth Congress, it gave hope to lakhs of youths like me but, because of very expensive elections, we are losing respect for you. Only those who are rich and sons of leaders can work well in the Congress."

With Vaghela known as a confidant of Patidar leader Hardik Patel, who earlier joined the BJP similarly expressing disappointment with the Congress, the party was resigned to his exit. However, the timing left it red-faced: not only did Vaghela do so just before

Rahul arrived for his first visit since May in the poll-bound state but also a day after he participated in a raucous Youth Congress protest outside the Adani Group's office in Ahmedabad over drug seizures at the Adani port.

Dismissing Vaghela's claims, Parthivrajsinh Kathadia, former national spokesperson of the Indian Youth Congress and its training coordinator, said: "What transpired in these eight months that Vaghela, who had worked for 18 years with the party and held senior positions, the same party which supported the son of a police constable, is now blaming the party and Rahul Gandhi?"

Youth Congress leaders said the "over-ambitious" Vaghela had been meeting senior BJP leaders for some time, and had tried to join the party at least three.

The Congress immediately announced Youth Congress national secretary Harpalsinh Chudasama as Vaghela's successor.

An MSc degree holder, Vaghela started his political career with student politics in 2008 at Gujarat University, Ahmedabad. In 2010, he won the NSUI Ahmedabad city president election, and then the NSUI national delegate election in 2013. In his resignation letter, he alleged that the 2010 and 2013 NSUI elections had cost him Rs 25 lakh, while he had spent Rs 1.7 crore on the 2016 and 2021 Youth Congress polls, adding that he only got picked because he gave this money to the party.

"How can I respect a party where I had to buy positions? I was tolerating all the weaknesses of the party, but now my tolerance limit is over," he wrote.

Vaghela added that what the Congress required of its leaders was "bhakti of one family", asking the party to ponder why, after the election system introduced by

Rahul, "thousands of youths in Gujarat and lakhs from across the nation" that had joined it, had quit. "But that shall not affect you as the pain of such youth never reaches you as you are surrounded by sycophants. Even after working for 18 years in the party, I have not been able to know who your advisors are," he wrote, quoting Gulam Nabi Azad in saying that the party needed to be a Bharat Jodo Yatra but a Congress Jodo Yatra.

Vaghela also complained that on the death and birth anniversaries of late Rajiv Gandhi, Youth Congress leaders had "spent lakhs" and reached Delhi, but Rahul did not turn up to meet.

Fresh faces, youth, women to be given 'priority' in ticket distribution: Cong

THE GUJARAT Congress will give 'priority' to women and youth in the ticket distribution for the upcoming state assembly elections.

"During a joint meeting Monday, it was a common suggestion by everyone that youth, new faces and women should be given priority wherever possible. This is happening at a big level in the party as everyone is clear that new faces should be given a chance in the distribution of tickets in Gujarat polls," said Gujarat Pradesh Congress Committee (GPCC) spokesperson Manish Doshi.

A joint meeting of the party's screening committee, headed by senior Kerala leader, Ramesh Chennithala, and the 39-member

GPCC was held Monday after Rahul Gandhi's Ahmedabad visit.

Last month, the screening committee headed by Chennithala and two members—Maharashtra leader Shivajirao Moghe and former Delhi MLA Jai Kishan—was constituted by the All India Congress Committee (AICC) to select candidates for the state elections. Gujarat Congress incharge Raghunath Sharma, state Congress president Jagdish Thakur and Leader of Opposition Sukhram Rathwa are ex-officio members of the committee.

During Monday's meeting that went on for more than three hours, modalities, methods and criteria, lessons learned last time and the overall state scenario were discussed. The Congress is expected to announce its first candidate list by the month-end.

Outage in Indane LPG booking; to be restored soon: IOCL

The LPG booking and delivery system of Indian Oil Corporation managed by IBM India is experiencing an outage since Sunday, the company said in a statement on Tuesday.

"IndianOil along with IBM and

Oracle are working to restore the system at the earliest", the release issued by Sandeep Sharma, CGM from the IOCL's Mumbai office.

IOCL sells gas cylinders under the Indane brand. An official of IOCL said that the system was likely to come on board "by midnight".

Due to the outage, customers were not getting the acknowl-

edgement via SMS once they booked online.

"But what we have done is that once such bookings happen, the customer gets a voice message that Indane is down but his booking will be sent to the distributor. So at backend we are sending these numbers to distributors for delivery to customers," said the official.
